

SAN ANTONIO MISSIONS 50/50 RAFFLE

Official Rules and Terms & Conditions

1. General Rules

By participating in the San Antonio Missions 50/50 Raffle (the “Raffle”), each entrant agrees to be bound by these Official Rules and Terms & Conditions and by the decisions of the San Antonio Missions Baseball Club, LLC (the “Club”) and the San Antonio 1888 Baseball Foundation, a 501(c)(3) public charity (the “Foundation”), which shall be final and binding in all matters relating to the Raffle.

The Raffle is conducted to support the charitable mission of the Foundation. Net proceeds retained by the Foundation from the Raffle will support the Foundation’s charitable programs, including its Community Grant Program and other youth, education, and community development initiatives, in the Foundation’s sole discretion.

The Raffle is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and is void where prohibited.

2. Eligibility

The Raffle is open only to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of purchase.

The following persons are not eligible to participate in the Raffle: employees, whether full-time, part-time, or seasonal, of the Foundation, the Club, Wolff Stadium, the Club’s and Foundation’s parent, subsidiary, and affiliated entities, the San Antonio Missions’ sponsors, vendors, players, coaching staff, training staff, board members, agents, representatives, and any immediate family or household member of any such person.

The Foundation and the Club reserve the right to require photo identification and any other information reasonably necessary to verify eligibility.

3. Raffle Dates and Drawings

A separate drawing will be conducted for each San Antonio Missions regular-season home game at Wolff Stadium at which the Raffle is offered.

Only tickets purchased for a particular game are eligible for that game's drawing. Tickets do not carry over to any other game or drawing.

4. Ticket Sales

Raffle tickets will be sold only to eligible individuals who are physically present at Wolff Stadium during the applicable San Antonio Missions home game.

Tickets may be sold from the time stadium gates open to the public until the end of the sixth inning. If a game does not start on time, or is delayed during the first two innings, ticket sales will continue for a minimum of two (2) hours from the time stadium gates open, unless otherwise required by law or operational necessity.

Tickets may be offered through in-stadium sales channels authorized by the Foundation or Club, including fixed sales locations, roaming sellers, and in-ballpark digital purchase methods such as QR code access, provided that all purchases are completed by eligible individuals physically present at Wolff Stadium.

Ticket prices are:

- One (1) ticket for \$3.00
- Five (5) tickets for \$10.00
- Twenty-five (25) tickets for \$20.00

Accepted payment methods may include debit cards and major credit cards, except as otherwise posted by the Foundation or Club at the point of sale. If a payment type is not accepted for a particular game or sales channel, posted point-of-sale terms will be controlled.

All ticket sales are final. No refunds or replacements will be issued.

5. Jackpot and Use of Proceeds

For each drawing, the "Jackpot" means the total proceeds from raffle ticket sales for that drawing, less reasonable expenses incurred for operation of the Raffle as permitted by law.

Subject to these Official Rules, one winner will receive fifty percent (50%) of the Jackpot for the applicable drawing as the prize. The remaining fifty percent (50%) of the Jackpot will be retained by the Foundation to support its charitable programs, including the Community Grant Program and other Foundation initiatives consistent with its mission.

Raffle ticket purchases are not tax-deductible charitable contributions.

6. Winner Selection and Announcement

During the seventh inning, one winning raffle number will be randomly selected by electronic means.

The winning number will be announced during the seventh inning over the public address system and on select video boards inside Wolff Stadium and will be posted after the game on the official 50/50 raffle page designated by the Club or Foundation on www.samissions.com/5050.

7. Claiming a Prize

A person holding the winning ticket does not need to be present at the time of the drawing to win.

To claim a prize, the winning ticket must be presented in person either:

- At the 50/50 Kiosk next to Guest Services, or
- To a Foundation representative during normal business hours at San Antonio 1888 Baseball Foundation, 5757 W US Hwy 90, San Antonio, TX 78227.

The winning ticket must be claimed within thirty (30) calendar days of the drawing date. If the thirtieth day falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or recognized holiday, the claim deadline will extend to the next business day.

The claimant must provide the winning ticket, valid identification, taxpayer identification information including Social Security Number if required, and any other claim documentation reasonably required by the Foundation.

Any required claim documents must be completed and returned within five (5) business days after the Foundation provides them to the claimant.

If a claimant does not timely claim the prize, is determined to be ineligible, refuses the prize, or fails to return required claim documents on time, the prize will be forfeited and retained by the Foundation for charitable purposes.

The Foundation has no obligation to contact potential winners.

8. Prize Payment and Taxes

Prizes will be paid by check only. No cash payments will be made.

The Foundation will issue prize payment by check within thirty (30) days after the prize is validly claimed and all required claim documentation has been received and approved. Administrative

processing may affect mailing timing, but the Foundation will endeavor to mail checks as promptly as practicable.

Each winner is solely responsible for any federal, state, county, or local taxes, fees, and withholdings associated with the prize. Applicable withholding laws in effect at the time of payment will control.

9. Unclaimed or Forfeited Prize

If a prize is unclaimed or forfeited, the amount otherwise payable as the prize will be retained by the Foundation and used for its charitable purposes, including the Community Grant Program and other mission-aligned initiatives in the Foundation's sole discretion.

10. Transfer Restrictions

An eligible purchaser may give a raffle ticket to another otherwise eligible individual, but in doing so waives any claim to the prize associated with that ticket.

Raffle tickets may not be resold. Tickets resold in violation of these Official Rules are void and ineligible to win.

A winner may transfer a prize to a third party only if the transferee would otherwise have been eligible to enter the Raffle and agrees to be bound by applicable terms, including tax obligations.

11. Odds

The odds of winning depend on the total number of tickets entered into the applicable drawing.

12. Publicity Release

To the extent permitted by law, each winner may be asked to grant or decline permission for the Club, the Foundation, and their designees to use the winner's name, city and state of residence, photograph, voice, likeness, and prize information for advertising, trade, and promotional purposes without additional compensation.

13. Release, Disqualification, and Modification

By participating, each entrant agrees to release the Foundation, the Club, and related entities from claims arising out of participation in the Raffle or acceptance or use of any prize, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

The Foundation reserves the right to disqualify any person who tampers with the entry process or violates these Official Rules and to suspend, modify, or terminate the Raffle if fraud, technical failure, unauthorized intervention, or other causes impair the integrity or proper administration of the Raffle.

14. Governing Law

These Official Rules are governed by the laws of the State of Texas, and venue for any dispute arising out of the Raffle shall lie in Bexar County, Texas.
