FRES-NOTES

HOME IS WHERE THE BALL FLIES: Blake Wright has made himself at home against the Visalia Rawhide, crushing his third homer of the year and 5th of his career on Thursday night. All five of Wright's homers have come against the Rawhide after he hit two at Chukchansi Park earlier this season and he hit two at Valley Strong Ballpark last August. Wright owns a .407 average against the Rawhide this year in 15 games.

FULL OF FIRSTS: Besides Wright's homer on Thursday, there were five other home runs in the game and each of those were the first of the year for the hitter. Derek Bernard hit a solo home run in the third and Felix Tena blasted a three-run homer off the scoreboard in left center. Visalia had three players hit there first homer of the season, cutting the Grizzlies 11-run lead to five before the Grizzlies piled on five runs in the ninth. It was the first time this season the Grizzlies hit three home runs in the same game and just the fourth time this year that they had multiple home runs in the same game. Three of those four games have come against Visalia and its the first time the Grizzlies have hit multiple homers on consecutive days.

NO RUNNING HERE: Alan Espinal threw out another attempted base stealer on Thursday night, giving him 17 runners caught stealing this season, the 3rd highest total in the California League this season. However, runners have the least success (.630 success rate) against Espinal of any catcher in the league. Espinal has nabbed 17 of 46 attempted base stealers.
