FRISCO OFFENSE EXPLODES FOR 10 RUNS, EVENS SERIES WITH NORTHWEST ARKANSAS:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 10-8 on Friday evening from Riders Field. Northwest Arkansas (7-9, 42-43) grabbed an early lead in the top of the first inning against Frisco (10-6, 54-31) starter **Nick Krauth** (7-3) with an RBI single from Rodolfo Duran. Trailing 1-0 in the bottom of the first, the RoughRiders got to Steven Zobac (0-1) in his Double-A debut, sending eight to the plate on their way to four runs. **Liam Hicks** tied the game with an RBI double, scoring **Alejandro Osuna**. **Keyber Rodriguez** gave the Riders a 3-1 advantage with a two-run double before **Abimelec Ortiz** capped off the frame with an RBI single to give Frisco a 4-1 lead. In the home half of the second inning, **Josh Hatcher** gave the Riders a 5-1 advantage with an RBI single. The Naturals cut into the RoughRiders lead in the top of the third, making it a 5-3 game on a pair of RBI doubles from Duran and Peyton Wilson. The Riders then struck again in the bottom of the third on an RBI double by **Maximo Acosta** that propelled the Riders out in front, 6-3. Eight batters came to the plate in the bottom of the fourth for the Riders as they manufactured their second four-run inning of the contest. **Cody Freeman** started the scoring with an RBI double before Hatcher delivered his second RBI single of the evening. Hatcher and Freeman executed a double steal and as the throw went to second, Freeman came down to score from third. Ortiz then logged his second RBI of the night with a single to make it a 10-3 lead. In the top of the sixth, the Naturals loaded the bases against Krauth, prompting **Seth Clark** to enter the game for Frisco. Northwest Arkansas used four walks, a hit-by-pitch, an error and a pair of hits to push across five runs to cut the deficit to 10-8. Krauth was charged with three of the five runs in the sixth, finishing after 5.0 innings in which he allowed eight runs on eight hits and three walks with four punchouts. **Andy Rodriguez** earned his third save of the season by tossing 2.0 scoreless frames. Offensively, Frisco erupted for 13 hits as Hatcher paced the offense going 4-for-4 with two RBI and two runs scored. Ortiz notched the only other multi-hit night, snagging three hits. Osuna led the way with three runs scored.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 30-12 at Riders Field this season. Their 30 wins and .714 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and second among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +71 run differential, a 3.56 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .744 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 24-19 with a 3.45 ERA, but a +18 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .631 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing .352/.400/.593/.993 at home this season with seven of his 10 home runs. His .352 batting average is the best in the Texas League play a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 11 games, he is hitting .349 (15-for-43)/.404/.698/1.102 with five doubles, two triples, two home runs and eight RBIs. Over his last seven games, he is batting .423 (11-for-26)/.483/.923/1.406 with three doubles, two triples, two home runs and eight RBIs. Last Friday, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .500 (5-for-11) with three doubles for the Riders.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman blasted a go-ahead home run in the seventh last Friday, giving him the team lead with 10 this year. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he is on a season-best tying nine-game hitting streak. During the streak, he is batting .343 (12-for-35)/.385/.543/.928 with four doubles, a home run, nine RBIs and three runs scored. This season, he has a career high in average (.281), slugging percentage (.467) and OPS (.800) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (73) and home runs (18).

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Riders are tied for the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (50) while also ranking second in fielding percentage (.983) in the minors. Frisco's 86 double plays are the most among non-Triple-A teams and fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. Frisco have allowed the third-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (61), throwing out 25 percent of total base runners against them.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.89 ERA, which is also the best in all of Minor League Baseball. In their series opener against Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday, the bullpen allowed six runs (all from normal starter **Josh Stephan**, who worked out of the bullpen because of rehabber **Tyler Mahle**). Those six runs were the most the bullpen had allowed in a game since April 23rd against Amarillo. That tied for the second-most allowed, with nine runs allowed in the second game of the season (4/6 at Wichita) marking the most. In their last six series, spanning 41 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 2.09 ERA (.36ER/154.2IP).

FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 31 games, the Riders have allowed just 91 earned runs over 283.1 IP (2.89 ERA). On Friday, the Riders allowed eight runs for the first time in 33 games (8 allowed on 6/5 at CC). Frisco has not allowed double-digit runs in 44 games (5/23 vs. MID). In their last 44 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs just 16 times and 13 times in the last 31 games.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

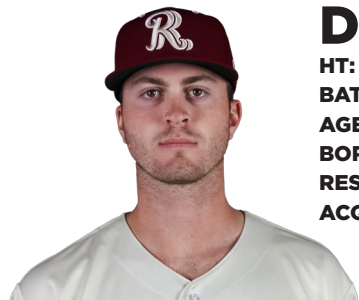

ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schripes College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 28 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In first start at Wichita on Opening Day, threw 3.2 no-hit innings before allowing his first hit. Finished with 4.2 innings, allowing just one run in a 6-4 Riders win.

-Pitched first two quality starts in MiLB career on 6/15 and 6/22. On 6/22, he went 5.0 scoreless before allowing three runs in the sixth.

2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.IIP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

-Made best start of MiLB career on August 30th against CC with 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 5 K.

2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
