YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Yard Goats, 10-3. The game was tied, 3-3, entering the eighth inning. Richmond scored four runs in the eighth with a go-ahead double by Will Wilson and RBI singles by Victor Bericoto, Andy Thomas and Jimmy Glowenke. In the ninth, Sean Roby singled in a run and Hayden Cantrelle added a two-run single to open a 10-3 lead. The Yard Goats opened a 3-0 lead in the third, the only runs allowed by John Michael Bertrand in his five-inning start, during which he set a career high with eight strikeouts. Richmond rallied to tie the game in the top of the fourth. Carter Aldrete hit a two-run double and Thomas added an RBI single to even the score. Relievers Clay Helvey and Tyler Myrick each covered two scoreless innings to finish the game.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks Richmond's first trip to Hartford since June 22-27, 2021. This series is the only set this year between the two teams.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 37-26 in their last 63 games since June 18, the second-best record in the Eastern League in that span, but have gone 5-6 on this road trip to Portland at Hartford. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.99 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 459.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 617.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.85 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A. Richmond hitters have homered 24 times over the last 11 games.

THE YARD GDATS have gone 3-10 in their last 13 games since August 19. Their .230 team batting average is 11th in the Eastern League and their 5.47 team ERA is 12th. Hartford's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including SS Adael Amador (No. 1 - No. 21 overall), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 3 - No. 51 overall), 3B Sterlin Thompson (No. 6), OF Jordan Beck (No. 7), C Drew Romo (No. 9), 3B Warming Bernabel (No. 11), SS Julio Carreras (No. 17), LHP Carson Palmquist (No. 13) and OF Bladimir Restituyo (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list includes seven Hartford players, including Amador (No. 1 - No. 21 overall), Fernandez (No. 2 - No. 53 overall), Thompson (No. 6), Romo (No. 9), Bernabel (No. 10), LHP Joe Rock (No. 16) and Palmquist (No. 21).

FOR ILCHMOND: Right-hander Hayden Birdsong makes sixth Double-A start. He started the opener of this series on Tuesday and threw four scoreless, hitless innings, his longest start at Double-A so far. This year, he ranked third among Giants minor league pitchers in strikeouts (133). Among minor league pitchers (min. 80 IP), Birdsong ranks fourth in strikeout percentage (35.3) and sixth in K/9 (13.45). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and pitched 12 games (10 starts). With San Jose, he led the California League in strikeouts (70) prior to his promotion to High-A Eugene on June 13. With the Emeralds, he went 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA in his final six starts before being promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 4. During his time with Eugene from June 13-July 30, he led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.92) and ranked second in strikeouts (46). Birdsong was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Eastern Illinois University, where he played two seasons minutes from his hometown. Birdsong is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more information on Birdsong, see page two.

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Case Williams makes his 22nd start of the season. He last pitched last Sunday at Somerset and allowed four runs over five innings in a no-decision. His 10 losses this year are tied for the most in the Eastern League. He has also worked the sixth-most innings in the Rockies system this season. Williams was selected in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft by the Rockies out of Douglas County High School in Castle Rock, Colo. In 2022, he pitched at three levels, going 11-5 with a 4.64 ERA in 23 starts, earning a selection as an MiLB.com Rockies Organization All-Star.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 13 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are in second place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, one game behind the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and one game ahead of the Bowie Baysox. Akron is six games back in fourth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels have homered 24 times in their last 11 games dating back to August 22, which is the most in the minors during that span. On Thursday, the Richmond hitters combined for eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise record. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in the minors this year, even with an eight-homer performance by Sugar Land at Albuquerque on May 7. It was also the most homers in an Eastern League game since the Harrisburg Senators homered eight times at Erie on June 18, 2006.

ALRIGHT, ALDRETE: On Thursday, Carter Aldrete hit three home runs in consecutive at-bats. He hit a two-run homer in the third inning, added another two-run homer in the fourth inning and hit a solo home run in the fifth. The three-homer performance tied the Richmond single-game franchise record. The last player to homer three times in a game was **Thomas Neal** on June 26, 2010 at Erie. Aldrete reclaimed the team lead in homers this year with 12. Prior to Thursday, Aldrete had not homered in his previous 36 games, back to his most recent home run on June 18.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Of the Flying Squirrels' last nine wins, they have scored the winning run in the seventh inning or later in six of them. On August 17, Victor Bericoto hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning the beat Harrisburg after Richmond entered the inning trailing, 6-2, tying the largest ninth-inning comeback in franchise history. On August 19 against the Senators, Sean Roby won the game with a walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth. On August 23 at Portland, Jimmy Glowenke hit a go-ahead single in the top of the ninth inning at Portland to give Richmond a 9-8 win. On Sunday afternoon in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field, the Flying Squirrels rallied after trailing, 8-6, down to their final out in the seventh before Brady Whalen and Bericoto hit back-to-back homers to tie the game and Logan Wyatt hit a two-run, pinch-hit homer for a 10-8 win. On Wednesday, Wyatt broke a 4-4 tie with a solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win at Hartford. On Saturday night, Will Wilson hit a go-ahead single in the eighth, starting a burst of seven runs over the next two innings in a 10-3 win.

BERICOTO BASHING: Victor Bericoto has homered six times in his last nine games dating back to Thursday. In his last 15 games since August 16, Bericoto is batting .333 (18-for-54) with six homers, four doubles and 16 RBIs. On August 17 against Harrisburg, he hit walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. Last Thursday at Portland, he homered and drove in two runs on the night. He added another homer on Saturday. He hit a game-tying homer in the last inning of Game 2 of Sunday's doubleheader at Portland. On Wednesday, he hit a two-run homer at Hartford. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 25 homers (16 with Eugene and nine with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 79 RBIs.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt has homered four times in his last eight games since Saturday. He hit a two-run homer in the ninth inning last Saturday night at Portland. On Sunday afternoon in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. On Wednesday at Hartford, he launched a go-ahead, solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. Dating back to August 20, Wyatt is batting .324 (11-for-34) with five homers, three doubles and 11 RBIs. His 17 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the third-most in the Giants organization.

GLDW SHDW: Jumy **Glowenke** is has picked up 17 hits and eight RBIs in his last 10 games dating back to last Wednesday, batting .607 (17-for-28) with three homers, two doubles and five walks. Last Wednesday, at Portland he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glowenke is batting .359 (38-for-106) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .338 (45-for-133) with seven homers and 27 RBIs in 41 games.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 63 times in his last 34 games since July 25 (34 hits, 28 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .291 (34-for-117) with six homers, six doubles, two triples and 25 RBIs adding a .430 on-base percentage. In the last home series against the Senators, Matheny hit .412 (7-for-17) with three homers, one double, nine RBIs and three walks. He is hitting .180 (7-for-39) in his nine games on this road trip. In the second game of Sunday's doubleheader, he hit a three-run homer. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 136 walks, ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
