NEWS & NOTES

THE BIRDS ARE BACK IN TOWN: The Hudson Valley Renegades welcome Wilmington. The 10 walks in a game are tied for the 12th most in the South in the Aberdeen IronBirds for their third of four series meetings this season. Atlantic League this year with the Bowling Green Hot Rods (TB) leading the The Renegades made their lone visit to Maryland earlier in May, splitting the series. After the six game set this week, the two sides won't face each (TEX) back on April 21st. other again until the end of August.

IT'S CIDER SEASON: Saturday is the first game this season the Renegades take on their alternate identity, the Cider Donuts. Unveiled as a new alternate identity in November, the Renegades are paying tribute to the fall favorite, invented right here in the Hudson Valley. Every game throughout the season features fresh-made apple cider donuts at the ballpark, and the Renegades are selling special merchandise including scented hats, sweatshirts and hoodies at the team store.

LAST TIME OUT: The Aberdeen IronBirds outlasted the Hudson Valley Renegades 2-1 in 12 innings on Friday night. **Juan Carela** recorded a career-high 10 strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work. The only blemish was an insidethe-park home run by Dylan Beavers in the seventh. **Spencer Jones** singled home the Renegades' lone run in the third inning. **Nick Paciorek** and **Ryan** Anderson each 2.0+ innings without allowing an earned run in the loss.

REHAB-PALOOZA: On Tuesday, LHP Josh Maciejewski commenced a Minor League rehab assignment with the Renegades, becoming the second Minor League rehabber on the team, joining **C Josh Breaux**, who began his rehab on Saturday, May 27. This is the first time in the Yankees Era (2021-Present) that the Renegades have had two rehabbers on the team at the same time.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: Hudson Valley's bullpen has been nails during the current series with Aberdeen Across the first four games of the series Renegades relievers have combined for a 0.95 ERA (19.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/2 ER, 9 BB, 24 K). Between Wednesday and Friday night's games, the bullpen retired 20 consecutive batters at one point. Over the last 11.1 innings, the bullpen has allowed just three walks and has yet to allow a hit. The last Aberdeen hit came in the seventh inning on Wednesday by Jacob Teter

BIG WINS AND LOSSES: The Renegades have already played in an extraordinary number of lopsided games this season, with 21 of the team's 48 games (44.6%) being decided by 5-or-more runs.

- Hudson Valley sports a 11-10 (.523) record in game decided by 5+ runs. The club has already played six games decided by 11-or-more runs,
- and has a 3-3 (.500) record in those games. The 'Gades have also played nine one-run games, and are 3-8 (.273).

WALK FEST: On Wednesday, the Renegades pitching staff collectively walked 10 IronBirds hitters setting a new season-high. The team had walked nine batters three times this season including twice last week in

SPENCE HENCE: Spencer Henson's season-long eight-game hitting streak was snapped on Friday night against Aberdeen. Over the course of the streak, Henson hit .366/.488/.854 with two doubles, a home run, and four RBIs. The 'Gades infielder tallied a multi-hit game in four out of the eight contests, including a season-high four against Wilmington on May 24th.

DOUBLE OR NOTHING: Spencer Jones collected his 16th double of the season on Thursday versus Aberdeen. Jones is 2nd in the South Atlantic League only trailing Wilfred Veras (WS) who has amounted 20 total. The 16 doubles are good for third in High-A and are the most among all NYY Minor Leaguers.

DON'T RUN ON ME: Renegades catcher **Antonio Gómez** caught Jackson Holliday on Tuesday to bring his total to 18 in 27 games behind home

- He owns the highest mark in the South Atlantic League and High-A, and good for t-3rd in MiLB
- Gómez has thrown out 28.5% of would-be basestealers this year. The SAL average is around 21%
- Nick Clarno (AUG -- A, ATL) leads MiLB with 25 CS while Gómez is t-3rd. In the month of May, Gómez has caught 34.1% of attempted runners
- After catching just four opponents in April, the 'Gades backstop has improved his CS% by nearly 18% month over month.

MY NAME IS INDIGO DIAZ: One of a flurry of roster moves the Yankees effecting the Renegades included receiving **RHP Indigo Diaz** from the Somerset Patriots. Diaz was acquired by the Yankees on December 28, 2023 from the Atlanta Braves along with INF Caleb Durbin in exchange for LHP Lucas Leutke. In his Hudson Valley debut on Thursday against Aberdeen, the right-handed pitcher retired all six batters he faced, striking out three.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: With a hit on Sunday, **Eduardo Torrealba** has tallied 111 career hits with the Renegades. He currently sits fifth in franchise history sitting behind Matt Rico (112) for fourth. Angel Perez holds the franchise record with 125.

A DOZEN IT IS: Friday night's 12-inning affair against the Aberdeen IronBirds was the longest game played by Hudson Valley this season. It's also the longest game played by the Renegades since a 5-4 victory in 12 innings on September 18, 2021, against the Greensboro Grasshoppers. The 'Gades played three 12-inning games during that 2021 season

CHASE HAMPTON · RHP · 6'2" · 225 LBS · 21

LAST TIME OUT: Hampton tied his career high by striking out 10 batters last Saturday at Wilmington, but got no decision in a 7-5 Hudson Valley loss. The right-hander allowed back-to-back home runs to Matt Suggs and Will Frizzell in the bottom of the fourth, and the only other hit he allowed was a bunt single to Jordy Barley in the third. It was an impressive start for the 2022 sixth rounder, who left with a 4-2 lead and in line for a victory.

YANKEES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON HAMPTON: "Hats off to our amateur scouting department on getting [Hampton] in the sixth round. He is a huge arm quickly moving up our prospect boards. He was so underdeveloped where he was -- we saw the delivery and there was a lot of things to like, and we thought he was an easy velocity upside guy, which we've seen. He was 90-91 mph arm in college, he's a 93-94 average arm here touching 97 and 98 now. Add that to some raw qualities that he has in his secondaries, we've started to refine those pitches and all of a sudden you've got a big power fastball with a lot of life, a curveball that is over 80% miss to lefties, a slider with over 55%... He's something that as a fanbase for the Yankees you should be really excited about seeing a power arm like that and he's got a little bit of polish for a young kid that doesn't have that many innings under his belt, he and [Drew] Thorpe have gone straight to High-A and you can see that polish, you see him have a little bit of pitchability, being able to start to understand and execute a plan, and when he starts to mature and understand what his stuff is and how to sequence his pitches, I think we'll see this kid fly."

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp roster.
- Struck out the first batter he faced in his professional career, Aberdeen's Jud Fabian.
- Struck out 10 batters on 4/25 vs Greenville, combining with RHP Drew Thorpe to become the first Renegades pitchers to whiff 10-or-more batters in back-to-back games since Tobias Myers and Jhonleider Salinas each fanned 10 on Aug. 12 and 13, 2017 against Brooklyn.
- During a three-start stretch from 4/25-Present, struck out 28 batters in 14.2 IP, and posted a 43.8% K%.
