## THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2016, the Sounds walked off on the Iowa Cubs in their home finale 6-5. Franklin Barreto tripled to score Josh Rodriguez in the bottom of the ninth inning to secure the victory. Barreto finished the contest with three hits.

**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Durham Bulls continue their six-game series has major implications in the International League second half title chase. The two clubs split last night's doubleheader, with Durham taking game one 9-4 and Nashville winning the nightcap 4-2. Nashville southpaw Robert Gasser hopes to build upon his excellent August, while righty Anthony Molina starts for Durham.

**Robert Gasser:** 24-year-old Robert Gasser makes his 24th appearance (23rd start) of the season tonight. The southpaw is 9-1 with a 3.85 ERA (119.1 IP/51 ER) and has won each of his last four starts. Gasser is one of four pitchers in the International League this season to win four consecutive starts. He fanned four over 6.0 innings of quality baseball (3 ER) at Gwinnett his last time out. Gasser leads the Triple-A level with 147 strikeouts and ranks among league leaders in ERA (2nd), opponent batting average (2nd, .232), WHIP (3rd, 1.25), wins (T-2nd), innings (4th) and starts (T-4th). He also leads the International League in win percentage (.900). Gasser's 147 strikeouts this season is the 10th-most in Sounds history, just behind Chris Hammond's 149 punchouts in 1990. The No. 6 prospect in the Brewers system per MLB Pipeline, Gasser was acquired by Milwaukee from San Diego (along with LHP Taylor Rogers, OF Esteury Ruiz and RHP Dinelson Lamet) in exchange for LHP Josh Hader on August 1, 2022. The California native was originally selected in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres.

**Anthony Molina:** 21-year-old Anthony Molina makes his 10th appearance of the season (ninth start) for Durham. He is 1-2 with a 5.65 ERA (36.2 IP/23 ER) with the Bulls in 2023. Molina failed to earn an out in his last start at Norfolk, allowing eight runs (7 ER) over eight batters faced and taking the loss. That is the most runs allowed in a start without recording an out in the minor leagues this season. Before his promotion to Durham on July 7, Molina went 2-5 with a 4.61 ERA in 15 starts for Double-A Montgomery. In 2022, the right-hander paced the Rays organization with 14 wins between High-A Bowling Green (13) and Single-A Charleston (1). Molina was signed by Tampa Bay as an international free agent on July 2, 2018 out of his native Venezuela.

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in the second half of 2023: First: 6 (Tied), Second: 17, Third: 18, Fourth: 10, Fifth: 4, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Hiura Keeps Hitting:** Keston Hiura extended his on-base streak to 25 games with a first inning walk and hitting streak to a team season-high 15 games with knocks in both ends of Thursday's doubleheader. His hitting streak is the longest active streak in the International League, while his on-base streak is tied for the fourth longest active streak in the IL. Dating back to the start of his on-base streak on July 28, Hiura is tied for the most RBI in the league (28) and holds the 10th-best batting average at .333.

**Toro Reaches 20... Again:** Abraham Toro extended his on-base streak to 20 games last night with a walk in game one and double in game two. He is the first Sounds player to have two separate on-base streaks of 20 games in the same season since at least 2010. Dating to the beginning of the streak on July 9, Toro is batting .405 (32-for-79) with 11 doubles, three homers, 15 RBI, 20 runs and 1.142 OPS.

**Consistent Cam:** Cam Devanney extended his on-base streak to 16 games and hitting streak to 10 games with a pair of hits in game two last night. Dating back to the beginning of his on-base streak on August 10, he is batting .314 (16-for-51) with six doubles, a home run, nine RBI, nine runs and an .887 OPS.

**Vieira Locks It Down:** Thyago Vieira earned the save in last night's win. In his last 15 appearances dating back to the beginning of July, Vieira has posted a 1.15 ERA (15.2 IP/2 ER) and is a perfect 6-for-6 in save opportunities. The hard-throwing Brazilian has struck out 22 of 62 hitters faced (35.5%) over the span.

**September Silly Season:** Major League rosters expanded by two spots today, allowing Milwaukee to recall INF/OF Owen Miller and LHP Clayton Andrews from Nashville. Yesterday, outfielder Chris Roller was acquired from Cleveland for cash considerations and was added to Nashville's roster today.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's recently updated Top-30 Milwaukee prospects list. Infielder Tyler Black is the No. 5 prospect and No. 56 in baseball, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 6 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the organization's No. 29 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Manager Rick Sweet collected his 307th win at the helm of the Nashville club last night. He trails Rick Renick (1993-96) for second place on the all-time Sounds manager wins list. In order for Sweet to pass Trent Jewett (1998-00, 2003-04) for the most wins in Sounds history, Nashville would need to win 14 of their next 21 games. Sweet has a 307-241 record in four seasons as Nashville's skipper.

**LAST OUTING:** Gasser spun his fourth consecutive quality start on August 25 at Gwinnett, allowing three runs over 6.0 innings. The southpaw did not issue a walk for the second straight time and struck out four. Gasser earned his fourth win in as many starts in Nashville’s 7-3 victory.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Tonight will be Gasser’s third career start against Durham, with both of his previous outings coming this season. His last time out (8/4), he held the Bulls to two hits over 6.0 scoreless frames, punching out 10 hitters. Overall, Gasser is 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA (12.2 IP/2 ER) and 18 strikeouts when facing Durham.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is on Nashville's Opening Day roster for the first time in his career
- Was first Nashville starter to pitch into the sixth in a start this season with 5.1 frames on April 12
- Allowed a career-high three home runs on April 30 vs. Omaha - one each in the third, fourth and fifth innings
- After posting 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP/4 ER) over first three starts, had 6.52 ERA (29.0 IP/21 ER) in next six games
- Spun a 6.2-inning gem in a convincing win on May 19 at Durham...was the longest outing this season by a Sounds pitcher at the time
- Tossed 7.0 scoreless inning gem on June 1 at Charlotte with no walks and nine strikeouts... followed it up with a 7.0-inning complete game on June 7 at Jacksonville, his first career complete game
- In bizarre outing on July 7 vs. Columbus, ejected after throwing one pitch (HBP, Brayan Rocchio)... is only one-pitch start by a Nashville starter since the year 2000
- Struck out a season-high 10 in win over Durham on August 4... was his first double-digit strikeout game in Milwaukee organization, with his last coming with Fort Wayne on July 9, 2022 (G1)
- Did not allow a first-inning run through first 15 starts of season
- With 6.0-inning, 10-strikeout performance on August 18 vs. Charlotte, became first Sounds pitcher to have three consecutive starts with 9+ strikeouts since Mike Fiers (4/18-4/30/14)... start was the fifth outing of 10+ strikeouts and 0 walks in International League this season
- With 4-0 record in August, became first Sounds pitcher to win four starts in a month since Colin Rea in September 2021... is 31st time a Nashville pitcher has won four or more decisions in a month since 1998
- Pitched fourth consecutive quality start on August 25 at Gwinnett (6.0 IP, 3 ER)... is one of just four pitchers in International League this season with four straight quality outings, joining Michael Soroka (GWN), Matt Dermody (WOR) and Nick Nelson (LHV)
- After walking 25 hitters in first eight appearances (5.92 per 9 IP, 14.7%), has issued 18 free passes in last 15 games (1.99 per 9 IP, 5.2%)

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 7-12 with a 3.94 ERA in 27 starts between Nashville, Biloxi, and Fort Wayne... ranked fifth in Minor League Baseball with 172 strikeouts
- Recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts on 6/8 vs. Lake County
