LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned its 9th win in 11 games in a 7-4 victory at Hudson Valley on tuesday night...Cyclones took a 4-1 lead in the 2nd inning thanks to a pair of 2-run homer runs by 18 Mateo Gil and LF Rhylan Thomas...Brooklyn tallied 3 more in the 4th on RBI doubles by SS César Berbesi and C Kevin Parada, plus a stolen base and throwing error...Parada picked up a pair of doubles on the night, while Gil tallied a double in addition to the long ball...Thom-as accrued a multi-hit performance, as well...RHP Cameron Foster hurled a career-high 7.0 innings, striking out 7, earning his 4th win...LHP EII Ankeney struck out 3 in the 8th and RHP Paul Gervase pitched a perfect 9th for his 4th save...CF Spencer Jones collected 2 hits and a solo home run for Hudson Valley.

THE .500 CLUB: With Brooklyn's victory on Tuesday night, the Cyclones returned to .500 on the season at 42-42...lt was the second time since Saturday the 'Clones were at the .500 mark since they were 2-2 following a 5-3 defeat at Winston-Salem on April 11...Brooklyn has not been over .500 since the 3rd game of the season...The Cyclones moved to 2-1 with a 4-2 win vs. Jersey Shore to close out the season-opening homestand on April 9.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn's season-high 5-game winning streak came to a close on July 8 at Wilmington...Alas, the team has won 8-of-10 and 14-of-19 going into Tuesday's contest...The Cyclones are 13-5 in the second half and lead the North Division of the SAL by 1.5 games over Aberdeen (11-6)...Brooklyn is 1.5 games behind Hickory (14-3) for the best record in the circuit during the half...The 5-game streak was the longest for the 'Clones since they won 6-straight from September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem.

SUPER STAFF: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball... Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 2.71 ERA (139 ER in 462.0 IP) over their last 53 games, holding a 31-22 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.06) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 6 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.4% and a walk rate of 11.3%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted 4 fewer home runs (16) than any other squad and holds the lowest opposing OPS (.595), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.64) in that time period...RHPs Tyler Stuart (1.62) and Blade Tidwell (1.73) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 50.0 IP).

RED HOT RELIEF: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023... Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.13) in the entire South Atlantic League and 2nd-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.09) is 2nd in MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.42) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones are also 3rd in MiLB in hits-per-9 innings (6.80) and 6th in opposing OPS (.640).

BANANA'S FOR FOSTER: RHP Cameron Foster has found his groove on the bump over the last few weeks...Since the start of June, the 24-year-old holds a 2-0 record with a 2.51 ERA (8 ER in 28.2 IP) with 10 walks and 31 strikeouts over 6 starts...Foster's strikeout rate is up 3.6% from his overall numbers (26.5% from 22.9%) and his walk rate is down 1.5% (8.5% from 10.0%)...Since his start on June 6, the right-hander is 7th in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.51) and 10th in opposing OPS (.601) (min 25.0 IP).

ACE GERVASE: RHP Paul Gervase has been as dominant as any relief pitcher in Minor League Baseball in 2023...Through 23 relief appearances, the 23-year-old is 1st and 3rd in ERA (1.23) among SAL and MiLB relievers, respectively (min. 35.0 IP)....The 2022 12th-round pick is 2nd in MiLB in opposing batting average (.130) and 7th in opposing OPS (.514) and strikeouts-per-9 innings (13.99)...Since June 6, Gervase holds a 0.60 ERA (1 ER in 15.0 IP) with a hold and 3 saves over 10 relief outings...In MiLB, the former Louisiana State arm is tied for 2nd among MiLB relievers (min 15.0 IP) in hits allowed (2), 3rd in opposing batting average (.100) and strikeouts-per-9 innings (16.20), 7th in ERA (0.60) and opposing OPS (.382), tied for 10th in strikeouts (27)...He holds a strikeout rate of 44.3% in that time.

PARADA POWER: C Kevin Parada registered his 2nd multi-home run game of the season on Saturday, tallying solo shots in the 1st and 5th innings...The Pasadena, Calif. native also accrued multiple blasts on June 23 vs. Hudson Valley...Kevin poked a solo home run in the 3rd and a 2-run inside-the-parker in the 6th...Since 2005, Parada is 1 of 2 Cyclones to record a pair multi-homer games in the same season...INF Mick Evans powered a pair of jacks on July 22, 2005, vs. Jamestown and again on August 24, 2005, at Williamsport...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .319/.388/.595 with a .983 OPS and 162 wRC+ in 30 games...Parada has accrued 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 7 home runs, 20 RBI, 10 walks, and 2 hit-by-pitches...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Wednesday ranked 5th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (33), total bases (136), and hits (79), and doubles (19), and 10th in OPS (.828)...Since June 6, Parada is tied for 1st in triples (3), 2nd in total bases (69), 4th in slugging (.595), tied for 4th in hits (37) and extra-base hits (15), tied for 5th in home runs (7), 6th in OPS (.983), and 7th in batting average (.319).

LUGO LAND: INF William Lugo has been scalding hot with the bat over the last few weeks... Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .339/.417/.645 with a 1.062 OPS and a 180 wRC+...In 17 games, Lugo is hitting .339 (21-62) with 9 runs scored, 5 doubles, a triple, 4 home runs, 15 RBI, and 8 walks (111 BB%) to only 10 strikeouts (13.9 K%)...In that time, the right-handed swinger has raised his batting average by 44 points (181 to .225)...Among SAL players with 70 or more plate appearances, Lugo is 4th in slugging percentage (.645) and OPS (1.062), 6th in RBI (15), tied for 6th in total bases (40), 7th in batting average (.339)in that time frame...Lugo has also reached base safely in all 11 games played during the month of July.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn collected their 7th shutout win of the season with a 3-0 blanking of Greensboro on Saturday...7 different pitchers combined on the shutout...RHPs Jordany Ventura (2.0 IP), Robert Colina (2.0), Luis Montas (1.0), Joshua Cornielly (1.0), Manny Rodríguez (1.0), Wilkin Ramos (1.0), and Dylan Hall (1.0)...It was the Cyclones' first shutout since a 2-0 victory vs. Hudson Valley on June 24...Brooklyn has matched their shutout total from 2022 (7)...The last time Brooklyn accrued more than 7 shutouts in a season was when they tallied 10 in 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014.

CUTTING 'EM DOWN: RHP Blade Tidwell is amid his best stretch of baseball in 2023...Tidwell has earned the win in 4 of his last 5 outings with Brooklyn winning all 5 games...He has permitted just 6 runs on 21 hits over 31.2 innings...He has walked only 7 (5.8 BB%) and struck out 43 (35.8 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...This

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns to the road to open a 6-game road trip against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades posses 3 of new York's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF Spencer Jones (7), RHP Drew Thorpe (8), and C Antonio Gómez (29)... Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time in 2023...Brooklyn captured the first series at Heritage Financial Park from May 16-21 and the first meeting on Coney Island from June 20-25...The Cyclones went 4-2 in both sets, taking 4-straight games to close out the most recent series...The Cyclones are 134-138 (.493) all-time against the Renegades dating back to their inaugural season in 2001.

comes after tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 10 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 6-0 with a 1.73 ERA (10 ER in 52.0 IP) with just 31 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 27 and struck out 76 (36.2 k%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .169 batting average (31-182) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League and Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (76) by 2 over Hudson Valley's RHP **Drew Thorpe** (74)...He also leads in batting average against (170) and 3rd in ERA (1.73) since that date (min. 50.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native leads in batting average against (.196), is tied for 3rd in wins (6), and 4th in strikeouts (103) and ERA (3.45).

OMAR KEEPS SWIPING: OF Omar De Los Santos stole a pair of bags on July 9 at Wilmington and has 32 stolen bases in 2023...The 32 swipes match INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also tied for 2nd in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 102 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in Mil.B...Only D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (108), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (107), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (107), and Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (104) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 60 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 42.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 16th come-from-behind victory of the 2023 season with a 7-4 win at Hudson Valley on Tuesday night...The Cyclones accrued 4 comeback wins during the pre-All-Star-break series at Wilmington...July 7's win was Brooklyn's first in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings...It marked the 'Clones first victory when trailing after 8 frames since August 14, 2022, at Wilmington...Brooklyn erased a 5-4 deficit entering the 9th that night on a 2-run pinch-hit home run by C Matt O'Neill...The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on Tuesday, matching their largest deficit erased on the campaign...The 'Clones erased a 4-0 margin entering the 5th and a 4-1 deficit going into the 7th...Brooklyn also erased a 4-run ledger on Opening Day — April 7 — vs. Jersey Shore...The Cyclones trailed 4-0 after the 1st inning that day, ultimately topping the BlueClaws, 9-8, in 11 innings.

AL-WAYS ON: OF **Alex Ramírez** is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in walks (24) and runs scored (26), and 4th in pitches-per-plate appearance (4.000) since the beginning of June (min. 150 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Tuesday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (71) and is 20 behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He is also tied for 2nd in doubles (30) with INF **Walter Rasquin**, 3rd in hits (127), and 5th in total bases (189), and runs scored (66).

SHUCKED: RHP Joshua Cornielly has hit his stride over the last 2-plus months for the Cyclones' bullpen...Since allowing 5 runs in 0.1 innings on April 15 at Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has been as consistent as any relief arm on the staff...Dating back to April 21 vs. Wilmington, Cornielly holds a 2-1 record with a 182 ERA (6 ER in 29.2 IP) in 16 appearances (1 start)...The Caraças, Venezuela native has permitted 25 hits, walked 10 (8.1 BB%), and struck out 36 (29.3 K%)...Among South Atlantic League relievers with one or fewer starts since that date, Cornielly ranks 3rd in the league in ERA (1.82) trailing only Bowling Green's RHP **Pate Dahle** (1.04) and teammate RHP **Paul Gervase** (1.48)...He is also 8th in walks-per-9 innings (3.03) and walk-to-strikeout rate (278).

LOVE THE DRAKEI: C Drake Osborn was unconscious at the plate in 5 games played during Brooklyn's series in Wilmington...The 24-year-old matched a career-high in hits (3) in consecutive contests to open the set...Osborn was 8-for-19 (.421) against the Blue Rocks with 4 runs scored, a double, 2 RBI, and a walk...Drake has reached base safely in each of his last 7 starts dating back to July 3 and, overall, is 9-for-his-last-27 (.333) with a .438 on-base percentage and a .845 OPS.

BENI, VIDI, VICI: RHP **Benito García** has been as reliable as any Cyclones reliever over the last month...Dating back to June 9 vs. Greenville, the 23-year-old has tallied 6-consecutive scoreless relief appearances...In 71 innings, García has earned a save and permitted just 6 hits and 1 walk, while striking out 7...The right-hander holds a 25.9% strikeout rate (7/27) and 3.7% walk rate (1/27) during that span...In 10 relief outings with Brooklyn in 2023, García holds a 1.26 ERA (2 ER in 14.1 IP).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...7 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), RHP Tyler Stuart (18), and RHP Jordany Ventura (22)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Copey Island

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win in relief on Saturday evening vs. Greensboro...Entered in support of starter RHP Jordany Ventura after a 44-minute lightning delay in the top of the 3rd and Brooklyn leading 2-0...Did not allow a run on 1 hit over 2.0 innings...Did not permit a walk and struck out 1...Tossed 20 pitches and 14 strikes (70.0%)...Relieved by RHP Luis Montas in the top of the 5th and the Cyclones still in front, 2-0...Ventura, Colina, Montas (1.0 IP), RHP Joshua Cornielly (1.0), RHP Manny Rodríguez (1.0), RHP Wilkin Ramos (1.0), and RHP Dylan Hall (1.0) combined on a 3-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 3-0 win.

THE ROCO SHOW: The right-hander struck out a season-high 7 on June 21 vs. Hudson Valley and has been on a tear since...Over his last 4 appearances, all out of the bullpen, Colina holds a 2-0 record with a 0.87 ERA (1 ER in 10.1 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 7 hits and walked 3 with 14 strikeouts...Colina's strikeout rate is up 6.6 percent (34.1 K%) and walk rate is down 1.4 percent (7.3 BB%) during the time span.

ALWAYS MOVING: Colina has already pitched at 3 separate levels in 2023...The 22-year-old was assigned to Single-A St. Lucie to start the season...After making 1 appearance, Colina was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on April 16...Earned the win in his lone outing for the Rumble Ponies on April 18...He was transferred to Brooklyn on April 24.

2022: Split the season between St. Lucie and the Florida Complex League...Assigned to St. Lucie on May 2...Returned to the FCL on May 10 and reported back to St. Lucie on May 23...Registered an 0-5 record with a 7.99 ERA (29 ER in 32.2 IP) and 41 K's in 10 appearances (6 starts) in the Florida State League...Joined the FCL club for the remainder of the season on July 19...Posted a 1-0 mark with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER in 17.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts in 4 outings (2 starts).

STARTING TIME: Colina expects to make his 2nd start of the 2023 season after pitching in relief during his inital 10 of his first 11 appearances...Last season, the 22-year-old started in 8 of his 14 outings...In a starting role in 2022, Colina held a 1-3 record with a 5.56 ERA (21 ER in 34.0 IP) in 8 starts...He held a walk rate of 7.3% and a strikeout rate of 28.7%...In 4 relief appearances, the Punto Fijo, VZ native was 0-2 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER in 15.2 IP)...Colina's walk rate was 12.7% and strikeout rate hovered at 28.2%.
