TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a sixgame road series against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. This is the third of five series between the two clubs who will meet a total of 30 times (12 at Trustmark Park, 18 at Blue Wahoos Stadi-

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves picked up two wins, finishing a suspended game from Thursday evening with a 6-5 win in 10 innings and dominating Friday night's game 15-3.

In the completion of Thursday's game, Drew Campbell hit his second homer of the game and his fourth in four games to tie it at 4-4. In the 10th, Waddell hit a go-ahead, two-run home run that was enough to win it 6-5.

In Friday night's game, the club put up season highs in runs (15) and hits (18). Cade Bunnell and Luke Waddell each hit a grand slam for the first ever multi-grand slam game in club history. The M-Braves scored 11 runs in the final three

GRAND SALAMI TIME: Less than halfway through the season, the M-Braves have a club record four grand slams, including the first ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell)

LET THE GOOD TIMES ROLL: Over the last five series, the club is 2-0-3 (18-11 overall). The M-Braves scored 68 runs in nine games from May 27 to June 7, ranking 2nd in Double-A over

AGAINST THE BLUE WAHOOS: The M-Braves lost five of six to Pensacola from May 2-7 despite losing the aggregate score 19-18. From May 23-28, the two clubs split a six-game set, with the M-Braves winning back-to-back games to close out the series

THESE TEAMS KNOW HOW TO PITCH: The M-Braves lead the Southern League in pitching, are 2nd in Double-A, and 12th in MiLB with a 3.72 ERA. M-Braves starters rank 11th in Double-A with a 4.27 ERA. The M-Braves finished May with the fourth best ERA in MiLB at 2.99.

The Blue Wahoos are 2nd in the Southern League and 8th in Double-A with a 4.12 ERA. Pensacola starters rank 3rd in Double-A with a 3.71 ERA.

<u>PROSPECTING:</u> 7 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (11), INF Cal Conley (13), OF Jesse Franklin V (14), RHP Alan Rangel (26), RHP Tanner Gordon (28), C Tyler Tolve (29) and LHP Luis De Avila (30).

HOME RUN ADVANTAGE AT HOME FIELD: The M-Braves have 69 homers - 43 on the road. 16 different players have at least one homer with Drew Lugbauer leading the way with 12 homers, ranking 1st in the Southern League.

The M-Braves hit 11 home runs at Trustmark Park this past week. M-Braves opponents have just eight home runs at Trustmark Park this seaALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer homered in three straight games from May 23-25, becoming the sixth M-Brave to do so. Lugbauer achieved the feat from July 25-28, 2021.

The first baseman went to the 7-day Injured List on Wednesday, ranking among the league leaders in home runs (12, 1st), RBI (38, T-4th), SLG (.600, 1st), OPS (.986, 1st), OBP (.386, 6th) and XBH (25, 4th) at the time.

Lugbauer recorded his first career M-Braves triple on May 13 against the Lookouts, then another on May 16 at Montgomery. He made his profesional pitching debut on May 17 at Montgomery tossing 2/3 scoreless innings with a strikeout of Logan Driscoll on an 87 mph fastball. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-per-hour home run, which ranked 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls at the time.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 58 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011), Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26).

"JESSE FRANKLIN V": Jesse Franklin V just lost a team-best, 10-game hit streak (5/24-6/9) and has hit in 14 of his last 15 games. Over those 15 games, he is slashing .306/.375/.516 with two home runs, five doubles, a triple, and nine RBI.

WADDYYY: Luke Waddell has reached base 16 times in the series, going 11-for-16 with three home runs, two doubles, four walks, and nine RBI. Waddell hit a go

BUNNY HOPPIN': Cade Bunnell is on a tear to start June, slashing .362/.436/.745 with five home runs, three doubles, and 13 RBI in 12 games. He hit his second grand slam of the season on Friday, June 16.

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens propelled himself into a tie for second in the league with 11 homers, including five home runs in June. He is slugging .633 over 13 games in June.

HOT VOD: Victor Vodnik has yet to allow a run in 9.2 innings over six appearances. Since the start of May, Vodnik has a 0.91 ERA in 19.2 innings over 13 appearances with 10 walks to 28 strikeouts.

BIG BAD BARGER: The 25-year-old reliever allowed a run for the first time on May 20 in his 12th relief appearance. He has four saves (T-5th, SL). Barger started the season with 15 shutout innings, with 19 strikeouts to seven walks, in 11 appearances. He currently has a 2.33 ERA in 27 innings.

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox has allowed one earned run in 13.2 innings over 13 relief appearances with the M-Braves, including five walks to 20 strikeouts. The right-hander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings.

Robles will appear in his 13th game of the season and 11th for the M-Braves. This will be his third career start against Pensacola. Robles ranks top 10 in the league in ERA (3.68, 7th) and WHIP (1.25, 6th).

LAST TIME OUT

 Robles gave up three runs on six hits and three walks in 4.0 innings on Sunday against Biloxi, taking the loss.
