FROM THE CROWS NEST

AWARDS SEASON: On Monday, Major League Baseball announced that C Omar Alfonzo was named the FSL Player of the Week, becoming the first Marauder this eason to garner a weekly award. In six games last week against St. Lucie, Alfonzo went 9-for-18 with two doubles, one home run, six RBIs, five walks, two intentional walks, and five runs scored. The 20-year-old wrapped up his week reaching base five times on Sunday, going 3-for-4 at the plate with a double and two RBIs

ILIKE TURTLES: Saturday night at LECOM Park was anything but ordinary when a turtle appeared in left-centerfield in the top of the second inning to halt play. LHP Magdiel Cotto swooped in to save the day by carrying the turtle back to the bullpen before being released in a pond just beyond the outfield wall. The video has been shared by several outlets, including The Athletic, SportsCenter, Pardon My Take, Jomboy, and Sports Illustrated

WE CALL THAT A WINNING STREAK: Sunday afternoon's victory over St. Lucie marked the Marauders' 10th-straight win which set a new franchise-record. The Marauders had won won nine straight three timex before, back in 2022 and 2011. They also won five straight from 5/25/21 - 6/3/21 en route to capturing the 2021 Low-A East Championship. Bradenton had three streaks of six-plus wins last season with their longest streak lasting from April 14 - April 21 at seven games. Only the Jersey Shore Blue Claws (PHI, A+) have an active winning streak longer than Bradenton (11) which is also the longest streak in MiLB this year

KING OF THE HILLS: Since April 17, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff holds the fourth-best ERA in Minor League Baseball at 2.69 with the Eries SeaWolves (Double-A, . So far in the month of May, Bradenton has allowed just 19 earned runs in 80.0 innings, which is good for a 1.90 ERA and the third-best in MiLB. The Pensacola Blue Wahoos (MIA, Double-A), have a 1.60 ERA to lead the way with the Jersey Shore Blue Claws ahead as well at 1.80.

THE OFFENSE HAS ARRIVED: During the Marauders' 10-game winning streak, the offense has scored 66 runs for an average 6.6 per game. Overall, the team is slashing .277/.373/.445 while ranking first in the FSL in slugging percentage and second in average and second in slugging percentage. Bradenton's team batting average on the season has been raised from .176 to .207 over the past 10 games. Bradenton has also stolen 17 bases in 21 attempts during the streak, the most in the FSL and sixth-most in all of Single-A

"RALPH" KEINER DELGADO?: Keiner Delgado became the first Marauder this season to homer in back-to-back games on Thursday night. Delgado was recently acquired as the player to be named later in the JT Brubaker deal with the New York Yankees last week. The 20-year-old infielder has hit a HR in three of his six games with the Pirates organization, slugging a grand slam for the FCL Pirates in one game before earning his promotion to Single-A.

ED, ED, AND EDDY: Eddy Rodriguez's seven-game hitting streak came to an endon Sunday afternoon. The 20-year-old was 11-for-25 with three doubles, seven RBIs, four walks, and six runs scored during the streak. Rodriguez delivered a walk-off RBI single on Friday night to extend the Marauders' winning streak to eight games. The streak is tied for the team's longest this season with Omar Alfonzo.

GOT EM!: Hunter Furtado picked off Kevin Villavicencio in the eighth inning on Friday night for the Marauders 11th pickoff of the season. As of Tuesday, the Marauders are currently tied for first in MiLB, with the Fredericksburgh Nationals (Single-A, WAS), Salt Lake Bees (Triple-A, LAA), Quad Cities River Bandits (High-A, KC) who all have 11 as well. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.
