### Today's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound today, looking to avoid the first 4G losing streak of the season (last: 8/29-9/2). Toledo will counter with LHP **Bryan Sammons**. Columbus is 1-8 (.111) versus left handers this year. Sammons has faced Columbus eight times in his career, going 4-1 with a 3.08ERA (38.0IP, 13ER), including 2-0 with a 1.80ERA (20.0IP, 4ER) in 4G Columbus.

### vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus was 10-11 opposing Toledo last year (have not won a season series since going 11-10 in 2022), including a 4-5 mark at Huntington Park (lost each of last 4G). Individually, **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .311 (14x45) with 2HR and 6RBI against the Mud Hens in his career (11G), while **Nolan Jones** has hit 5HR and collected 17RBI in 34G. **Juan Brito** has 2HR and 17RBI in 26G.

### Saturday Redemption

Last night's loss snapped a 2G win streak on Friday, as the Clippers are now 6-22 on Friday since starting last season 5-0. They lost on Saturday two weeks ago vs. Iowa before getting rained out in Buffalo last week (29-10 on Saturday since starting the 2024 season 2-12). Columbus has not lost on both Friday and Saturday since 8/29-8/30 last year in Louisville (last time at home: 8/22-8/23/25 vs. Omaha).

### Treading Water

Columbus fell below .500 with last night's loss, marking the second time in the red this season (started the year 0-1, then had 5G win streak). After starting last year 12-5, the Clippers dipped under .500 on 4/30 and sank underwater for good on 5/2 (14-15, closest to .500 after that was 40-41). Columbus has a -13 run differential after last night's unpleasantness (between -9 and +9 through first 30G).

### Gone Cold

Like the infuriating weather that has rolled into Columbus, the bats were iced out of the homer column in the first 3G of the series until **Nolan Jones** went deep last night. The lineup pounded 13HR in the last 5G of the Iowa series, but has 6HR in the 10G since (.338SLG, 20th in the IL). The Clippers have scored a grand total of nine runs in the last 3G, having averaged 7.0 in the dozen prior (4/15-4/28).

### He's Due

**Milan Tolentino** is getting his first start in the leadoff spot since 7/22/25 (started 8G at leadoff last year, all in July), taking the first hacks at Toledo's southpaw starter. Tolentino is hitting lefties at a .353 (6x17) clip this season, but still does not have a homer off a lefty in Triple-A (97AB; 27HR in 393AB vs. RHP). As a team, Columbus had 1HR in 188AB vs. LHP before Sunday (2HR in 39AB since).

### Familiar Surroundings

**Juan Brito** is slotting into the second spot in the batting order today for the 162nd time in his Clipper career (75G and 344PA more than any other player in the IL since his Triple-A debut on 9/19/23). Brito is 1x10 in 3G since getting optioned earlier in the week, and is hitting .182/.308/.212 with a double and 4RBI in 9G since opening weekend (.500/.533/.833 with four doubles and 2RBI in first 3G).

### Rollin' Jones

**Nolan Jones** saw his on base streak snapped at 10G on Thursday (.489OBP, 4/16-4/29; was 0x11 with a walk in previous 3G), but bounced back with a multi-hit game last night. Jones is hitting .341 (14x41) over the last 12G, drawing 9BB to 9K. Only three Clipper streaks have reached 11G and, though all are active, none of the batters are (**Petey Halpin**- 16, **Cooper Ingle**- 15, **Travis Bazzana**- 13).

### Hot at Home

**Kody Huff** rebounded from a pair of hitless games to collect his seventh multi-hit game of the year last night (fifth at home; hitting .313, 15x48, in 12G at Huntington Park, .212, 11x52 in 14G on the road). Among Clippers with at least 40PA at Huntington Park, Huff is one of four hitting over 100 points better at home (**Stuart Fairchild** +204, **Milan Tolentino** +188, **Kahlil Watson** +137). The team is +45.

### No Experience Necessary

**Maick Collado** has hit safely in every game (8x22 with 4XBH and 3RBI in 6G) since skipping over Double-A to make his Triple-A debut on Sunday, while **Juan Benjamin** has homered twice in his last 4G (3x13; 4x31 in 9G prior). Both rookies are in the lineup today, as rookies account for 7% of Clipper plate appearances (**Juan Benjamin**- 48, **Collado**- 23, **Kevin Rivas**- 16), 3.4% prior to 4/24.

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

5/2/1982

Clipper slugger **Steve Balboni** hit a 3-run, walk-off homer vs. the Pawtucket Red Sox. Balboni finished the game with 2HR and 5RBI. He would go on to hit 32HR in the 1982 season, good for the 2nd highest total in Clippers' history at the time (currently 3rd). Balboni, the franchise record holder in HR (92), was inducted into the International League Hall of Fame in 2011.

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,422 to 1,369).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 43-41 (.512) in pitch reviews, with batters going 27-30 (.474) and pitchers/catchers going 16-11 (.593). They have run out of challenges in 17G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-2 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-35 when playing past regulation (.593, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 86G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

## Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 13th in the IL this year (.978), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 18G this season (9-9, .500), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Stuart Fairchild** moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 4/26 at Buffalo and that runner came around to score in a rare loss. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-23 (.785) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-2 (.333, blew 7-run lead in on of the losses) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 401-422 (.487), 371-376 with Columbus (.497).

### Workhorse

Allen is the only Clipper averaging over 80 pitches a start this season, at 84.4 (along with **Trenton Denholm**, only pitchers to throw more than 90 in a game). Averaging almost 93 pitches per outing in the Majors last season, Allen hit triple digits six times (Columbus has not had a pitcher reach 100 since **Peyton Battenfield** on 9/2/22, 495G ago)

### Stellar Support:

Through 5GS, the bullpen has graced Allen with a 0.93ERA in relief (19.1IP, 2ER), though they have allowed the only runner inherited from him to score. The defense has committed only 3E in Allen's starts, while the offense has put forwad 4.6 runs per game. That all adds up to a 4-1 record for Columbus when he takes the hill.

### 2026 Spring Training:

Allen pitched four times for Cleveland during spring training, going 0-2 with an 18.00ERA (10.0IP, 25H, 20R, 20ER, 8BB, 9K). He was optioned to Columbus on 3/22, but did not join the team until 3/31.

### Last Season:

Pitched the entire season with Cleveland... after season opening loss at San Diego on 4/1 (5.1IP, 7H, 4R, 4ER, 5BB, 1K), went 1-0 with a 0.56ERA (16.0IP, 1ER) in next 3GS (4/9-4/20), before loss vs. Boston on 4/27 (4.1IP, 9H, 7R, 7ER, 3BB, 2K)... won with a scoreless start on 5/13 vs. Milwaukee (6.0IP, 3H, 1BB, 6K) and earned a win in a relief outing on 5/31 vs. Los Angeles (1.0IP, 2K)... went 3-3 with a 3.34ERA (35.0IP, 13ER) in 6GS (4QS) prior to the All-Star Break (6/11-7/11)... lost a pair out of the Break before winning vs. Colorado on 7/29 (7.0IP, 8H, 2R, 2ER, 1BB, 3K)... struggled over 5GS from 8/12-9/4, turning in a 6.66ERA (25.2IP, 19ER)... won a scoreless start on 9/20 at Minnesota, following a nine-day layoff (8.0IP, 4H, 1BB, 7K)... did not pitch in the AL Playoffs.
