BACK ON TRACK: After getting back in the win column last night in a big way, the FredNats will go for their second win in a row against the Lynchburg Hillcats, Single-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Tonight, Fredericksburg sends RHP Travis Sykora to the mound looking to build on his last start in Myrtle Beach which was by far the best he's looked in his pro career so far. He allowed just three base runners in four scoreless innings and could've kept going if not for pitch count/inning limits. Tonight's pitching matchup should be a good one as Sykora matches up with Hillcat righty Alozo Richardson, who is the reigning Carolina League Pitcher of the Week after he spun a 7-inning complete game last week against Delmarva. He allowed just one hit in a shutout performance for Lynchburg.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats set a single-game high with six extra-base hits last night in a 10-6 victory over the Hillcats in the first Copa night of the season. The team hit four doubles and two homers, one for Jeremy De La Rosa and one for Armando Cruz. The Freddies scored five runs in the 2nd inning and got to Lynchburg starter Jackson Humphries once again. Roismar Quintana had two doubles, three hits and four RBI, and De La Rosa had a three-run homer plus an RBI single.

HOTTEST HITTER ON THE PLANET: Roismar Quintana has been on an absolute heater the last three games for Fredericksburg. After hitting for the first cycle in team history on Sunday in Myrtle Beach, Quintana has five hits in the first two games of this series, three of them for extra bases. In his last three games, Quintana is 9-for 14 with three doubles, a triple and a home run, and has driven in six runs. In addition to this insane three-game stretch, he's also turned it on big time in the month of May. In 15 games this month, Quintana is slashing .352/.407/.611 for an OPS of 1.018 this month.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. So far this season, the bullpen has pitched 213 innings this year and allowed just 58 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.45. The Freddies are also 13/14 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is tied for first in all of Minor League Baseball with eight saves. The unit also worked out of major trouble a bunch on the last trip. The first five wins of the last road trip, the opposing team has had the tying and/or go-ahead runs on base in the 9th inning, and FXBG's bullpen has slammed the door each time. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (20-0), and 8 (22-0) innings.

OFTEN USED: As noted above, the FredNat bullpen has been a very strong unit this year, and the formula for winning for FXBG has been very clear. Hand a late game lead over to the bullpen, and they'll hold onto it. FXBG has five relievers in the top seven in the Carolina League in appearances this year. Thomas Schultz has the second most in the league with 15 (2nd in the league), Mason Denaburg and Samuel Vasquez both have 14 appearances (T-3rd), and Merrick Baldo and Kevin Rodriguez both have 13 (T-5th).

RBI KING: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead all of Minor League Baseball Double-A and below in RBI with 43 after he drove in nine total runs on the two-week road trip. This year, Pimentel is hitting .444 with runners in scoring position, and is 9-for-16 (.542) with runners in scoring position and two outs. Pimentel continues to be one of the best situational hitters in all of MiLB.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 19-2 this season when scoring first, including 16 out of the last 17 wins. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in the last road trip against Charleston, and Tuesday night against Myrtle Beach last week was the first time since mid-April the team won despite not scoring first.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 167-134 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI).

TONIGHT'S START: Travis Sykora is making his fourth professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans.

He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

QUICK CLIMBER: Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during the late April series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely.

Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

A BIG MENTOR: Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

LAST TIME OUT: Sykora turned in his best pro outing last week in Myrtle Beach. He carved up the Pelicans over four shutout innings, allowing one hit and one walk, while fanning six.
