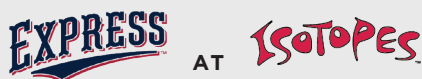

TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Albuquerque Isotopes (Colorado Rockies) are set for game five of their seven-game series on Friday at Isotopes Park. First pitch is scheduled for 7:35 p.m. CT.

E-TRAIN CLAIM THE SERIES

Round Rock claimed the series on Thursday night with a 13-6 win. In the bottom of the third, Albuquerque 1B Blaine Crim's groundout sent 2B Braidon Ward home from third. The next batter, DH Keston Hiura, got aboard with an infield single and 3B Owen Miller scored for a 2-0 advantage. Round Rock tied it in the fourth on RF Abimelec Ortiz's two-run homer. In the fifth, DH Jake Burger gave the E-Train the lead with a two-run home run to make it 4-2. Hiura recorded a sacrifice fly and LF Sterlin Thompson hit a solo shot, tying the game at four in the bottom of the frame. Two-run homers from 2B Alan Trejo and LF Cody Freeman bookended CF Dustin Harris' RBI single in the sixth. Isotopes SS Jose Torres hit a solo home run in the bottom of the frame. In the eighth, Freeman scored on a force out. Trejo led off the ninth with another home run then Burger tallied a two-run double to finish the scoring for the Express. Crim tallied a solo home run for Albuquerque in the bottom of the inning, but Round Rock RHP Craig Kimbrel struck out the side as the Express claimed the series in their 13-6 win at Isotopes Park.

SUPAK SET TO START

Round Rock RHP Trey Supak is slated for his fifth start. He went 5.0 innings with two earned runs on eight hits, one walk and four strikeouts on August 1 against El Paso. In two starts at Isotopes Park for his career, he owns a 6.52 ERA (7 ER/9.2 iP) with one walk and two strikeouts. The 29-year-old opened the season with Double-A Frisco and went 6-3 with a 4.09 ERA (32 ER/70.1 IP) in 14 starts.

THE OFFENSE IS ROLLING

Round Rock recorded 21 hits on Thursday night, marking their third game this year with at least 21 hits. The Express join the Reno Aces as the only teams in all of Triple-A to achieve the feat in three different games this season. All nine starters recorded. Their five home runs tie their season-high from June 4 at Salt Lake.

C-FREE STILL HOT

Express INF Cody Freeman finished 3-for-5 with a home run, two RBI, two runs scored and a walk last night. It was his 17th home run of the season. He is first in the PCL in batting average (.326) and seventh in OPS (.908) this year. Since May 23, he is third in the league in home runs (14).

TOP OF THE ORDER

The first four batters of CF Dustin Harris, 1B Jake Burger, LF Cody Freeman and DH Trevor Hauver went 13-for-22 with seven RBI, six runs last night. Harris and Burger each had four hits.

WE'RE STREAKING

The Express have won four straight games and can tie their longest winning streak of the season with a victory tonight (July 11-20 & April 19-24). Round Rock has scored five or more runs in five consecutive games. In the last 16 games at Isotopes Park, Round Rock is 13-3 with a 4.12 ERA (62 ER/135.1 IP).

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
