### LAST TIME OUT - FIREFLIES 4, RIVERDOGS 1

The RiverDogs fell in a first inning hole and couldn't climb out, dropping the series opener 4-1 to Columbia on Tuesday night... Ryan Andrade took the loss, despite working a career-high seven innings, and allowing just two earned runs to collect his seventh quality start of the year... Charleston scored its lone run on a Jose Monzon sacrifice fly in the fifth inning... The RiverDogs put runners on second and third with one out, trailing by two in the seventh inning, but failed to score either runner... The 'Dogs finished the game 0-6 with runners in scoring position... Moises Palma made his Single-A debut out of the bullpen in the eighth and allowed an earned run while striking out two....

### HOW ARE THINGS AT HOME?

The RiverDogs have lost four consecutive home games - their longest home losing streak of the season. In those four losses, the 'Dogs been held to just three combined runs. Meanwhile, opponents have tallied 19.

### HOME HEAVY

The RiverDogs are in the midst of playing 15 of their final 18 games before the All-Star break at home. Through 10 games, the team is 3-7. The RiverDogs come out of the All Star break with nine consecutive road games, and 15 of 21 away from Charleston.

### OF THE HIGHEST QUALITY

RiverDogs starter Ryan Andrade pitched yet another quality start on Tuesday, pitching seven innings of two-run ball. Andrade's seven quality starts lead Single-A baseball. Jose Urbina's six are tied for second. The RiverDogs 24 quality starts are the most in Single-A by seven and tied for the fourth most in MiLB.

### WE LIKE LEFTIES

The RiverDogs struggled against left handed pitching to open the season but have improved drastically in the month. Since June 1, the RiverDogs are hitting lefties at a .254 clip with a .709 OPS. In April and May, Charleston hit .207 with a .546 OPS against southpaws.

### WHERE ARE THE FIREWORKS?

July has not been kind to Charleston, as the RiverDogs have opened the month 1-5. Charleston has particularly struggled at the plate, batting just .193 in six games this month, the second-lowest average in the league, while their .521 OPS is the lowest.

### SERIES STREAK = SNAPPED

Friday night's defeat clinched a series loss for Charleston, snapping a streak of five consecutive sets with a win or split. The RiverDogs last series loss came May 20-25 at Augusta, when the GreenJackets took five of six. The RiverDogs lost four of their first five series of the season before winning six of their last eight.

### NICE AND CLOSE

50 of the RiverDogs 81 games (61%) have been decided by three runs or fewer. However, Charleston has played 17 one-run games - the fewest in the league.

### INNINGS FOR DINNER

The RiverDogs starting staff has thrown 388.1 innings through 81 games - the most in Single-A by 18 innings. The RiverDogs 24 quality starts are the most in Single-A, while their 3.73 rotation ERA is 5th of 30. The team's 28 wins by starters lead Single-A.

### MATEO'S MONTH

Angel Mateo was named the Carolina League player of the month for June by MiLB last Thursday afternoon. Mateo becomes the first RiverDog to win a player of the month honor this season. The native of San Juan De La Maguana, DR had a monster month, leading the league in batting average (.349), hits (30), RBIs (24) and finished second in OPS (.945). Entering today's action, Mateo is fourth in the league in batting and leads the league in RBIs.

### HOME COOKING

The RiverDogs pitching staff has been particularly effective at home this season, posting a 3.25 ERA in 43 games - the third-lowest home ERA in Single-A. However, the team's numbers on the road take a sizable hit (see right).

**LAST START:** Made Single-A season debut on 7/2 vs MB... Surrendered 2 ER on 4 hits and 3 walks... One run scored in the second and third innings...  
**IT'S BEEN A WHILE:** First start with the 'Dogs on 7/2 was first appearance with Charleston since April 16, 2024.  
**ON ASSIGNMENT:** Made four rehab starts with FCL Rays coming off 60-day IL... pitched to a 5.14 ERA in 7 innings; struck out 10 and walked just 3.

ABOUT ANDREW

**ORIGIN STORY:** Acquired by the Rays in a trade in November 2023 with the Marlins that sent Vidal Brujan and Calvin Faucher to Miami... Was selected by the Marlins in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of Tennessee  
**OFF THE SHELF:** Opened season with Charleston in 2024, pitched 8 innings in April but then landed on full-season IL...  
**THE ROAD LESS TRAVELED:** Lindsey spent his college career at three different schools... Began at Walters State CC and pitched his freshman and sophomore seasons there (19-20)... Transferred to UNC Charlotte for 2021, posted a 4.89 ERA in 81 innings... Took a year off from baseball in 2022... Transferred to Tennessee for 2023 season, opened campaign in the bullpen before moving to the rotation and earning Baseball America All-America 3rd team honors...  
**A YEAR AWAY:** Intended to retire from baseball by taking 2022 season off... Picked up government contract work helping Waverly, TN clean up from major flooding... Returned to baseball by coaching a youth travel team, then tried out for the Appalachian Summer League, where he caught the eye of Tennessee...  
**WHAT HE'S SAYING:** "That job I had was not glamorous in any way," Lindsey said. "Some of the guys I was working with had been doing it for years. And even though it wasn't in the spotlight and didn't come with a lot of thank yous, those guys would come in to work every day cracking jokes, enjoying life and being grateful for everything they had... That was something that I tried to carry over into baseball."

**LAST OUTING:** Was promoted to A+ Bowling Green for a spot start on 7/3... Pitched 5.2 innings and allowed 1 ER... Allowed lone run in final inning of work.

**NEAR PERFECTION:** Hurlled seven perfect innings on 6/20 at Kannapolis to earn Carolina League pitcher of the week honors... Struck out 5... Marked first time since 2007 that a RiverDog starter pitched 5 or more perfect innings...

**10/10:** Galan became the first RiverDogs pitcher this season to strike out 10 batters, punching out 10 on 6/6 at Carolina... Was Galan's first 10K game since High School.

**THROWN INTO THE FIRE:** Made Single-A debut in long relief, relieving Janzen Keisel in the first inning on 5/23 at Augusta... Threw 5.1 innings, surrendered 5 ER including HRs...

**FANTASTIC IN FCL:** Opened the season with the FCL Rays... Made three appearances, two of which were starts.... Allowed just 1 ER in 12 IP... All three outings came against FCL Braves...

**ABOUT ANDRES**

**ORIGIN STORY:** Drafted by Tampa Bay in 17th round last year after three-year college career at Cal...

**COLLEGE YEARS:** Posted 4.38 career ERA in 86.1 innings for Cal... Capped career with 3.40 ERA in 39.2 innings, split between bullpen and rotation; struck out 44 while walking just 17...

**BEARISH:** Grew up a Cal fan in Elk Grove, CA... Located south of Sacramento... First generation college student... Uncle, Mike Tonis, was drafted in second round out of Cal by the Royals in 2000 MLB Draft, eventually played two MLB games with Royals in 2004...

**TWO-WAY:** Opened college career as a two-way player... Got one at-bat as a freshman, hit a double vs New Mexico

**PRINCETON MAN:** Spent 2022 summer ball season with Princeton WhistlePigs (West Virginia) of the Appalachian League... Princeton was the Rays Advanced Rookie Affiliate from 1997-2020.

**WHAT HE'S SAYING:** On his hitting aspirations - "It's funny, looking back on it, I tried really hard to be a hitter... It made me a better man. It taught me the struggle, because up until that point I hadn't struggled a ton... That's when I realized I wanted to take pitching more seriously; that made me a better pitcher."

## COACHING STAFF

### Sean Smedley

### Manager

Sean Smedley is back for his ninth season with the Rays and third season as Manager of the RiverDogs. Smedley led the team to complete the three-peat as Carolina League Champions in 2023, as well as the South Division second half title in 2024. During his playing career, he was a part of the Rays system in Bowling Green and Hudson Valley, and in 2016 he began his coaching career within the same organization he played for as video coordinator for the Princeton Rays. From 2017-2019, he was the bench coach for Hudson Valley. In 2021, after the Covid-19 pandemic, he became the bench coach for the RiverDogs. Smedley helped guide the RiverDogs to a dominant 82-38 campaign where they would eventually secure their inaugural title. He left to become a bench coach for Double-A Montgomery in 2022 and returned to the Lowcountry the following year.

### Brett Schneider

### Hitting Coach

Brett Schneider returns to the Holy City for a second season as the hitting coach of the RiverDogs. The bats saw massive improvements throughout 2024 and finished third in the league in walks and fourth in on-base percentage. Schneider spent the previous four years as a hitting coach in the Seattle Mariners farm system, including with the Arizona Complex League Mariners in 2023. Prior to coaching in the professional ranks, Schneider was a volunteer assistant coach at Florida Atlantic University. He also served as hitting coach for the Green Bay Bullfrogs of the Northwoods League in 2016 and managed the Great Lakes Collegiate League's Richmond Jazz in 2017.

### Levi Romero

### Pitching Coach

Levi (pronounced Lev-ee) Romero is back for a third season as the pitching coach after guiding the 2024 staff to the most shutouts in the league (15) and the circuit's fourth-best ERA. Prior to joining the RiverDogs, he served in the same role with the Rays Florida Complex League affiliate in 2022. Romero was the pitching coach for one of the Rays two entries in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. His playing career began in 2003 when he was signed out of Venezuela by the Houston Astros. In all, he pitched for five years in Minor League Baseball with the Astros and Texas Rangers before embarking on a seven-year international career that included stops in Venezuela and Japan and ended in 2015.

### Francisco Leandro

### Bench Coach

Leandro will serve as bench coach for the RiverDogs after spending each of the last two seasons with the FCL Rays. His primary responsibilities will include outfield defense and baserunning. After playing collegiately at Central Missouri, Leandro was drafted by Tampa Bay in 2004 and played in 31 games for the RiverDogs later that season. Prior to joining the Rays, the Venezuela native coached for both the Toronto Blue Jays and New York Yankees. He returned to Charleston as a defensive coach for the 2019 RiverDogs, who were affiliated with New York at the time.

### Strength and Conditioning

Rance Terry is in his first season with the Rays as well as the RiverDogs. He spent the last four years as the Senior Performance Coach for the University of Louisville's baseball and men's golf teams. Terry has previously worked in the farm systems of the Kansas City Royals and St. Louis Cardinals as well as collegiately at Purdue, Louisiana Tech, Florida Gulf Coast University, Tarleton State, Texas Tech and Texas Christian University. A 2012 graduate of Lubbock Christian University, Terry earned a bachelor's degree in exercise science while catching for the Chaparral baseball team. In 2015, he earned also a master's degree in Kinesiology from Tarleton State.

### Kyndell Crowell

### Athletic Trainer

Kyndell Crowell is in her first full season as Athletic Trainer for the RiverDogs. She served in the same role for the FCL Rays during each of the last two seasons. Prior to joining the Rays in 2023, Crowell spent the 2022 campaign as associate athletic trainer for the Milwaukee Brewers Single-A affiliate in the Carolina League. She has a master's degree in athletic training from Point Loma Nazarene University.
