**BREAKING OUT:** Yankees No. 1 prospect Anthony Volpe entered this 6-game series amid his hottest stretch of the 2022 season: a season-long 5-game hit streak where he was 7-for-18 with 5 R and 4 RBI. Volpe followed that up by going 1-for-16 to start this series in Portland, before a 4-hit eruption in his final 4 at-bats on Saturday. The 4-for-5 day marked Volpe's 6th multi-hit game of the season, but his 1st with more than 2 hits. It was Volpe's 3rd career 4-hit game and his first since 7/16/21 @ WIL. It's the 3rd 4-hit performance by a Patriot this year (Chad Bell 4/28 and 5/15). Volpe also racked up his 22nd RBI, which leads Somerset. In total, Volpe is 12-for-38 (.315) over his last 10 games. Coming into today, he has gone 4 straight games without striking out (18 PA). Prior to this stretch, he had only 2 2-game stretches this season without striking out.

**BACK AT IT AGAIN:** After combining to score just 9 runs over the series' first 4 games, the Patriots doubled that total with 9 runs in Saturday's win. After Somerset began the series with only 2 hits with RISP (neither of which scored runs), they also broke through for double that amount: 4 hits with RISP, all of which scored runs. Finally, coming into this series, the Patriots led the Eastern League in SB (72), but were held without one for 4 straight games before answering with 3 on Saturday (Dunham, 9-10; Lockridge, 7).

**UN-BULL-IEVABLE:** The Patriots bullpen has given up just 2 ER over its last 28 IP (0.64 ERA).

**RISPY BUSINESS:** Despite their 9 runs on Saturday, the Patriots' recent woes with RISP continued, going just 4-for-20 (.200), making them 6-for-37 (.162) with RISP in the series and 7-for-50 (.140) over their last 6 games. All 4 Somerset hits with RISP on Saturday came in the 5th and 6th inning, where they went 4-for-6 with RISP. The Patriots had 11 LOB on Saturday, one shy of a season-high, not including one GIDP, one pickoff (Volpe) and one tag-out at home (Gasper).

**SPREADING THE LOVE:** Mickey Gasper's first homer of the season on Saturday made it so that every active batter on the Patriots roster has hit a HR this season. On Saturday, all but one Patriot had a hit (Lockridge, 2 BB) and all but one Patriot had a walk (Dunham, 2 H). The Patriots drew a new season-high 9 walks on Saturday.

**TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT:** All 5 games of this series have been decided by 3 runs or less. During the month of May, 16/23 games the Patriots have played have been decided by 3 runs or less. In total, Somerset has had 27 of their first 43 games decided by 3 runs or less, going 15-12 in these games. Out of 11 games played between Portland and Somerset this season, 8 have been decided by 3 or fewer runs. The Patriots are 13-3 in games decided by 4+ runs.

- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and leading Renegades in starts (20), innings pitched (105.0) and strikeouts (118).
- Worked solely as a reliever in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team.
- Started out as solely a reliever in college, with all 16 of appearances coming out of the bullpen as a freshman in 2017. After posting a 7.56 ERA that year, Spence became a start a starter for his final two seasons (2018-19), starting 28/31 appearances. He set career-best college marks as a sophomore with a 3.03 ERA and 117 strikeouts.
- Born in Kirkland, WA, claims Cary, NC as his hometown. Attended Green Hope High School in Cary, where he became the school's all-time leader in career ERA and saves. Avid Carolina Hurricanes fan. Grew up a Seattle Mariners and Seahawks fan, Ken Griffey Jr. his favorite player.

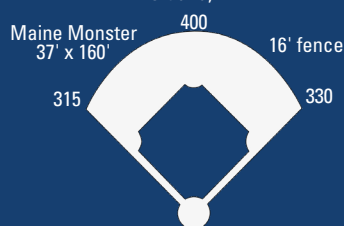

# COACHING STAFF



**DAN FIORITO**



**MANAGER**

Born and raised in Yonkers, NY, Dan Fiorito enters his sixth season with the Yankees organization and his first as Somerset's manager. Fiorito is also the Yankees' Roving Upper Level IF/OF Instructor. He served as the manager of High-A Hudson Valley in 2021, after making his managerial debut in 2019 with the GCL Yankees East. Fiorito also had been slated to manage the Yankees' former short-season Single-A affiliate, Staten Island in 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He served as the defensive coach at the Yankees' former Single-A Charleston affiliate in 2018, after making his professional coaching debut as defensive coach with the Yankees' former Rookie-level Pulaski affiliate in 2017.

His playing career began when he was signed by the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent in 2012. Over four seasons as an infielder in the Yankees system, he batted .240 (264-for-1102) with 107 runs, 52 doubles, six triples, seven home runs and 98 RBI in 322 career minor league games. Fiorito played three years at Manhattanville College (Purchase, NY) and is a 2008 graduate of Fordham Prep (Bronx, NY).



**GERARDO CASADIEGO**



**PITCHING COACH**

Gerardo Casadiego will begin his first season in Somerset and 10th in the Yankees organization. He held the same position in Hudson Valley last season, where the Renegades staff ranked second in the High-A East division in strikeouts (1,308, sixth in MiLB) and third in ERA (4.12). The Venezuela native has also previously served as the pitching coach for former Rookie-level Pulaski (2017-2019), DSL Yankees 1 (2014-2015) and DSL Yankees 2 (2016).

**JAKE HIRST**



**HITTING COACH**

Jacob Hirst will serve as hitting coach in his first season with Somerset and fourth with the Yankees organization. He was the hitting coach for Hudson Valley in 2021, when the Renegades' batters ranked second among High-A East clubs in triples (33) and OBP (.341), third in doubles (217) and fourth in home runs (156), batting average (.255), slugging percentage (.446) and OPS (.787). The Iowa native served the same role with the GCL Yankees West (2019-2020).



**AARON BOSSI**



**DEFENSIVE COACH**

Aaron Bossi begins his first season with Somerset after making his coaching debut in the same role with Hudson Valley in 2021. His prior experience for the organization was assisting rehabbing players at the minor league complex from 2017-2019. The St. Louis, MO native was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Yankees on June 24, 2016 as a catcher/infielder. He played in 22 games for the GCL Yankees East in 2016.
