

Community Outreach

CENTRAL TEXAS FLOOD RELIEF

The Round Rock Express and Nolan Ryan Foundation collaborated to raise funds and donations for those affected by the historic flooding that affected Central Texas in early July.

- Throughout the July 8-13 homestand, the Express partnered with Cody Pools to host a
 men's and women's hygiene donation drive. Fans, players and staff members brought
 two truckloads of hygiene products during the drive, which were delivered to areas
 affected by the floods that next week thanks to Cody Pools.
- The nightly 50/50 raffle, put on by the Nolan Ryan Foundation, had a continuously growing pot throughout the homestand and raised **over \$11,200**.
- We also raised **over \$5,600** through our game-worn and autographed Ryan Express 34s jersey auction.

The Express and Foundation made an immediate impact through the above fundraising efforts, but did not stop there. The Nolan Ryan Foundation coordinated with partner baseball clubs to donate \$100,000 to Texas flood relief. A quarter of these funds were raised and donated by the Express and Foundation thanks to our fans, players and staff members.

NOLAN RYAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Nolan Ryan Foundation works year-round to raise funds for its scholarship program. The program was recently elevated by establishing a scholarship endowment fund that awards a local outstanding high school senior a scholarship, renewable for up to four years, to help further their education. In partnership with the Round Rock ISD Partners in Education Foundation, the Nolan Ryan Foundation awarded Angelyna \$40,000 to continue her education at the University of Texas - Austin.

After a successful 2024 Brisket Bash, the E-Train teamed up with Goodstock by Nolan Ryan & the Nolan Ryan Foundation to bring the Brisket Bash BBQ Tasting back to Dell Diamond! Fans were able to grab a bite from 10 BBQ joints around the state of Texas with an exclusive ticket add-on, proceeds benefiting the John Brotherton's Pitmaster Foundation and Texas Flood Relief. The Express, through the Nolan Ryan Foundation, donated \$9,000 to both efforts through ticket add-on sales.

WILLIE WELLS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Every spring, the Nolan Ryan Foundation and the Round Rock Express award the Willie Wells Memorial Scholarship to an outstanding student athlete at Huston-Tillotson University. Hall of Famer Willie Wells, the scholarship's namesake, was a pioneer in the sport of baseball, playing in the Negro Leagues and most notably with the Austin Black Senators. This year, the Foundation and Express awarded the Willie Wells Memorial Scholarship to Grecia, a Huston-Tillotson softball student athlete.

Each year the Express partner with little leagues in the Central Texas region to host their own Youth League Night. In total, Dell Diamond hosted local baseball and softball leagues across 26 games and raised **over \$32,200** in 2025.


PLAY BALL WEEKEND

The Round Rock Area Serving Center teamed up with the Express at every Tuesday home game in 2025 to strike out hunger in our community. Collectively, we received over 7,000 pounds of canned food (2,000 pounds more than 2024) from Express fans to help feed our community).

MILITARY & FIRST RESPONDER APPRECIATION

The Express are proud to pay tribute to local military members and first responders. In 2025, the Express honored 20 heroes through our Hero Salute Program, presented by Sport Clips, and donated \$2,500 in tickets to them and their families. The E-Train also provide discounted tickets

to every Round Rock Express home game through GOVX.

GOOD SPORT PROGRAM

To prevent drinking & driving and promote responsible drinking, the Express teamed up with Brown Distributing to implement the Good Sport Program at each Thursday and Friday Express game.

THE SALVATION ARMY DONATION DRIVE

The Express and Salvation Army teamed up for a season-long donation drive.
