FRISCO SUFFERS WORST LOSS OF SEASON TO MIDLAND IN FINALE:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped the series finale against the Midland RockHounds 13-2 on Sunday afternoon from Momentum Bank Ballpark. The RockHounds (15-12) jumped on Frisco (13-14) starter **Wyatt Sparks** (1-1) early with a run in the first and six more in the second inning to knock him out of the game in the second frame. The Riders then found the scoreboard in the third when **Nick Tanielu** bashed a two-run homer, but that's the only offense Frisco would get on the day. It was Tanielu's second home run of the season Midland proceeded to put up five more runs in the fifth and another in the sixth to complete the blowout win. Outside of Tanielu, **Jax Biggers**, **Luisangel Acuña** and **Evan Carter** all picked up hits for Frisco and **Antoine Kelly** worked a scoreless eighth from the bullpen.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING HARDWARE:

The RoughRiders had three players honored by their parent club in their April awards. **Evan Carter** won Player of the Month in the org, hitting .343/.500/.543/1.043 with a league-best 21 walks while **Grant Wolfram** earned Reliever of the Month honors by not allowing a run over 9.2 innings with 11 strikeouts. **Luisangel Acuña** anchored the best defensive team in the minors to take home Defender of the Month, playing both shortstop and second base.

HOME SWEET HOME:

The RoughRiders return home today after their first of two two-week road trips this season. Frisco finished 5-7 on the road trip to Amarillo and Midland, dropping the series to the RockHounds 4-2. Out of its 27 games this season, Frisco has played 18 contests away from Riders Field. Their nine home games are the fewest in the league to this point.

PITCHING STRUGGLING:

While on the road, Frisco had trouble on the mound. Over the last 12 games, Frisco has a 6.99 ERA, which is the second-worst in the Texas League (7.27, Wichita). The Riders allowed 14 home runs, which was second-to-last in the league as well (15, Wichita). The Frisco bullpen had a 7.02 ERA over the last two weeks, ballooning their reliever ERA to 4.63 this season, which is still fourth in the league. After the tough two weeks, Frisco is still fifth in the league with a 4.92 ERA.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .333/.422/.538/.960 with three doubles, a triple, a home run and five RBIs while walking six times and just striking out six times. Over the last 10 games, he has raised his average 93 points and his OPS 253 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .317 (38-for-120)/.366/.458/.824 through the first 27 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (38), tied for fourth in doubles (9), sixth in total bases (55) and second in stolen bases (14). Over his last 23 games, he is batting .343/.398/.510/.908. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (118).

LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 32 RBIs with the bases loaded this year, which is also second most in Double-A (Biloxi, 38). As a team, they are hitting .379 (11-for-29)/.371/.931/1.302 with four grand slams and 34 RBIs. They are one of three teams in Minor League Baseball with four grand slams this season already (Triple-A Norfolk and Double-A Tennessee) as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another in San Antonio, **Luisangel Acuña** blasted one against Arkansas and **Jax Biggers** slugged one in Amarillo.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed 12 errors through 27 games. On Thursday in Midland, they had their first multi-error game of the year. The team's .987 fielding percentage is the second-best in Minor League Baseball. Their 12 errors are the second-fewest in the minors.

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 150 walks is fourth among non-Triple-A teams while their .357 team OBP is second in Double-A. **Evan Carter** has the Double-A lead with 26 walks and **Dustin Harris** is fourth with 23 (second in the Texas League) while Carter is first in OBP (.463) in the league.

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 21 of his 24 games this season, batting .301 (28-for-93)/.463/.452/.915 with two doubles, four home runs, 26 walks, 20 RBIs and four stolen bases. Carter is first in the Texas League in OBP (.463) and first in walks (26). The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter also opened the season as the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Devon Strake De Los Santos of Amarillo. Since going 0-for-4 for the first time this season on Saturday in San Antonio, Carter has walked 21 times to 10 strikeouts over 16 games with a 4.74 OBP.

ABOUT ROBY

-On his name Tekoah: Born in Hendersonville, North Carolina and, about two hours away in Georgia, there is a beautiful area named Toccoa Falls with waterfalls and outdoor activities. His parents were driving around there one day and liked the way it sounded, so they changed the spelling and named their son Tekoah.

-Originally committed to Troy University in Alabama.

-Paired a 7-3 record with a 1.19 ERA in his junior season at Pine Forest High School in Pensacola, Fla., earning the 2019 Pensacola News Journal Pitcher of the Year award...recorded 109 strikeouts against just 10 walks that season while contributing a .384 batting average and 28 RBI at the plate to lead Pine Forest to its first regional appearance in 12 years.

-Is one of several Texas minor leaguers enrolled in the club's 'RangersU Powered by ACU' program, which allows players and coaches to earn academic credit by taking online courses taught by Abilene Christian University faculty and staff in both English and Spanish.

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 12 prospect in the Rangers system per MLB.com.

-Struck out seven over six innings on April 15th in San Antonio, allowing all four runs with two outs (two runs in the second inning and two runs in the sixth before he exited).

2022 SEASON

-Was one of the youngest starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League, pitching the entire season at the age of 20.

-Late in the season, he added a slider to give himself a true four-pitch mix.

-Led the Crawdads staff in innings pitched (104.2) and strikeouts (126).

-Over his first six starts, he allowed 23 runs (7.67 ERA), but rebounded to collect a 3.59 ERA over his last 16 games (15 starts), starting on May 24th.

-In his last five starts, Roby owned a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP), striking out 36 batters to just five walks.

-On August 19th, he threw an immaculate inning against Winston-Salem (nine pitches with three strikeouts).

2021 SEASON

-Made only six starts because of an elbow sprain in June, but did not have surgery.

-It was a proximal tear in the UCL, which heals easier than a distal tear without surgery.

-In six starts, struck out 38.9% of hitters (35 of 90) and held opponents to a .177 batting average against.
