TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a 6-game set at Somerset.

LAST TIME OUT: Somerset used a pair of 3-run innings to secure an 8-4 win in the series opener. Liover Peguero and Abrahan Gutierrez each homered in the loss.

FATHER ABRAHAN: In place of the promoted Henry Davis, Altoona welcomed C Abrahan Gutierrez to the roster for their series at Richmond. Gutierrez reached base safely in 5-of-6 games played including 2 2B, 2 HR and 3 RBI, including a game tying 2-run homer on Sunday, June 11 to aid Altoona to a 5-4 comeback win in 10 innings. Gutierrez was acquired from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for LHP Braeden Ogle in July of 2021 and the two worked as the battery on Friday, June 9

COMEBACK KIDS: Altoona picked up 3 wins in their series at Richmond and each time rallied from a deficit after 7 innings. The Curve stand 1.0 game clear of Erie in the Southwest Division with 13 games to play in the First Half.

PEGGY'S POP: Infielder Liover Pequero enters play on June 14 as one of the league's top hitters this month, he is 9th in the Eastern League batting average with a .341 mark and reached base safely in 11 straight games (5/31 - Present).

MACGREGOR CARRIES CURVE TO GETAWAY DAY WIN: On Sunday, June 11 at Richmond, Travis MacGregor struck out 3 straight hitters in the bottom of the 9th inning and stranded the tying run placed at second in the 10th to secure a 5-4 win over the Flyings Squirrels. It was his second straight outing where he tossed 3.0 scoreless innings with 5 K's. In his last 10 G (one start), he is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (21.0ip/3er) and 27 strikeouts. <u>MacGregor leads all Eastern League relievers with 43</u> strikeouts in 32.1 innings (that also ranks fourth among all Double-A relievers and 16th-most in MiLB).

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Wednesday, June 14, Altoona has struck out 460 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 3rd fewest in minor league baseball. In their series at Richmond beginning on June 4, the Curve struck out 62 times (including 4 games with 10 or more) one shy of a season-high in a six-game series.

WE'LL TAKE TWO: Altoona is 2nd among all Double-A teams with 54 double plays turned.

A BID FOR THE AGES: Altoona right-hander Jared Jones carried a no-hit bid into the 7th inning on Thursday, June 8 at Richmond. Jones allowed just one walk and hit one batter in his first six innings before Brandon Martorano swatted a solo homer to left field to leadoff the 7th inning. <u>Jones is now ranked as the No. 89 prospect in all of minor league baseball ac</u> cording to Baseball America.

HAMMERING HANK HEADS TO INDY: C Henry Davis, who had at least one hit in 17-of-22 games in May and had his first two career multi-homer games was promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on Tuesday, June 5. <u>Davis' .980 OPS is 3rd-best among all</u> Double-A players and he reached base safely in 37-of-41 games with Altoona.

PROSPECT PARTY: The Curve roster features several top Pirates prospects according to MLB Pipeline led by No. 6 INF **Liover Peguero**, No. 11 RHP **Jared Jones**, No. 17 OF **Matt Gorski**, No. 20 RHP **Kyle Nicolas**, and No. 23 OF **Matt Fraizer**.

THE PATRIOTS ARE THE YANKEES?: Fresh off an Eastern League championship in just their second season of play as the Yankees Eastern League affiliate, Somerset enters the series in the thick of the First Half Championship race. Their roster has some top Yankees farmhands according to Pipeline: No. 1 OF Jasson Dominguez, No. 2 C Austin Wells, No. 4 OF Everson Pereira, No. 5 INF Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Richard Fitts, No. 9 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, and No. 13 RHP Clayton Beeter.

A PATRIOT ON THE 'SET: Signed in 2020 out of Nevada, RHP Blane Abeyta takes the ball on Wednesday night for the Patriots. Abeyta had a spectacular performance on May 14 when he struck out 10 batters in 6.0 innings at Portland and is coming off his best performance of the season last Thursday at Hartford where he struck out 11 in 6.2 IP, however, he did allow 5 runs for the 3rd time this season. He attended Cares HS (CA) and lists Roy Halladay as his sports hero, but has spoken about how much his grandfather (Gilbert) has done for him in aiding his baseball journey to local media.

2023: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Struck out 6 in 4.2 in his Double-A Debut on April 8 vs. New Hampshire... Matched his career-high with 4 BB on 4/14 @ Erie... Allowed 2 R or fewer in each of his first 9 starts... Placed on 7-day IL on 4/23 (retro 4/21) with lower back spasms, activated on 5/10 for 11 a.m. start vs. Akron... Struck out a season-high 7 batters in 4.0 innings on 5/16 at Bowie... Carried a no-hit bid into the 7th inning on 6/8 @ RIC...

**2022:** Spent the entire season with High-A Greensboro where he <u>led the South Atlantic League and Pirates minor leaguers with 26 starts and 142 strikeouts</u>... Also ranked second among Pirates minor leaguers in innings (122.2) and walks (51)... His 142 strikeouts were the most by a Pirates minor leaguer since Luis Escobar recorded 168 strikeouts during the 2017 season... Improved his walk rate from 4.64/9 innings in 2021 to 3.74/9 during the season... Held his opponent to two runs or fewer in 13-of-26 starts... Struck out at least six batters in four of his five outings of the season... Struck out a season-high 10 batters across 5.0 innings on 5/28 at Ashville... CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2020 First- Year Player Draft out of La Mirada High School (CA)... Signed on July 2, 2020

CURVE CUTS: Jared Keith Jones... His father, Keith, was drafted by Arizona in 1997 and spent two seasons in their system as an infielder... Selected by the Pirates 13 picks after Carmen Mlodzinski in the 2020 MLB Draft and signed with the Pirates for a bonus of \$2,200,000... Played outfield and pitched in high school and was viewed by scouts as one of the best athletes in the high school class of the 2020 draft... Was committed to play collegiately at the University of Texas... Added the curveball to his pitch mix during the COVID-19 shutdown in the spring and summer of 2020... In his final full high school season in 2019 was named the Whittier Daily News' Player of the Year after leading his team to the CIF-SS Division Semifinals with a 7-1 record and a 0.77 ERA, also hit .457 at the plate... Three times during his amateur career was a member of USA Baseball's Junior National Teams... Was Named the 2019 Perfect Game/Rawlings National High School Two-Way Player of the Year...
