LAST GAME

Ninth inning troubles continued to plaque the Baysox on Sunday as they dropped their series finale to the Richmond Flying Squirrels 9-6. Bowie trailed by four runs early before fighting back to tie the game at six, but Richmond plated three more runs in the ninth. After two perfect innings to start the day, things got out of control for Grayson Rodriguez, as he walked the first three batters of the inning, before ultimately allowing four runs. Bowie did not get any action until the seventh inning, when walks and errors allowed Bowie to plate six runs total over the next two frames to tie the game at six. After collecting two quick outs in the ninth, Hector Perez melted down and allowed four straight batters to reach, and three runs total

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Akron has been the hottest team in the Southwest Division over the past month, and have an opportunity to complete their late-season comeback with this final six-game series. The last time these two teams met, Bowie was entering a seven-game series with an active eight-game win streak, but only won two of the seven games. Since the start of that series, Akron is 21-11, and Bowie is only 14-17. Akron has been dictated by their pitching plenty this season, their 3.53 ERA over that same span is the third-best in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Gavin Williams is one of the best pitching prospects in the Guardians organization, and was well-deserving of his promotion from High-A toward the end of the first half, despite still being in his first professional season. With the High-A squad, Williams had only allowed multiple runs in just one of his nine starts, while striking out five batters in every start. Williams has had a handful of shorter outings since joining Akron, but has still struck out at least five in half of his outings, including in a win against Bowie where he tossed five innings of one-hit ball. In his second dance with Bowie, Williams only lasted three innings, partly because of two errors in the third inning that extended the frame. At the Double-A level, 62% of the balls put in play against Williams have been fly balls, while he has already allowed four home runs. Featuring a mid-90s fastball that can draw whiffs at the top of the zone, Williams has hit triple digits at points, a two-plane curveball, as well as a slider and a changeup.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie has had a love-hate relationship with one-run games this season. One-run games have been one of the most common outcomes for Bowie this season, as their 49 one-run games leads the Eastern League. Their .429 winning percentage in one-run games (21-28) is the second-lowest in the Eastern League, trailing only Binghamton. The 28 one-run losses is the most in all of Minor League Baseball.

MEAT LEFT ON THE BONE

Some of Bowie's offensive woes this season have not been from a lack of effort. In fact, the Baysox are the team most likely to start an inning with a runner on base in the Eastern League. Bowie leads the league in all three slash lines (.272/.369/.466) from the first batter of an inning this season. They also lead the league in lead off doubles. All of those numbers combine to Bowie leaving 968 runners on base this season, the most in the league, and an average of 7.4 per game. Bowie has also stranded the most runners in scoring position in the league (716). Inversely, Bowie has the second-most strikeouts in the league when batting with runners on base (571). In their last series with Richmond, Bowie only went 4-for-48 (.083) at the plate with runners in scoring position.

NOT THEIR FAVORITE INNING

Bowie would be a much better team this season if baseball games ended after eight innings. Bowie has a -25 run differential in the ninth inning this season the worst in the entire league, and their worst differential in any inning this season. Their 34 runs scored in the ninth inning is the fewest in the Eastern League this season. Bowie's walk-off losses have hurt them this season, as they have been dealt 12 walk-offs, tied for the most in Minor League Baseball. Bowie has lost five games this season where they had a lead in the ninth inning.
