THURSDAY: The Flying Squirrels fell to the Bowie Baysox, 8-6. Bowie jumped ahead, 2-0, in the first with back-to-back homers by Seth Mejias-Brean and Kyle Stowers. Richmond tied the game in the fourth with a two-run double by Jacob Heyward. In the fifth, Diego Rincones hit a two-run homer to put the Flying Squirrels ahead, 4-2. In the bottom of the fifth, Cadyn Grenier hit a solo homer and Zach Watson gave the Baysox a 5-4 lead with a two-run double. Bowie pulled away with three runs in the sixth inning. The Flying Squirrels closed the score to 8-6 with a two-run homer by David Villar in the top of the seventh. Diogenes Almenzo worked a scoreless ninth inning to pick up his seventh save.

TODAY'S GAMES: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth and fifth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Baysox are the only team the Flying Squirrels play more than two series against in 2021. This is the last of four sets between the two teams this year. In the Flying Squirrels' last trip to Bowie from July 6-11, they went 4-2. The Baysox went 4-2 at The Diamond from May 18-23 and 5-1 in Richmond from July 27-August 1.

DOUBLE DIP: The Flying Squirrels are 9-3 in double-header games this season. They swept a twinbill against Hartford on May 8, split a pair on May 27 at Reading, swept two on May 29, won twice on June 10 against Harrisburg, split a double-header on July 2 against Binghamton and split two at Bowie on July 9.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped two straight after winning the previous three. Since July 21, the Flying Squirrels have gone 5-15. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 11.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .232 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.87 ERA for the season.

THE BAYSOX have won eight of the last 12 games. They split last week's road series against the Somerset Patriots. The Baysox are currently second in the division and sit 2.0 games out of the second postseason spot for the league. The Bowie offense is ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast with a .240 batting average. Bowie's pitching staff is ranked sixth with a 4.18 ERA. Bowie's roster features seven of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including RHP Grayson Rodriguez (2), LHP D.L. Hall (3 - on IL), OF Yussniel Diaz (8), 2B Terrin Vavra (10 - on IL), OF Kyle Stowers (22), LHP Drew Rom (25) and SS Joseph Ortiz (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his seventh Double-A start and second against Bowie in Game 1. He made his first Double-A outing since May last Sunday at The Diamond against Reading and allowed one run over 6.0 innings in a win. He faced the Baysox on May 19 at The Diamond and was hit with his only Double-A loss this season after allowing two runs (one earned over 5.0 innings). Frisbee was selected as the Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Month for May. He was promoted to Triple-A on June 3 and made 11 appearances (nine starts) for Sacramento, going 1-6 with a 7.64 ERA. He was assigned back to the Richmond roster on August 6. On May 13 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked 6.0 perfect innings in the Flying Squirrels' first-ever nine-inning no-hitter. He spent most of the 2019 season with San Jose, going 9-8 with a 3.17 ERA in 22 outings (20 starts). He went 4-2 with a 1.91 ERA in his last 10 appearances (56.2 IP) of the season while picking up 60 strikeouts. Following the season, Frisbee was named a Giants Organizational All-Star by MiLB.com. He was drafted by the Giants in the 15th round in 2018 out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

Right-hander **Akeel Morris** makes his fifth start for Richmond and his second since returning to the roster from Triple-A in Game 2. In his first start back with Richmond on Saturday against Reading and pitched 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits in a combined shutout. He made his previous five appearances, including four starts, for Triple-A Sacramento, going 1-3 with a 10.23 ERA. He was assigned back to Richmond on August 1. He signed with the San Francisco Giants on June 19 from the independent Long Island Ducks, where he made two starts and combined for 11.0 scoreless innings of work. Morris, a native of St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, was drafted by the New York Mets in the 10th round in 2010 and reached the big leagues with them for the first time in 2015. He has also appeared in the majors with the Atlanta Braves and the Los Angeles Angels. After reaching free agency following the 2018 season, Morris signed with the High Point Rockers of the independent Atlantic League to begin the 2019 season, where he pitched as a reliever. He was traded to the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs and then swapped again before making an appearance to the New Britain Bees, where he finished the year going 7-4 with a 4.94 ERA in 16 outings (13 starts). **For more on Morris, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Blaine Knight seventh Double-A start and 11th overall appearance in the league in Game 1. He pitched out of the bullpen in his most recent outing last Friday at Somerset and allowed one run over 3.0 innings. He has faced Richmond once this season, tossing 4.0 innings and allowing one run in a relief outing on July 6 at Prince George's Stadium. As a starter with the Baysox, Knight has gone 1-3 with a 5.33 ERA, but he is 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA in four relief outings. Knight began the season with High-A Aberdeen and went 0-1 with a 2.41 ERA in four starts. He was drafted by the Orioles in the third round in 2018 out of the University of Arkansas.

Right-hander Cody Sedlock takes the mound in Game 2 for his 12th start and 17th appearance of the season. Last time out, Sedlock allowed one run over 5.2 innings in a win at Somerset last Saturday. He pitched at The Diamond on July 27 and held the Flying Squirrels to one run in 5.0 innings with seven strikeouts, matching a season high. Over his last three starts since July 27, Sedlock is 3-0 with a 2.16 ERA (4 ER/16.2 IP). He has faced Richmond four times this season, going 3-0 with a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP). He was drafted in the first round (27th) by the Orioles in 2016 out of the University of Illinois. He was a Carolina League All-Star in 2019 with the Frederick Keys.

BIG FLIES IN BOWIE: The Flying Squirrels have combined to hit 18 home runs at Prince George's Stadium in nine games this season. During the Flying Squirrels' first visit to Bowie from July 6-11, they hit 11 home runs. They have added seven more homers this week's series. In the nine games in Bowie this year, **Vince Fernandez** and **Frankie Tostado** have hit three homers, **Sandro Fabian**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Diego Rincones**, **David Villar** and **Brandon Martorano** have hit two. **Mitchell Tolman**, **Andy Sugilio** has one homer in Bowie this season.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank ninth in the circuit with 90 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 124 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. Richmond's 90 home runs this season is a higher total than the entire 2019 (84), 2016 (83), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons. This year, the team has combined for a .384 slugging percentage, which is 11th in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013).

LEAVING THE YARD: The 2021 Flying Squirrels have five players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **Vince Fernandez** (13), **David Villar** (12), **Frankie Tostado** (11), **Sandro Fabian** (10) and **Heliot Ramos** (10). Five players with 10 or more homers ties a franchise record, matching the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duvall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Minicozzi** (10).

GO, DIEGO, GO! Over his last 20 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .329 (23-for-70) with six homers, five doubles, one triple and 19 RBIs. He homered in three consecutive games from July 17-20 and added a fourth on July 29 against Bowie. He has hit homers in Bowie this week on Wednesday and Thursday. Over his last nine games since August 3, Rincones is batting .400 (14-for-35) with two homers, four doubles and eight RBIs. He knocked go-ahead hits in the Richmond wins on Saturday, Sunday and Tuesday, and briefly gave the Flying Squirrels the lead with his two-run homer on Thursday night.

SIMON SAYS: **Simon Whiteman** is batting .299 (26-for-87) over his last 23 games since July 15 with six doubles, one triple, one homer and six RBIs. Whiteman leads the team with 14 stolen bases this season, which is tied for fifth in the Double-A Northeast. For the year, Whiteman has picked up a total of 31 steals in 34 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season.

FABULOUS FABIAN: In his last five games since August 7, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .533 (8-for-15) with one homer and three RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in each of the first three games of the current series against the Baysox, including three hits on Thursday. For the series, Fabian is batting .636 (7-for-11). On Tuesday, Fabian hit his 10th home run of the season, which is tied for fourth on the team.

TORRES ON A TEAR: **Bryan Torres** saw his 13-game hitting streak end when he left the game early on Wednesday. The streak dated back to July 3 and is the longest hit streak for any player on the Flying Squirrels this season. During that span, Torres hit .386 (19-for-49) with three doubles, a triple and seven RBIs. He is batting .297 this season in 34 games, which would be the highest average of his professional career. Torres is playing his first season at the Double-A level after previously topping out at the rookie level before 2021.
