Tonight's Tilt

The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the 11th-of-18 matchups between the two teams this season and fifth-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Somerset holds a 6-4 series lead, as the teams split their first series of the season from Apr. 14-19 at TD Bank Ballpark before the Patriots jumped out to a 3-1 series lead this week. Reading returns to Somerset from July 7-12 to finish the season series.

Patriots Topple Fightins 6-5 On Friday Night

The Reading Fightin Phils lost an 6-5 shutout to the Somerset Patriots on Friday. Bryan Rincon had a home run for the Fightins, who leapt out to a 5-1 lead through the first five innings of work. The Patriots stormed back, as Somerset scored five unanswered. Jace Avina's two-run shot knotted up the game. Jackson Castillo's go-ahead RBI single put a stamp on the Patriots' third consecutive victory.

Trending In The Right Direction

At 14-16, the Fightin Phils find themselves in second place in the Eastern League-Northeast Division Standings behind only the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. Last year's team finished last, with an overall record of 55-81 (.404). Last year's team didn't claim its 14th win until May 21st, when they defeated the Portland Sea Dogs 5-1 in the front end of a twin bill. Additionally, Reading has not dropped a six-game series yet this season, with their only series loss being a three-game sweep by Akron from Apr. 2-4 to open the season.

Organizational Honors for Binelas

Reading infielder Alex Binelas has been named Phillies Minor League Hitter of the Month for April after a dominant stretch at the plate. The 25-year-old slashed .268/.403/.786 with a 1.189 OPS, going 15-for-56 with two doubles, nine home runs, 19 RBIs, 13 walks and 15 runs scored in 19 games for Double-A Reading. Among Eastern League hitters, he ranked first in slugging percentage, tied for first in home runs, second in OPS and tied for seventh in RBIs. Binelas recorded multiple homers in a game on April 16 at Somerset, marking the fifth such performance of his professional career, and added the second grand slam of his career on April 21 against New Hampshire. Binelas continued to slug with his 10th homer of the season on Wednesday night, a mark that is tied for the league lead with Marco Luciano and Garrett Martin, both of Somerset.

Bring it Bryan

Phillies No. 29 prospect Bryan Rincon stayed red-hot at the plate on Tuesday with two hits, including the second grand slam of his professional career, then followed it up with two-more hits on Wednesday night. On Friday, he smacked a solo shot down the left field line. This is the everyday shortstop's sixth home run in just the last three series alone, and it ties him with Bryson Ware for the second-best long ball tally on the team.

Aroon is Awesome

Aroon Escobar stayed red-hot at the plate for the month of May on Tuesday with four hits, including two doubles and a home run. It marked the second time in his pro career the Phillies' no. 6 prospect had four-or-more hits in a game, with the other instance coming on May 17, 2025, when he had five hits with Clearwater (A), against Lakeland. Escobar has also successfully stolen a base in all eight tries a year removed from swiping a career-best 25 in the 2025 season.

Dante The Dasher!

After being caught stealing in his first four attempts, Dante Nori has stolen seven bases in his last eight tries. The Phillies' no. 7 prospect has a 65-grade run tool (on a scale of 20-to-80) according to MLB Pipeline. His speed was on full display in 2025, as he tallied 52 stolen bases across 125 games with the Clearwater Threshers (A), Jersey Shore Blue Claws (High-A) and Reading Fightin Phils (Double-A). He also snagged a triple in last night's contest, his team-best fourth of the season.

Bringing the Boom

This week's series matches up the top-two teams in home runs across the Eastern League. Somerset has been hitting long balls at a torrid pace, as they lead the league with 60 through the season's first 31 games. Reading is in second with a still-impressive 46 home runs hit this season. When these two teams met at Somerset from Apr. 14-19, it was a home run derby at TD Bank Ballpark, with the teams combining for 23 home runs (Reading: 14 and Somerset: 9).

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 9, 2024: At Reading, the Fightin Phils are no-hit in the fifth inning, but it's broken up by a two-run home run from Kendall Simmons, in his first game back from the injured list. Reading scores six in the seventh to take the lead for good. Carlos De La Cruz hit his first home run of the season in the sixth, and follows with his second in his next at-bat in the seventh. He became the first R-Phil to hit homers in back-to-back at bats since Nick Ward did it on Aug. 10, 2023 at New Hampshire.

Sup Somerset

Somerset enters play today with a 15-16 record, which is second in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. The Patriots most recently took four-of-six at home against Portland, and after this week head back to TD Bank Ballpark and welcome Binghamton. Somerset's roster features nine of the Yankees' top-30 prospects: Ben Hess (5), Chase Hampton (8), Kyle Carr (11), Brock Selvidge (15), Cade Smith (16), Jace Avina (19), Xavier Rivas (23), Jack Cebert (25) and Eric Reyzelman (28).

Patriots Pitcher

Yankees' No. 11 prospect Kyle Carr will toe the rubber for the Patriots today. This is the fourth consecutive game where a top 30 prospect will start for the Patriots, and as a result, against the Fightin Phils. Carr is 2-3 with a 6.95 ERA through five starts this season. He was the Yankees' third round pick in the 2023 MLB Draft, selected 97th overall out of Palomar Junior College in California. The southpaw turned 24 years old just three days ago and has 259 innings of MiLB experience since entering the professional ranks.
