WEDNESDAY: The Flying Squirrels fell for the third straight game with a 6-2 loss to the Rumble Ponies. The Flying Squirrels opened the scoring in the first inning with a two-out RBI triple by **Frankie Tostado**. In the top of the second, Binghamton evened the score on an error. The Rumble Ponies pulled ahead with an RBI single by Nick Meyer in the third. Later in the inning, Quinn Brodey hit an RBI single and Will Toffey added a two-run single to open a 5-1 lead. **Vince Fernandez** hit an RBI single in the third to bring Richmond back within three runs, one of his three hits in the game. Yoel Romero pushed the Binghamton lead to 6-2 with an RBI double in the fifth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third and fourth of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This series marks the only trip to The Diamond for the Rumble Ponies this year. The Flying Squirrels play in Binghamton from August 31-September 5.

DOUBLE DIP: The Flying Squirrels are playing their fifth double-header of the 2021 season. In their previous four, they have combined to go 7-1, including double-header sweeps on May 8 against Hartford, May 29 at Reading and June 10 against Harrisburg. Dating back to August 28, 2019, the Flying Squirrels are 9-1 in their last 10 double-header games. Binghamton has played two double-headers this year, both at New Hampshire, picked up a sweep in the first and being swept in the second.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost three straight and four of the last five games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 5.5 games behind first-place Erie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .233 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked fourth in the league with a 3.77 ERA for the season.

THE RUMBLE PONIES have won four straight games after dropping their previous three. The Rumble Ponies started the season 0-10 before picking up their first win on May 16 against Altoona. They lost seven of the next eight to begin the year with a 2-17 record through May 26. For the year, the Rumble Ponies are ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast with a .236 batting average. The Binghamton pitching staff is ranked 10th in the league with a 5.24 ERA this year. Binghamton's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 New York Mets prospects, including 3B Mark Vientos (8), RHP Ryley Gilliam (16), 2B/OF Carlos Cortes (17), RHP Oscar De La Cruz (23) and OF Jake Mangum (30). Binghamton's Mark Vientos is ranked tied for third in the league with 12 homers, fifth with a .586 SLG and seventh with a .930 OPS. Carlos Cortes is ranked eighth in the league with 33 RBIs, eighth with a .561 SLG, ninth with a .918 OPS, tied for seventh with 50 hits, tied for second with 18 doubles, first with 28 extra-base hits and third with 97 total bases.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Akeel Morris** makes his third start for Richmond and his first at The Diamond in Game 1. In his last start on Friday at Hartford, Morris allowed seven runs over 5.0 innings with seven strikeouts in a no-decision. He signed with the San Francisco Giants on June 19 from the independent Long Island Ducks, where he made two starts and combined for 11.0 scoreless innings of work. Morris, a native of St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, was drafted by the New York Mets in the 10th round in 2010 and reached the big leagues with them for the first time in 2015. He has also appeared in the majors with the Atlanta Braves and the Los Angeles Angels. After reaching free agency following the 2018 season, Morris signed with the High Point Rockers of the independent Atlantic League to begin the 2019 season, where he pitched as a reliever. He was traded to the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs and then swapped again before making an appearance to the New Britain Bees, where he finished the year going 7-4 with a 4.94 ERA in 16 outings (13 starts). **For more on Morris, see page two.**

Left-hander **Michael Plassmeyer** makes fourth Richmond start in Game 2 and his home debut. He last pitched on last Saturday at Hartford and worked six scoreless innings. Plassmeyer was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the San Francisco Giants on June 11 in exchange for right-handed pitcher Matt Wisler. He began the season with Double-A Montgomery in the Double-A South. In his first four outings of the year, he went 0-1 with a 7.36 ERA (12 ER/14.2 IP). In his last three outings before the trade, all in relief, he combined for a 2-0 record over 15.0 scoreless innings with 18 strikeouts and two walks. Plassmeyer was originally drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round in 2018 out of the University of Missouri, but he was traded to Tampa Bay after one professional season along with catcher Mike Zunino and outfielder Guillermo Heredia for outfielders Mallex Smith and Jake Fraley. In his first season with the Rays organization in 2019, his first full professional season, Plassmeyer posted a 1.91 overall ERA, which was the third-lowest for a pitcher in Tampa Bay's minor league system in the history of the franchise, trailing only a 1.41 ERA by Blake Snell in 2015 and a 1.77 ERA by Dylan Florio in 2013. **For more on Plassmeyer, see page three.**

FOR BINGHAMTON: Left-hander Josh Walker makes his sixth start of the season at Double-A in Game 1. Last time out, he picked up a win at Reading after throwing six innings, combining for a no-hitter with Andrew Mitchell last Tuesday. It was the seventh no-hitter in Binghamton's franchise history. The no-hitter was the second in the Double-A Northeast this year, joining Richmond's performance on May 13 at Harrisburg. Walker was drafted by the New York Mets in the 37th round in 2017 out of New Haven. He began this season with High-A Brooklyn, going 3-0 with a 2.57 ERA in four starts.

Right-hander Cole Gordon makes his fifth start of the season and his 12th overall appearance in Game 2. In his most recent outing last Friday at Reading, he tossed a season-high 6.1 innings and picked up a season-best five strikeouts in a no-decision. He began the year as a reliever with Binghamton, posting a 4.38 ERA in seven games. He moved to the starter rotation on June 5 and has gone 0-1 with a 3.52 ERA in four starts.

TOASTY: Over his last 19 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .333 (25-for-75) with four homers, six doubles and 20 RBIs. He is first on the team this season with 30 RBIs. He is also first among qualified Richmond batters with a .286 batting average on the year. Last Friday, Tostado recorded a season-high four hits, became the first Richmond player this year to record five RBIs in a single game, and he clubbed a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the ninth. On Saturday, he mashed a go-ahead, two-run homer in the ninth inning for the second straight game. Tostado is currently riding a five-game hit streak and has at least one extra-base hit in each of those games.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over his last 22 games since June 1, **Sando Fabian** is batting .324 (22-for-68) with three homers, six doubles and 17 RBIs while scoring eight runs. He hit a two-run homer in the series finale at Hartford on Sunday, his fifth longball of the season. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .265.

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, **David Villar** has hit .367 (18-for-49) with five homers and 10 RBIs over his last 13 games since June 16. In the last series against Hartford, Villar hit three homers. For the season, Villar leads the Flying Squirrels and ranks tied for eighth in the league with 10 home runs.

SIMON SAYS: **Simon Whiteman** started his Double-A career 0-for-17 in his first four games from June 15-18 after being promoted from High-A Richmond. In his last 10 games since June 19, Whiteman is batting .300 (12-for-40) with 10 singles and two doubles. In that stretch, he has collected multiple hits in five games, including a Double-A-high three singles last Friday night. Since joining the Flying Squirrels, Whiteman has picked up six stolen bases, which is tied for the team lead this season. He has gone 1-for-12 in his last three games.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 26-24 record is the tied for the third-best start in team history through 50 games, even with 2014 and trailing only a 27-23 start in the franchise's inaugural season in 2010 and in 2018. Both of those years, the team posted a 27-24 mark through 51 games, which the Flying Squirrels can match with a win tonight.

LAW OF AVERAGES: The 12 teams in the Double-A Northeast have combined to hit .243 this season. In 2019, the Eastern League combined for a .238 batting average, which was the lowest for the circuit since a .234 mark in 1971 and the sixth-lowest since the league was first classified as "Double-A" in 1963.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with six RBIs by pitchers at the plate. Flying Squirrels pitchers have eight hits this year, which is tied for first in the league with Reading. On the year, Richmond has gone 23-14 (.622) against National League affiliates, but have gone 3-9 (.333) against affiliates of American League clubs. Pitchers returned to the batter's box for last week's set against Hartford and continue to hit this week against Binghamton. After July 4, the Flying Squirrels will return to using the DH for the remaining four series in July.

JUNE WRAP: For the month of June, the Flying Squirrels went 11-15, the second-worst record in the Double-A Northeast. On the offensive side, **David Villar** ranked fourth in the league with 21 runs scored. **Shane Matheny** was tied for seventh in the league with 13 walks. **Simon Whiteman** was tied for fourth in the league with six stolen bases. Among qualified pitchers, **Caleb Kilian** ranked second with a 2.67 ERA, seventh with 31 strikeouts, tied for first with one complete game, third with 3.01 innings pitched, fourth with a .232 BAA, third with a 0.99 WHIP and tied for first with a 1.000 winning percentage. **Trenton Toplikar** ranked seventh with a 5.70 ERA, 10th with 29 strikeouts, first with six games started, fourth with 30.0 innings pitched, eighth with a .309 BAA and eighth with a 1.53. **Frank Rubio** finished the month ranked tied for fourth with 10 appearances in June.
