BUSY AS A BEE

♦ The Reno Aces are fresh off a positive first homestand to the 2025 season against the Tacoma Rainiers, coming out on top in four of six matchups. Reno will now head to Salt Lake to handle the Bees, the Triple-A Affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels... The BLC-Nine came out swinging in Tuesday's series opener, cruising to a dominant 7-1 win over the Rainiers. **Brandon Bielak** was impressive in his Aces debut, holding Tacoma hitless through 4 2/3 innings while allowing two walks and striking out two in front of the GNF crowd. **Tim Tawa** continued his scorching start to the season, going 2-for-3 with a triple, a home run, and four RBIs... Thursday night's commanding 8-2 win was fueled by standout performances from Tawa and **Jordan Lawlar**, who each tallied multiple hits and three RBIs... Tawa wouldn't return to the Aces lineup after Thursday night's win and for a good reason. The Stanford product earned a well-deserved call-up to the big leagues after slashing .391/.462/.957 with three home runs and 12 RBIs over the season's first six games. He made his MLB debut on Saturday against the Washington Nationals... Reno returned to the win column that same day, handling the Rainiers with a confident 6-1 victory. It was a historic day at Greater Nevada Field as **Idemaro Vargas** etched his name into the record books, becoming the Aces' all-time leader in runs scored with his 273rd career tally. **Cristian Mena** held it down on the mound, limiting the Rainiers to one run with five punchouts in six strong innings, cruising to his first win of the year... Tied at three games apiece, Sunday's series finale wasn't just another day at the ballpark – it was a statement game for Reno. The Aces' offense exploded for 13 runs, driven by a seven-run third inning that buried Tacoma and sealed Reno's first series win of the year... With the series victory now in the rearview, the Reno Aces head to Salt Lake to face the Bees.

ACES vs ANDERSON

♦ The Aces will face right-hander Shaun Anderson in Tuesday's series opener... The 30-year-old has struggled in his first two outings of the year, posting a 6.52 ERA with nine punchouts and three walks in 9 2/3 total innings... He allowed nine runs (three earned) on seven hits and three walks in 4 2/3 innings vs the Albuquerque Isotopes in his previous outing... Anderson owns 69 appearances (18 starts) in the big leagues, playing for seven different teams in the last five or six years. He has gone 3-7 with a 6.10 ERA 117 strikeouts and 63 walks over 152 total innings... The Aces can expose the Bees early against Anderson in Tuesday's series opener.

♦ NEXT STARTER: RHP YILBER DIAZ (0-1, 2.89 ERA) ♦

♦ **Yilber Diaz** will take the mound in Wednesday's match-up against the Salt Lake Bees... Diaz pitched well in his previous outing, limiting the Tacoma Rainiers to one run across 4 2/3 frames with three walks and five punchouts... The exciting prospect has yet to surpass the five-inning mark this season but has held it down on the bump, striking out 11 in 9 1/3 total innings of work in his two starts... Diaz faced the Bees once in 2024 and was efficient, allowing three runs (zero earned) with two walks and six strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings... In 10 games (eight starts) with the Aces in 2024, the young right-hander posted a 3.22 ERA with an 18/68 BB/K in 50 1/3 frames... Diaz will be locked in on Wednesday night searching for his first win of the season vs the Bees.

♥ **Idemaro Vargas:** Has raked vs the Bees in his career, slashing .382/.466/.528 with 23 XBH (2 HR), 28 RBI, and 26 BB in 199 at bats (49 games)... The switch-hitter has hit considerably well to start the 2025 season, slashing .323/.400/.548 with 3 XBH (2 HR), 7 RBI, and 4 BB in 8 games... 7-for-22 (.318) with 2 HR vs TAC in the previous series... .304/.360/.478 with 2 XBH (1 HR), and 4 RBI vs RHP this season.

♦ **Gustavo Campero:** Is off to a scorching start to the 2025 campaign, going 15-for-39 (.385) with 7 XBH, 4 RBI, and 4 BB in his first nine games... Went 11-for-25 (.44) with 5 XBH in the previous series vs ABQ... Campero was solid in 2024, slashing .279/.393/.472 with 38 XBH (14 HR), 45 RBI, and 39 BB in 314 AB in split time with Double-A Rocket City and Triple-A Salt Lake... Has hit .407/.467/.667 with 3 2B, 2 3B, and 4 RBI vs RHP this season.

CORCO-CANNON

♦ **Billy Corcoran** is set to make his second start of the campaign in Tuesday's series opener vs the Salt Lake Bees... Corcoran was hit around in his first outing, allowing the Tacoma Rainiers to score five runs (four earned) on nine hits and two walks in four frames. He did not collect any strikeouts... The 6'8 right-hander was efficient in 2024, splitting time between High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo. With Hillsboro, Corcoran went 2-0 with a 2.22 ERA and 36 punchouts in 28 1/3 total innings (five starts)... He was called up to the Sod Poodles in May, posting a 4.92 ERA with 78 strikeouts in 106 frames... The 25-year-old's best outing in 2024 came in early April when he limited the Tri-City Dust Devils to just one run across six commanding innings, walking none and striking out a season-high nine batters... Corcoran will look to look past his struggles and towards a win in Tuesday's series opener.

♦ Signed a minor league deal with the Diamondbacks on July 27, 2022... Was originally drafted in the 36th round (1079 overall) by the Texas Rangers in the 2018 MLB Draft but chose to honor his commitment to the University of Pittsburgh.

HAIL TO PITTI!

♥ Majored in Legal Studies at the University of Pittsburgh... During his tenure with the Pitt Panthers, he made 28 appearances with 19 starts, accumulating a 4-8 record, a 4.08 ERA, and 91 strikeouts over 103.2 innings pitched. In the 2020 season, he led the team with a 0.95 WHIP and limited opponents to a .190 batting average. His junior year in 2022 was particularly notable; he earned Third Team All-ACC honors and was named ACC Pitcher of the Week on April 25 after a standout performance against No. 4 Miami, where he allowed just one run with eight strikeouts over seven innings.

BECOMING A SNAKE

♥ After his junior year, Corcoran signed as an undrafted free agent with the Arizona Diamondbacks in July 2022. He began his professional career with the ACL D-backs and quickly progressed through the minor league system. In April 2024, while with the High-A Hillsboro Hops, he was named the organization's Minor League Pitcher of the Month, posting a 2-0 record with a 2.53 ERA and 28 strikeouts over 21.1 innings. Later that year, with the Double-A Amarillo Sod Poodles, Corcoran recorded an 8-8 record with a 4.35 ERA and 114 strikeouts over 134.1 innings pitched.
