RIDERS TAKE DOWN CARDINALS ON FRIDAY NIGHT:

The Frisco RoughRiders turned a 4-0 deficit into an 8-4 lead in two innings, defeating the Springfield Cardinals 8-5 at Riders Field on Friday. The Cardinals (34-33) put three runs on the board in the third inning to take a 4-0 lead. At that point, Frisco (29-37) had been outscored 15-0 in the third inning this series, but Frisco broke through in the bottom of the third. Bringing nine batters to the plate, the RoughRiders totaled four runs with three walks and three singles. Frisco then repeated that feat in the fourth inning with four more runs, including a double from **Liam Hicks** and **Jax Biggers'** first triple of the season. Frisco also recorded three sacrifice flies between the third and fourth innings. **Grant Wolfram** (3-0) logged 2.2 relief innings for Frisco without a run, giving up just one hit while striking out four. Noah Trogllic-Iverson (1-2) was pegged for three earned runs in 0.2 innings to take the loss. **Michael Brewer** earned the save for the RoughRiders, taking care of two innings without a hit or run. Brewer followed **Aidan Anderson**, who logged two innings with one hit and one run allowed. In total, the Frisco bullpen covered 7.2 innings with just one run allowed. Eight different batters logged a base hit on Friday for Frisco, plus seven walks. **Evan Carter** led the way with two RBIs, including the first of the game for Frisco on his third-inning single. He tacked on a sacrifice fly the next inning. **Trevor Hauver** reached base in three straight innings, walking twice with a single. He led off both of Frisco's back-to-back four-run innings with a walk.

CONSISTENCY NEEDED:

With **Juan Mejia** slated to start today for the RoughRiders, he becomes the 10th different starting pitcher in June for Frisco, which is the most in the league this month. Over their last 10 games, the Riders starting staff has just one game of at least five innings with a 9.62 ERA. In June, Frisco has a starters ERA of 7.40 over 20 games. The good news is the bullpen has been very strong in June, owning a 3.49 ERA and a 2.47 ERA over the last 10 games.

RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just eighth in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .253, though Frisco is fourth with 259 RBIs with RISP. Over the last nine games (3-6 record), Frisco is hitting just .244 (21-for-86) in those situations.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over a 12-game hitting streak, Saggese is hitting .429 (21-for-49)/.491/.755/1.246 with two doubles, four home runs, 14 RBIs, six walks, nine runs scored and a steal. Among those who have played at least 50 games, Saggese is first on the team with a .303 batting average and .842 OPS.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

Reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.68 over 22 appearances. In 26.2 innings, he has struck out 45 to 12 walks. Opponents are hitting just .140 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 13 outings. During that span, he has struck out 30 to five walks over 16.1 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .121 (8-for-66) against him on the season with a .374 OPS.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday, which is second in the league. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .444 (20-for-45) on the initial offering while his 20 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 30 and is on pace for a career-best 62 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 97 bases in 113 attempts (86 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)).

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .300 (75-for-250)/.363/.444/.807 through the first 58 games. Over his last 54 games, he is batting .310/.377/.466/.843. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (114).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 329 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .352 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is still first in the league with 44 walks despite being promoted to Triple-A Round Rock on Tuesday.
