> IF YOU'RE NOT FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The Bradenton Marauders' offense has scored in the first inning in seven of their last nine games. During this stretch, they own a 5-4 record.

> ROSTER MOVES: Prior to Tuesday's game, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced a number of roster moves affecting the Bradenton Marauders. Pitchers **Michael Kennedy** and **Carlos Jimenez**, infielders **Javier Rivas** and **Duce Gourson** were promoted to High-A Greensboro. Gourson, a 2024 9th round pick of UCLA reached base in his final seven games as a Marauder while Michael Kennedy sported a 2.33 ERA across five appearances in August in his return from the injured list.Rivas leaves Bradenton with 12 HRs, which is good for seventh in the Florida State League.

> **TARPON FISHING:** The Tampa Tarpons make their lone visit to LECOM Park this year beginning on Tuesday night. The Marauders have dropped seven of the first nine meetings against Tampa, including being swept out of the All-Star break at George M. Steinbrenner Field. Bradenton split a pair of series and lost the other in their three meetings last year. In their only trip to Bradenton last August, Tampa won four out of the six games. In fact, the Tarpons have won their last three series meetings in Bradenton and haven't lost one since May of 2019.

> SCOUTING THE TARPONS: The Tampa Tarpons, the New York Yankees Single-A affiliate, are coming off a six-game home split with first-place Fort Myers. Their roster features three of the Yankeees' Top 30 prospects which is headlined by Roderick Arias (No. 4)

> ALUMNI UPDATE: RHP Luis Peralta made his Major League debut with the Colorado Rockies on Aug. 24, becoming the 105th Marauder to appear in the Major Leagues. Peralta spent 2022 and 2023 with Bradenton before starting 2024 in High-A Greensboro where he allowed just two earned runs in 30.0 innings. The 23-year-old was then promoted to Double-A Altoona on June 25 before he was dealt to the Rockies at the trade deadline for LHP Jalen Beeks. Peralta struck out two in 1.2 scoreless in the Bronx against the New York Yankees in his debut.

> SECOND INNINGS IS OURS: This season, the Bradenton Marauders have scored 73 runs in the second inning. The 73 runs are the sixthmost in Single-A this season and 11th-most among High-A and Double-A teams as well.

> $\textbf{ANYBODY BUT LAKELAND PLEASE:} \ Against the \ Lakeland \ Flying \ Tigers in 24 games, the \ Marauders pitching staff owns a 4.95 \ ERA. \ Against every other opponent in the Florida State League (97 games), Bradenton's staff owns a 3.81 \ ERA. \ They also hold \ K/9 of 9.93 \ and \ BB/9 of BB/9 of$ 4.71 compared to 8.85 and 5.66.

> AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold three of the top seven home run leaders in the Florida State League, with Esmerlyn Valdez leading the way in second with 18 longballs. **Axiel Plaz** is currently in fourth with 15 and **Javier Rivas** is in seventh with 12 Valdez is just two HR shy of tying league leader in Ariel Almonte (Daytona). The 18 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

> CLOSE QUARTERS: Both wins on Saturday against Lakeland marked the Marauders' 40th and 41st one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 21-20 record in those games. After dropping their previous five one-run games, Bradenton has won three-straight
