TODAY marks game #101 of the 2023 season, the first game of a six-game roadtrip, and the first game of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 17 times during the 2022 regular season, with the Whitecaps winning the series 9-8, and will play 24 times in 2023. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 29th season in pro baseball, while Great Lakes is in their 16th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps hit the road for the first time in August for a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons (High A - Los Angeles Dodgers) from August 8-13 before returning to LMCU Ballpark for a six-game stretch against the South Bend Cubs from August 15-August 20.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The West Michigan Whitecaps saw a dominant pitching performance and clutch hitting carry them to their seventh-straight victory 3-1 over the Lake County Captains in front of 7,176 fans Saturday night at LMCU Ballpark. Whitecaps starter Carlos Pena put on a show, tossing six scoreless frames with eight strikeouts as 'Caps pitchers posted 11 punchouts while holding Lake County to an 0-for-4 mark with runners in scoring position in the win. Meanwhile, Eliezer Alfonzo and Roberto Campos combined to go 3-for-7 with a double, triple, and three RBI. Neither team scored through the first three innings, as Lake County and West Michigan managed just one hit a piece. In the fourth, Alfonzo scored Hao-Yu Lee on an RBI single before Campos added an RBI triple, jumping in front 2-0. At the same time, Pena held the Captains to just three hits through the first six innings as Alfonzo added an RBI triple, extending the advantage to 3-0. The Whitecaps bullpen picked up where Pena left off, as reliever Bryce Tassin tossed two scoreless innings with a pair of strikeouts to maintain the 3-0 lead. Lake County finally scored in the ninth as Chase DeLauter crossed the plate on a wild pitch, but it was too late, as 'Caps closer Dario Gardea struck out Captains left fielder Jorge Burgos to earn the save and put the finishing touches on the 3-1 victory. The Whitecaps record improves to 51-49 overall and 19-16 in the second half, while the Captains fall to 46-54 and 15-20 in the second half. Pena (4-6) secures his fourth win of the year as Gardea collects his sixth save. Captains starter Aaron Davenport (3-9) suffers his ninth loss of the year, allowing three runs (two earned) through seven innings of work. The Whitecaps extend their longest winning streak of the season to seven straight and are one win shy of tying the longest win streak with Brayan Pena as manager. The Whitecaps now sit 1.0 games back of first place in the Midwest League East Division and are tied with the Dayton Dragons for second place.

CANCEL CULTURE: The Whitecaps scheduled game between the West Michigan Whitecaps and Lake County Captains at LMCU Ballpark on Sunday was canceled. Due to steady rain showers throughout Sunday morning, the decision was made to cancel the contest. Because the Whitecaps sit just one game out of first place in the Midwest League East division, the possibility remains that, due to playoff implications, these two teams could meet for a makeup game at the end of the regular season. West Michigan and Lake County are not scheduled to meet again in 2023, making Sunday's contest a tentative cancellation.

IMPOSING HIS WIL-KEL: Whitecaps pitcher Wilkel Hernandez has allowed just two runs over his last 21 innings pitched while posting a 25-to-2 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

BRINGING THE PENA: Whitecaps pitcher Carlos Pena was named Midwest Player of the Week on July 24. The lefty tossed ten innings while giving up just one run on one base hit while striking out eight batters. The 24-year-old also brought home Midwest League Pitcher of the Month for April earlier this season, and currently holds the third-lowest ERA in the Midwest League at 3.44.

GUARDIAN ANGEL: 'Caps pitcher Angel Reyes now leads the franchise in appearances with 131 over the course of four years with the team.

Rated the #15 prospect in the Detroit Tigers farm system, Smith returns to West Michigan after rehabbing down in the FCL during the month of July. Smith takes the mound with the Whitecaps as the first Whitecaps player from the University of Alabama since Tigers pitcher Spencer Turnbull, who threw a no-hitter in May of 2021, threw in West Michigan during the 2015 Midwest League championship season. .

LAST START: Smith looked healthy during his final appearance with the FCL Tigers, tossing two scoreless innings with a strikeout in a 5-4 win over the FCL Blue Jays.

2023: Smith began his season with the Erie Seawolves and struggled - allowing nine runs through 5.2 innings before being placed on the injured list. Before his promotion to West Michigan on August 6th, Smith made two rehab appearances down in the FCL, where he tossed five scoreless innings with three strikeouts.

2022: Smith began his season with the Low-A Flying Tigers before finishing the year in West Michigan, where he posted an 8-6 record with an even 4.00 ERA and a 86-to-21 strikeout to walk ratio in 19 starts.

2021: Went 2-8 with a 3.84 ERA in 16 starts in a breakout season at the University of Alabama. Struck out 113 batters in 98.1 innings on the mound.

MORE: An outstanding athlete, Smith played basketball, soccer, ran track, and was good enough to warrant Division 1-football scholarships before deciding to play baseball at the University of Alabama.

Throws: 4-seam sinker, slider, curveball, changeup

Projected to have plus-command in the future by FanGraphs.

Once drafted by the San Diego Padres in the 18th Round of the 2018 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Was ranked as the #58 overall 2021 MLB Draft prospect by Prospects Live.
