TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue their lone series of the season against the Hartford Yard Goats.

LAST TIME OUT: Brenden Dixon broke a 2-2 tie with a long solo homer to leadoff the top of the ninth and earn a 3-2 win for the

YOYNER ON TOP: When batting in the leadoff spot this season, outfielder Yoyner Fajardo has been at his best, batting .299 with a .406 on-base percentage in 36 games. Since June 1 he ranks second in the Eastern League in batting average (.305) and on-base percentage (.414).

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS: For the first time since the adoption of the 6-game series in 2021, Altoona won all six games in a sixgame series from August 25-Sept. 1 against New Hampshire. Altoona is one of three Double-A clubs (Birmingham, Springfield) to sweep a 6-game series and be swept in a 6-game series this season (vs Akron April 25-30).

LEFT-HANDED PUNCHES: Lefties Jaden Woods and Cy Nielson have racked up strikeouts since arriving from High-A Greensboro during the summer. Woods has struck out 39 batters in 28.0 innings since his Curve debut on June 22, during that time are the third-most among Eastern League relievers. Nielson has struck out 21 batters in his first 16.0 innings since being promoted from Greensboro on July 30

SEND US HOME: Altoona picked up their eighth walk-off win of the season on Friday. August 30 against New Hampshire when Matt Fraizer yanked a 3-run homer over the right field wall in the 10th inning. The Curve's 8 walk-off wins this season puts them in striking distance for the franchise record of 10, set by the 2005 Curve.

UNCHAPPED: Emmanuel Chapman has fulfilled a critically important role on Altoona's pitching staff throughout the season. Since June 19 he's recorded a 2-2 record and a 2.79 ERA (50.0 IP / 15 ER), 49 strikeouts and a .173 BAA in his last 18 appearances (5 starts). In that time he's matched his career-long outing of 4.0 innings four times.

A YOUNG MAN'S ARRIVAL: Infielder Termarr Johnson joined the Curve on Tuesday, August 27 ahead of their series with the Fisher Cats. At 20 years, 2 months and 16 days, Johnson is the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve, behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve. At High-A Greensboro this season, Johnson helped the Grasshoppers earn a First Half title and batted .238/.372/.385/.757 with 17 2B, 1 3B, 13 HR, 46 RBI and 20-24 SB. He earned 78 walks in 110 games played. He ranked first in the SAL in walks (78) and runs scored (73), fifth in OBP (.372) and eighth in hits (94). Johnson's first Double-A hit was a two-run homer off New Hampshire's Nick Fraze on Wednesday, August 28. Johnson's 83 walks this season are sixth-most in the minors this season.

SIR SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani has heated up at the plate since July 30 (28 games), he's batting: .316/.407/.449/.856 with 6 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 11 RBI, 4-5 SB.

ROAD Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng has one of the most dramatic home/road splits of any Eastern League player. In 61 road games, Cheng is batting .240 with a .745 OPS, totaling 10 2B, 10 HR, 29 RBI and 22 BB. In 56 home games, Cheng is batting .170 with a .531 OPS totaling 7 2B, 1 HR, 19 RBI and 33 BB. Overall, Cheng has done a majority of his damage at the plate on the first pitch of his plate appearance where he's batting .354 with a 1.088 OPS in 48 at-bats that he's put the ball in play in an 0-0 count.

HARTFORD HAS IT: Manager Bobby Meacham makes another trip through the Eastern League circuit after two seasons leading the |Runs Scored9th (523) New Hampshire Fisher Cats. The Rockies Double-A affiliate is loaded with future stars including INF Adael Amador, RHP Chase Dollander, INF Ryan Ritter and LHP Sean Sullivan. To top things off, RHP Antonio Senzatela is back for a pair of rehab starts.

A GOAT HERDER: Sean Sullivan takes the ball on Thursday night. Sullivan joined the Yard Goats at the beginning of August and has gone 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 starts. Sullivan hails from nearby Andover, MA and pitched collegiatelly at Wake Forest where he finished cas career with the program record for K/9 at 14.34. Sullivan spent one season at Northwestern before hitting the transfer portal. Sullivan features subpar velocity by today's standards, but has a bit of an unorthodox delivery that generates an awkward slot for hitters that have noted how difficult it is to see his fastball. Additionally he generate 7' - 7'2" worth of extension, far beyond the major league average of 6'4".
