SOUNDS SWEEP SHRIMP IN DOUBLEHEADER

The Jumbo Shrimp were swept 4-3 and 5-4 on Saturday in a doubleheader by the Sounds. In the opener, Jacksonville led 2-0 after their first at-bats and 3-1 in the fourth following **Andrew Pinter**'s solo home run. However, a Nashville run in the bottom of the fourth cut it to 3-2. **Luis Matos** then lined a walk-off two-run double in the seventh to win it for the Sounds. In the finale, Nashville led 5-0 until **Deyvison De Los Santos** launched a three-run bomb in the sixth. **Kemp Alderman** collected an RBI single in the seventh, but Jacksonville stranded two to come up short at 5-4.

ACE UP THE SLEEVE

Jacksonville starting pitching has been nothing short of dominant of late. Over the club's last 18 games, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have combined to yield only 26 runs, 23 earned, on 65 hits (6.7 H/9) in 87.0 innings, recording an extraordinary 2.38 ERA. During this run, Jacksonville starters have combined for 110 strikeouts (11.4 K/9) against just 25 walks (2.6 BB/9). Not coincidentally, this starting pitching success has helped the Jumbo Shrimp go 13-5 over this stretch. On the season, Jacksonville starters lead Triple-A with a 3.85 ERA. Their 395.0 innings pitched trail only Tacoma for the most of any staff at the level.

THE SOUNDS OF MUSIC

Jacksonville and Nashville split their first series of the season, continuing a theme between the two clubs. Since Jacksonville rejoined Triple-A in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp have played 91 games against the Sounds, with Jacksonville going 45-46 (.495) against Nashville. The Sounds have outscored the Jumbo Shrimp by a miniscule 435-422 (+13) margin over these 91 contests. Each of the last four games in the clubs' current series has been decided by one run.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville has racked up an impressive 24-17 (.585) record on the road this season - the 24 away victories rank in a tie for fourth in all of Triple-A. The biggest difference for the Jumbo Shrimp in their away contests has been their offense. At VyStar Ballpark, the club is hitting just .219/.330/.360/.690 with 190 runs scored (4.3 per game). Jacksonville is batting .261/.337/.423/.760 with 241 runs scored (5.9 per game) on the road.

ONE DIRECTION

Prior to Saturday's doubleheader, Jacksonville had won 11 of their last 14 one-run games, including each of their previous five such decisions. However, the Sounds swept a pair of one-run games during that twin bill. Nonetheless, the Jumbo Shrimp are now 16-9 (.640) in one-run games, the second-most such victories in Triple-A. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp earned 29 one-run victories, tied for the most one-run victories in MiLB. The 29 one-run triumphs were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs.

WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT

Jacksonville has won 12 of their last 16 games dating back to June 17, mainly behind a dominant pitching staff. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp hold massive leads Triple-A in ERA (3.14; next-closest: Sugar Land, 3.74), runs allowed (56; next-closest: Durham and Louisville, 66), hits allowed (103; next-closest: Durham, 105) and BAA (.205; next-closest: Durham, .216), while ranking tied for fourth in strikeouts (149). Jacksonville's 89 runs scored over the last 16 games ranks 14th in Triple-A.

ETZEL DAY? WELL, I LIKE ETZEL DAY

Matthew Etzel got off to a very slow start to the season, hitting just .183/.256/.254/.510 over his first 20 games of the season. Over the last 46 contests, however, the Texas native is a scorching 50-for-172 at the plate, slashing a robust .291/.396/.500/.896 with eight doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 28 RBIs, 29 walks and 40 runs scored. Since this stretch began on May 3, Etzel ranks third in the IL in runs, 14th in OBP, tied for 16th in walks, 17th in OPs and tied for 19th in hits.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has gone four games in a row without committing an error, matching their longest such streak of the season... Saturday represented the Jumbo Shrimp's first traditional doubleheader of the season. The club was swept in a twin bill for the first time since falling 3-2 and 14-9 to Charlotte on June 6, 2024. Jacksonville broomed five doubleheaders in 2025... The Jumbo Shrimp have lost only one series since April 28. They have 5-1-3 in sets since that point.

ABOUT DAX

-In 2019, Fulton underwent Tommy John Surgery, which caused him to miss his senior year at Mustang High School (Okla.). The Marlins picked him in the second round, 40th overall, and signed him away from his commitment to the University of Oklahoma for \$2.4 million - a record for a prep pitcher who missed his entire senior season with injury.

-Fulton has undergone two Tommy John Surgeries, the latter of which caused him to miss the entirety of the 2024 season.

-Had he gone to the University of Oklahoma, Fulton has said he was planning to major in pre-law.

-In his spare time, Fulton enjoys playing the guitar. While with Double-A Pensacola, he roomed with right-handed pitcher Evan Fitterer, who also plays the guitar.

2026 SEASON

-Fulton made his major league debut on May 6 for the Miami Marlins in a game against the Baltimore Orioles at loadDepot park. Fulton filled a long-relief role for Miami, working 4.0 innings of relief. He yielded two runs on three hits with three strikeouts against a pair of walks in the Marlins' 7-4 loss to the Orioles.

2025 SEASON

-Fulton was promoted to Jacksonville from Double-A Pensacola on August 26. At the time of his promotion, Fulton was 12th in the Southern League in strikeouts (96) and tied for 16th in games started (18).
