"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints went from being no-hit into the seventh inning to being down to their final out in the ninth before they were walked off on a dribbler a few feet in front of the plate in a 3-2 loss on Tuesday night in Indianapolis, the Saints' eighth consecutive loss at Victory Field. St. Paul starter Travis Adams went 4.0 strong innings allowing one run on five hits with four punchouts. The Saints got two runners aboard in the fifth with the help of an error and a hit by pitch, but failed to capitalize, and didn't collect their first hit until the seventh when Edouard Julien singled with two outs to right field against Burch Smith, the fourth different Indy pitcher used in a bullpen game. In the ninth, the Saints were down to their final out when Julien doubled to left-center to score pinch-runner Maddux Houghton and tie the game at one. In the tenth, the Saints brought home the placed runner after a pair of hits and a walk, including an sac fly from Payton Eeles to give them their first lead of the night. It all unraveled in the bottom of the inning. After Kyle Bischoff struck out the first batter, the placed runner Matt Fraizer stole third and a wild pitch on a 3-2 offering from Bischoff tied the game. An errant pickoff attempt allowed Tsung-Cheng Cheng to reached third before Ronny Simon hit a tapper just in front of the plate that Bischoff fielded, but couldn't flip home in time to prevent the walk-off loss.

HOW COME THEY CALL IT VICTORY FIELD?: The Saints make their first and only trip to Victory Field this season after hosting Indianapolis for a pair of series at home already. The Saints have historically struggled in Indy, and have the second-lowest winning percentage at Victory Field of any of their visiting ballparks since going Triple-A, with only a worse mark in Columbus (see below). The Saints went just 1-11 in two visits to Indianapolis last year, including being swept in a six-game series from August 13-18. They've now lost eight straight in the building. The Saints have been outscored 205-182 all-time at Victory Field and in particular have struggled to pitch there. The Saints own a 4.92 ERA all-time and the 12 pitchers on the current roster with experience in Indianapolis are a combined 7-8 with an 4.93 ERA at Victory Field (48 ER, 87.2 IP):

I'M LOVIN IT: Left-hander Richard Lovelady has retired the last 12 hitters he's faced out of the bullpen dating back to June 1 and has converted his last five save opportunities. His current streak of five straight saves is tied for third in Triple-A. Lovelady is currently one of five relievers in all of Triple-A that have an active streak of 12+ batters retired in a row, trailing Las Vegas' Grant Holman (16), Durham's Eric Orze (15), Gwinnett's Jesse Chavez (14), & tied with Norfolk's Grant Wolfram (12). Lovelady's 59.2% ground-ball rate is top-15 in the Int'l League (min 10 IP).

MCCRUSHER KEEPS MCCRUSHIN': Recently returned from his first-ever stint in The Show, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker currently ranks 5th in Triple-A in average exit velocity (93.3 mph). Coming off a pair of home runs in the last homestand, the Sparks, Nevada native ranks 4th in the league in homers (12) and leads all qualifiers in slugging%. On Thursday vs Scranton, he demolished a 463 foot homer that jumped off the bat at 115.2 mph, marking the third-hardest batted ball in Saints franchise history (Matt Wallner-115.6 mph & Trevor Larnach-115.5 mph). It was the 7th-longest tracked homer in the history of CHS Field, the fourth furthest hit by a Saints batter. McCusker has the four hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including three batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history.

ED(WALK) JULIEN: Saints second baseman Edouard Julien is tied for the 2nd-most walks in all of baseball (majors & minors) with 25 free passes since May 11. In that stretch, Julien has drawn at least one free pass in 15 of the 25 games he's appeared in and owns a .453 on-base percentage.

COMEBACK KIDS: 18 of St. Paul's 30 wins this year have been in come-from-behind fashion this season, tied for the 2nd-most in the International League and trailing only 13 teams in all of baseball (majors or minors, El Paso and Modesto lead the pack with 23 comeback wins each).

GOING, GOING, GONE: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the 2nd-fewest in the Int'l League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 67 round-trippers in their last 49 games since April 14, which ranks 4th in the minors in that stretch, trailing only Charlotte (81), Greensboro (75), & Everett (72). The Saints' streak of homering in consecutive games came to an end at 10 straight on Wednesday night, marking the longest stretch for the club since they homered in 11 in-a-row from April 27-May 10 last year. The Saints have homered in 4-last-5 since and have gone deep in 28 of their last 34 games since May 2.

HEY MICKEY YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .349 (37-106) with 10 doubles, 7 HR, and 18 RBI in 28 games. Gasper is 2nd in the IL in extra-base hits (17) since that date and his OPS ranks 3rd in the International League (min 80 AB) in that stretch. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure).

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (35-31) fell behind big in the middle innings last night as a 0-0 game after three became 10-4 after six in a blowout 16-4 defeat to Texas at Target Field. The Rangers have now scored 25 runs over a 3-game win streak, the most they've scored in a 3-game span all year. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (30-28) won their opener hosting Corpus Christi (HOU), led by a two-homer game from catcher Andrew Cossetti. First baseman Aaron Sabato was named the Texas League's Player of the Week after going 10-for-24 (.417) with 3 HR, 10 RBI in 6 games last week. High-A Cedar Rapids (33-24) snapped a 3-game skid with a 7-6 walk-off over Peoria on Rayne Doncon's sac fly. Low-A Fort Myers (27-31) staked an early lead to top Dunedin (TOR) 5-4 in the series opener on the road. Following 5.0 shutout innings with 5 K's on Thursday, right-hander Jason Doktorczyk was named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week.

LAST APPEARANCE: Made his 10th start of the season on Thursday night at CHS Field vs Scranton. Following his best two-start stretch of the season (3.52 ERA, 3 ER, 7.2 IP), gave up seven runs across 3.1 innings. Gave up singles to three of the first four batters he faced and allowed two runs in the first inning. Threw up zeros in the second and third before allowing five straight baserunners with one out, including being chased on a three-run homer by Jorbit Vivas. According to pitch-tracking, threw 22 changeups (29%), 19 sweepers (25%), 12 four-seamers (16%), 11 cutters (14%), 11 curveballs (14%), and one sinker (1%). Induced a season-high 20 swings-and-misses, his third straight start of double-digit whiffs.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Raya etched his name into Saints history in his start on May 24 vs Norfolk. After entering play with an ERA north of 12.00 on the season and more walks than strikeouts, he came out and struck out the first six batters he faced, becoming the third-ever Saints pitcher to go six up, six down all on the strikeout to start a game, joining Joe Ryan (Aug. 20, 2021 vs Iowa) and Bailey Ober (May 30, 2021 @Iowa). He came one shy of the franchise record of 7 K's in-a-row at any point in a game, a record held by David Festa (set on May 25, 2024 @BUF). Raya was also perfect through the first four innings of the game before reaching his pitch count, marking just the third time that the Saints took a perfect game bid through four innings (Mario Sanchez went 13 up-13 down to start on June 26, 2022 @Buffalo & Simeon Woods Richardson went 12 up-12 down on April 28, 2023 @Rochester). The Saints bullpen promptly followed his start with a leadoff walk in the fifth in a game the Saints would go on to lose 12-1 in 7 innings.

YOUNG GUNS: After making St. Paul's Opening Day roster following one appearance with the Saints to end last season, Raya is one of just six pitchers aged 22-years or younger to begin the 2025 season on a Triple-A roster. At 22 years, 7 months, and 21 days as of Opening Day, Raya is more than five years younger than the average pitcher at the Triple-A level this season. A LONG WAIT: A fourth-round pick in 2020, Raya had to wait a while to make his professional debut. After entering the year as a 1st Team Preseason All-American, his senior season at United South High School in Laredo, Texas was limited to just 18.0 innings in which he struck out 36 batters. His final high school outing was a complete-game, one-hit shutout. However due to the COVID-19 shutdown, followed by a right rotator cuff strain, Raya threw his first professional pitch on April 12, 2022, 670 days after hearing the Twins call his name in the Draft.

THAT'S MARK, WITH A K: Raya, who's full legal name is Marco Antonio Raya, goes by Mark, despite not having a "K" in his legal name. He said you'd have to ask his dad as to why --- he's listed as "Marco" everywhere on Major League Baseball's websites.

GOOD GENES: Athletes run in the Raya family. Mark's mother played college tennis, his father played baseball at Nixon, while his sister made it to regionals as a junior and senior at United South HS in hurdles. Raya's brother also holds the Texas A&M International career strikeout record (127) despite only pitching two years for the Dustdevils in Division 2.
