READY FREDDY: Freddy Zamora extended his hitting streak to five games and on-base streak to six games with a base hit in the bottom of the fourth inning against the Knights on Friday. Zamora's hitting streak is currently the longest on the team, and his on-base streak is the second-longest. During his hitting streak, Zamora is 7-for-18 (.389) with four RBI and three runs. Zamora is having a stellar July with a .300/.379/.420 slash line. He also has notched nine RBI, 10 runs, and an OPS of .799

CHAD IT UP: Despite allowing three runs (two earned) in the top of the first inning, right-hander Chad Patrick found a way to keep the Sounds in the game during his third Triple-A start of the season. Patrick tossed 4.0 scoreless frames with eight strikeouts after the first. Overall, the 26-year-old finished the game allowing just one hit and two earned runs over 5.0 frames. It is the 10th time in a row, including his appearances with the Milwaukee Brewers, that Patrick has gone 5.0 or more innings this year. This is the second-longest streak of his professional career, with the longest being 11 with Nashville that occurred from 4/19/24-6/21/24 as he went on to win International League Pitcher of the Year.

SHUT IT DOWN: On Friday, the Sounds were shut out for a second time in a row with a 3-0 loss to Charlotte. It was the fourth time this season Nashville's offense went scoreless in a game and the third in time in the last 30 days, going back to an 8-0 loss on June 28th to the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. The last time the Sounds were shut out in back-to-back games was July 31-August 1 against Columbus. Over the past two games, Nashville hitters are 8-for-60 (.133) with one extra-base hit and a combined 0-for-9 hitting with RISP and have left 13 runners on base.

DYNAMIC DUO: Daz Cameron and Bobby Dalbec have been arguably the two best hitters in the Nashville offense against the Charlotte Knights this week. On Friday, that narrative stayed the same, as both players reached base. The two walks issued to Cameron extended his on-base streak to a season-high 10 games. Cameron is now 5-for-15 with a home run and four runs, while Dalbec is 5-for-17 with three homers and five RBI. Combined, the two are 10-for-31 with four home runs, which makes up for more than half of Nashville's long balls this week.

SELL ME THIS PEN: The Nashville bullpen has been one of the best 'pens in the International League for the 2025 season. Rob Zastryzny, Jesus Liranzo, Will Childers, and Justin Yeager combined to toss 4.0 scoreless innings after Chad Patrick's start on Friday. Overall, the bullpen ranks top five in ERA (3.97), home runs allowed (31), walks (186), and saves (26) this season. Over the last two nights, the Sounds bullpen has thrown 7.1 scoreless frames.

THE YOHO YO-YO: Brewers no. 19-rated prospect Crieg Yoho worked his 10th consecutive appearance without allowing an earned run after pitching a 1-2-3 top of the ninth with a pair of strikeouts. His current 10-game streak is the sixth-best active streak going in the International League and the third-longest streak for a Nashville pitcher this year behind the 15 games Tyler Jay had from April 17-June 15 and the 12-game streak Yoho posted to begin the 2025 season. In 29 appearances this year, Yoho is 3-1 with a 0.84 ERA over 32.0 IP (3 ER) and has 39 strikeouts while converting on six-of-eight save opportunities. Since making his Triple-A debut on August 9, 2024, Yoho has allowed an earned run in just four games over 43 appearances and only one game with more than one earned run.

GET NASHTY: Rehabbing Nestor Cortes suffered the loss despite turning in 5.2 IP with four hits allowed and two runs (1 ER) on Thursday night. The southpaw struck out his season-high of nine batters. The nine strikeouts are tied for the second-most by a Nashville pitcher this year along with Jacob Misiorowski (4/27 vs. DUR) and Tobias Myers (6/5 vs. GWN). Jacob Misiorowski set the season-high for a Nashville pitcher with 11 strikeouts on May 9 vs. Norfolk. It's the only double-digit strikeout performance for a Sounds pitcher this season. Cortes had four different nine strikeout games during the 2024 season for his season-high with his last coming in his second to last start of the regular season on September 12 against the Red Sox. The nine strikeouts are tied for the most he has had in a game since October 1, 2022, when he tied his career-high with 12 strikeouts.

BOBBY BARRELS: Bobby Dalbec swatted his 10th and 11th long-balls of the season with Nashville and his 15th overall in Triple-A this year on Wednesday. Dalbec had two-out, two-RBI, 409-ft shot to left field off Noah Syndergaard in his first plate appearance of the night. After hitting a home run last night in the series opener, Wednesday night was the second time Dalbec has homered in back-to-back games this season. He also did it June 15-17 with three homers in a nine at-bat span. He joins Jorge Alfaro (3x) Daz Cameron (2x), and Jared Oliva (2x) as Sounds players to have a home run in back-to-back games multiple times this year. **It was the 25th time in his professional career with home runs in consecutive games** and has done it multiple times in each of the last five seasons. His solo blast in the fourth off Syndergaard gave him his **20th career multi-HR game**. He joined Daz Cameron as the other Nashville player with more than one multi-HR game in 2025. His 41 RBI in 56 games since playing his first with Nashville on May 14th are the sixth-most in the International League over the span.

- Made his Major League debut in 2025 and tossed a quality start in his first career start (6.0 IP, 3 H, ER, HR, 9 K, BB) against the Athletics...Through first four MLB starts is 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (14 H, 4 ER, 29 K, 6 BB)...One of two MLB pitchers since 1901 to have struck out at least 29 and allowed four or fewer runs through first four MLB starts...Joined fellow Brewer Freddy Peralta.
- Got a late start to his 2024 season after injuring his oblique during the 2024 Spring Breakout Game...Made his season debut on May 9th in the Arizona Complex League.
- Earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month as well as Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2024 after going 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA in four starts...Held opposing hitter to a .192 AVG and matched his single-game career-high with 10 strikeouts in two of his outings (6/15 vs. TEN and 6/28 vs. PNS).
- From the time of his first start with High-A Wisconsin on May 24th until he was promoted to Nashville (8/8) he led the Brewers farm system with his 78 strikeouts.
- Made his Triple-A debut on 8/9/24 and allowed one run on three hits over 4.0 IP but took the loss...Tossed a quality start in his second game vs. DUR (6.0 IP, 0 R, 8 K, 3 H).
- Finished the 2024 season 8th in the Milwaukee farm system in strikeouts (104) and was T-8th in wins (7)...Added to the Brewers 40-man roster on November 19th. 35.2% strikeout rate was fourth best among 661 minor leaguers with at least 70.0 IP in 2023.
- Missed the majority of 2022 after undergoing non-Tommy John elbow surgery in the spring.
- Pitched one season at McLennan CC in Texas and was named NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA in 17 games (14 GS)...Led NJCAA DI in strikeouts (169) and IP (97.2)...Struck out 17 over 8.0 IP with one run allowed to guide the Highlanders to their first championship since 1983.
