#### HOEING K'S SEVEN IN JACKSONVILLE'S WIN

Bryan Hoeing made his Triple-A debut in Jacksonville's 6-4 win against Memphis Saturday night. In his first start with Jacksonville, Hoeing tossed seven innings and struck out seven Redbirds in the process. JJ Bleday continued his power surge with his third homer in his last three games and Charles Leblanc also contributed, driving in a pair. Jake Fishman was very effective out of the bullpen, tossing a scoreless two innings en route to his first save of the season. With this win, the Jumbo Shrimp have won their third series of the season and have improved their May record to 4-2.

#### SWEEP!

The Jumbo Shrimp played their first doubleheader of the season on Friday. After a comfortable win in game one 7-3, they kept the offense going in game two. JJ Bleday hit a solo home run in both games and in total Jacksonville clubbed five home runs. The Jumbo Shrimp swept their first doubleheader and also won their first road game in extra innings.

## THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 42 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fourth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast in recent years; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

## SHRIMP SPECKS

The Jumbo Shrimp have made just one error in their last eight games a span of 69.2 innings... With a 13-10 record, Jacksonville finished April with a winning record for the first time since going 14-10 in April 2013. The Jumbo Shrimp are now 4-2 in the month of May. They are just one-of-six teams in the International League with a winning record on the road. Three have winning records and Jacksonville ranks third with a winning percentage of .625.

#### **CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE**

Charles Leblanc went 3-for-9 in Friday's doubleheader, and he continues to have a fantastic start to 2022. The Laval, Quebic City native has reached base safely in 22 of his 24 games this year. On the season, Leblanc ranks second in the International League in batting average (.385), first in OPS (1.095), seventh in slugging percentage (.648), tied for 10th in home runs (6), third in on-base percentage (.447), and fifth in hits (35) Among the 133 qualified hitters in the circuit, Leblanc leads the league in both wOBA (.474) and wRC+ (190).

#### THIS CUBAN IS CRUSHING MISSILES

Over his last 13 games, Lorenzo Quintana has gone 21-for-57 at the plate, slashing .368/.429/.789/1.218 with six doubles, six home runs, 18 RBIs and 14 runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up the International League leaderboards on the season; the native of Pinar del Rio in Cuba ranks in the top 20 of the league in slugging (3rd; .655), batting average (T-9th; .333), OPS (5th; 1.034), home runs (T-6th; 7), RBIs (T-7th; 22), extra-base hits (T-6th; 14) and hits (12th; 29). Of the 133 qualified hitters in the International League, Quintana has posted the 9th-lowest strikeout rate (12.6 %). He places fourth in both wOBA (.441) and wRC+ (169).

## ERIK THE RED

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Erik González has gone on a tear over his last 19 games. During this span, the Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic native is 34-for-79 at the plate, slashing .430/.446/.582/1.028 with seven doubles, one triple, one home run, 10 RBIs and 11 runs scored. Heading into play on Saturday, González is ranked first in the International League in average (.392) and ranks first in hits (38).

## **ROAD WARRIORS**

Heading into play on Sunday, Jacksonville is currently 11-6 on the road. There are six teams in the International League with eight or more road wins so far in 2022 and of those six teams, three have winning records and three own a .500 winning %. There are six teams with a winning record on the road and Jacksonville ranks third with a 11-6 record (.625) and is the only team with 11 road wins in 2022.

#### ABOUT EDWARD

-Ranked as the No. 2 prospect in the Marlins' organization by MLB.com, Cabrera signed with Miami for \$100,000 on July 2, 2015 as an international free agent. He is also a consensus Top-100 prospect, ranked 33rd by Keith Law of *The Athletic*, 34th by MLB Pipeline and No. 69 by both Baseball Prospectus and Baseball America.

-The Marlins have been fairly aggressive with Cabrera, starting his professional career in the Gulf Coast League rather than the Dominican Summer Legaue. After just 82.2 innings in 24 games, including 13 starts, with the GCL Marlins and Short Season Class A Batavia, Cabrera found himself in full season ball with Low-A Greensboro in 2018 at the age of 19.

## 2022 SEASON

## 2021 SEASON

-Cabrera made two rehab starts with Low-A Jupiter on June 6 and June 12, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts and no walks. His rehab assignment ended on June 15, when he was assigned to Double-A Pensacola. After five starts with the Blue Wahoos, he was promoted to Jacksonville on July 15.

## 2020 SEASON

-Cabrera was a member of the Marlins' Alternate Training Site.

## 2019 SEASON

-Cabrera was assigned to Jacksonville on June 23 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the right-hander ranked second in the Florida State League out of 60 pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched in FIP (2.28), third in strikeout percentage (32.2 percent), fourth in K-BB% (24.3 percent), fifth in xFIP (2.64) and ninth in ERA (2.02). He also tallied the circuit's sixth-highest swinging strike percentage (14.5 percent).

-The Santiago, Dominican Republic native surrendered four runs to the first five batters he faced on the season on April 5 at Palm Beach. However, he did not cede another tally until the sixth inning of his start on May 23, a span of 28 consecutive scoreless innings.

-On May 1, Cabrera tied Jupiter's franchise record with 13 strikeouts in a game while also netting a career high of his own. He wound up yielding just two hits over 6.2 scoreless innings against the Bradenton Marauders.

-Cabrera missed 22 games while on the injured list from August 3 through August 25. He was activated on August 26 prior to a start against Mobile.

## 2018 SEASON

-The right-hander began the season on a strong note. In 12 starts before the All-Star Break, Cabrera went 3-6 with a 3.27 ERA (63.1 IP, 60 H, 23 BB, 45 K, .252 BAA). However, in 10 second-half starts, he posted a 1-2 record and 5.84 ERA (37.0 IP, 45 H, 19 BB, 48 K, .298 BAA).

-Left-handed hitters posted a .299/.366/.423 (.789 OPS) batting line against Cabrera. However, he was able to hold righties to a .239/.335/.367 (.702 OPS) slash mark.

-On April 16, Cabrera held the Lakewood BlueClaws hitless for six innings in an eventual 1-0 victory. Just over a month later, on May 20, the right-hander fired seven frames of one-hit ball in an 8-0 triumph over the BlueClaws.
