Today: It's the fourth game of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the A's, and the host West Michigan Whitecaps, the High-A affiliate of the Tigers. This is the 459th all-time meeting, coming in the Nuts' 3801st all-time game, so 12% of all of the regular season games the Lugnuts have ever played have come against West Michigan. The Nuts are 4-5 vs. West Michigan this season, 15 more meetings remain to be played.

Yesterday: Whitecaps 5, Lugnuts 4. Max Clark supplied two-out RBI singles in the second and seventh innings, then laced a two-out, two-run game-tying triple in the bottom of the ninth and was balked home by Hunter Breault, as the Whitecaps ended the Lugnuts' six-game road winnings streak in front of 8,777.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday, enjoy an off day on July 29, and then welcome in the Dayton Dragons for a six-game series running from July 30 - August 4. Only three more homestands remain in the Nuts' 28th season.

Brisk Baseball: Game times for the Lugnuts/Whitecaps' nine matchups this year: 2:19 (yesterday), 2:24, 2:23, 2:49, 2:02, 1:44, 2:26, 2:53, 2:31.

Season Series: The Nuts are hitting just .221 in nine games vs. West Michigan, though there have been several standouts. Catcher Cole Conn is slashing .375/.450/.688. hitting 6-for-16 with two doubles, one homer, three walks and five runs scored through five games. Second baseman Casey Yamauchi is slashing .348/.464/.348, hitting 8-for-23 with three walks and six runs scored in eight games. And corner outfielder Jonny Butler is slashing .278/.395/.472 with one double, triples and seven walks, leading to seven runs scored in nine games.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in triples and ranks 2nd in runs, hits and total bases, and 3rd in batting average, doubles, on-base percentage, slugging percentage and OPS.

All-Star Alumni: The Lugnuts were represented in the MLB All-Star Game by 2017 Nuts alum Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went hitless, and 2022 Lansing standout Mason Miller, who tossed a perfect frame for the A.L., striking out Shohei Ohtani and Trea Turner and hitting 103.6 mph, the fastest pitch in All-Star Game history. Miller unfortunately landed on the Injured List today with a fractured left pinkie finger.

Prospecting: The Nuts have four Top 30 A's prospects on their roster: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Ryan Lasko (No. 15), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 24), and pitcher Will Johnston (No. 27), as ranked by MLB Pipeline.

The Future is Here: 21-year-old Luis Morales, the youngest player on the Lugnuts, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Perez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the Prospect Showcase, and the fifth all-time Lugnut to participate in the game. TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Facing the Clinton LumberKings on Summer Fun Day, Brad Glenn became the fifth Lugnut in team history, and the first since Travis Snider in 2007, to hit for the cycle, leading the way in a 9-5 victory. The Oklahoman singled in the 1st, homered in the 3rd, doubled (sun-aided) in the 5th, and snapped a 4-4 tie with a two-run triple in the 7th inning.

2022: Tyler Soderstrom homered twice and drove in four runs, and Jake Walkinshaw struck out seven Great Lakes Loons in five scoreless innings in a 6-0 win at Dow Diamond.

In a Nutshell: Pitched in 2023 with the Nuts, returning to the Midwest League this season... spent the offseason training in Alabama with Tyler Baum... opened the season in a tandem with Opening Day starter James González... González was promoted on May 8, so Myers made the next four starts without a piggybacker... has since pitched in tandems with Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang, Grant Judkins and Wander Guante... notable splits:

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.


Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/ curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds.
