### ROUGHRIDERS OUTLASTED BY SOD POODLES 6-2:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Amarillo Sod Poodles 6-2 on Friday night from Riders Field, ending a three-game winning streak. The Sod Poodles (3-10) tagged four of their six runs in the top of the first inning. Gavin Conticello hit a sacrifice fly, Christian Cerda and Caleb Roberts ripped RBI doubles, and Jose Fernandez lined an RBI single to take a 4-0 lead. Then, in the top of the third, Roberts and Fernandez laced a pair of RBI doubles to grab a 6-0 lead. Roberts finished with three of Amarillo's seven doubles. **Alejandro Osuna** plated both runs for Frisco (9-4). Osuna notched RBI groundouts in the bottom of the third and the bottom of the seventh. In that seventh inning, Frisco loaded the bases but could only cut the Amarillo lead to 6-2. The Riders bullpen sparkled with 5.2 shutout innings of work. **Nick Krauth**, **Janser Lara** and **Ryan Lobus** combined for just two hits allowed and six strikeouts. Sod Poodles starter Spencer Giesting (3-0) earned the victory, allowing one run across six innings. RoughRiders starter **Ben Anderson** (0-2) took the loss, ceding six runs over 2.2 frames.

### A RETURN TO REMEMBER:

**Janser Lara** had a great night on paper against Amarillo on Friday, but it meant even more. Over his two shutout innings, he allowed just one base runner on a walk, pitching in affiliated baseball for the first time since 2018. The 28-year-old originally signed with the Royals, pitching with Low-A Lexington in 2018 as his highest stop. After pitching in the Nicaraguan Winter League in the offseason, he signed with the Rangers in January.

### FLYING THE COOP:

**Cooper Johnson** has started out well in 2025 on both offense and defense. At the plate, he is hitting .276/.417/.655/1.072 with two doubles, three home runs, six RBIs, seven walks and five runs scored. He is tied for the league lead with three homers while being tied for fourth in both SLG and OPS. On defense, Johnson leads the Texas League with six caught stealings behind the plate, throwing out six of seven base runners against him. His 86 percent caught-stealing rate is the best in MiLB currently.

### SEVENTH INNING STRETCH THE LEAD:

For whatever reason, the RoughRiders have been fantastic on offense in the seventh inning this season. They are leading the Texas League with 17 runs scored in the seventh, while slashing .339/.467/.500/.967. In the seventh, they have walked 14 times to 10 strikeouts as a team.

### POWER BRINGS WINS:

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been amazing on offense during their first 13 games. Frisco's 15 home runs through 13 games are second in the Texas League. They are first in BA (.268), first in SLG (.431) and second in OPS (.797). **Josh Hatcher** and **Cooper Johnson** have both hit three home runs, tied for the league lead. Over this stretch where they have won seven of their last nine games, Frisco is hitting .279/.376/.465/.841, all of which are first in the Texas League, while also ranking first in runs per game (7.0) and home runs (12).

### HATCHIN' HITTIN':

**Josh Hatcher** was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he has reached safely in all nine games he's played in, batting .463 (19-for-41)/.465/.756/1.221 with three doubles, three home runs, nine RBIs, a stolen base and eight runs scored over his first nine games. His 19 hits are the most among Double-A, High-A and Low-A players and tied for 19th in all of MiLB. His .463 batting average is fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. Hatcher already has six multi-hit games and is 6-for-7 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs. Hatcher's 18 hits were the most by a Texas Leaguer through the first eight team games since five-year Major Leaguer Jesus Guzman had 19 with Midland in 2008.

### VERSUS THE SOD POODLES:

A season ago, the RoughRiders went 16-8 against Amarillo and showed off their offensive might against the Diamondbacks affiliate. The Riders as a team hit .292/.351/.494/.845 with 37 home runs in 24 games. Their 37 homers were the most against a single team since 2022, when they hit 47 in 18 games against Amarillo. **Keyber Rodriguez** crushed them in 16 games, batting .367/.433/.617/1.050 with 19 RBIs. **Josh Hatcher** (seven) and **Abimelec Ortiz** (six) both bashed six or more homers against the Sod Poodles as well.

### ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

**Abimelec Ortiz** ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz clubbed his first home run of the season on Wednesday.

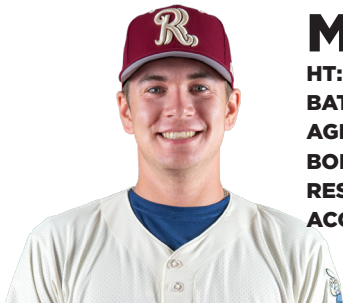

ABOUT MITCH

-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft.

-Committed to play baseball at Florida State.

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and JT Realmuto.

2025 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-Recorded RoughRiders first quality start of the season on 4/11 at NWA, allowing two runs over six innings with six strikeouts to no walks. He moved up a day in the rotation, pitching on five days rest.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.

-Dominated with Hickory while ahead in the count, allowing a .163 average and .240 slugging (as opposed to .298 average and .638 slugging when behind in the count).

-First Double-A start was 5.0 shutout innings at San Antonio on 8/1.

2023 SEASON

-Spent all of 2023 with High-A Hickory and was selected as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.

-Despite being 19 at the beginning of the season and turning 20 midway through the year, he ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.54) among those with at least 15 starts.

-Was placed on the Injured List from 7/18-8/31 with lat tightness.

-Played under Carlos Cardoza in the 2023 Arizona Fall League with the Surprise Saguaros, going 1-0 with a 6.46 ERA over six games (one start).

2022 SEASON

-Was named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star with Low-A Down East, entering the season as the youngest pitcher in the Carolina League at 18 years old.

-He finished the season third in ERA (2.45).

-Named the Rangers Starting Pitcher of the Month for July, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA.

2021 SEASON

-Bratt out 13 of 24 (54.2%) batters faced without issuing a walk over four appearances for the ACL Rangers in his professional debut.

-He recorded at least three strikeouts in each of his outings, all of which came in August or September, shortly after his 18th birthday.
