TODAY'S GAMES: Having dropped two games in a row for just the second time this year, the Space Cowboys look to get back in the win column tonight with RHP Blair Henley on the mound against the Chihuahua's RHP Randy Vasquez.

ABOUT WEDNESDAY NIGHT: The Space Cowboys struck first in the top of the second after a Corey Julks sac-fly... An RBI groundout from Jesús Bastidas and double from Shay Whitcomb added a couple more runs for the Space Cowboys and Luke Berryhill had an RBI single to give Sugar Land four runs... RHP Ryan Gusto gave up a three-run home run and Rhett Kouba gave up a two-run home run and an RBI double that put the game out of reach for Sugar Land as they dropped the contest 6-4.

ROSTER MOVES: 5/2 - Quincy Hamilton promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus Christi... 5/1 - INF Jacob Amaya recalled by Houston... INF/OF Trey Cabbage recalled by Houston... 4/30 - INF/OF Joey Loperfido contract selected by Houston and recalled... LHP Colton Gordon activated from the IL... RHP Joel Kuhnel designated for assignment... OF Zach Daniels activated from the IL and transferred to Corpus... 4/29 - OF Trey Cabbage returned to Sugar Land...RHP Deury Carrasco transferred to Asheville... 4/27 - INF/OF Trey Cabbage recalled by Houston... RHP Luis Contreras reinstated from the IL... 4/26 - RHP JP France optioned to Sugar Land... RHP Forrest Whitley placed on the 7-Day IL

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 12 players that were drafted by the Astros, six free agent signings, four players acquired in trades, three international free agents, two waiver claim, one MiLB Rule 5 Draft pick and two undrafted free agent.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys roster sports five of the Astros' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline, including: RHP AJ Blubaugh (#8), LHP Colton Gordon (#10), RHP Rhett Kouba (#14), INF Will Wagner (#15) and OF Pedro León (#27).

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: With a win on Saturday night, the Space Cowboys collected their fourth-straight series win... They are currently 4-1-0 overall in series this season.

BOMBS AWAY: Sugar Land is second in the Pacific Coast League in home runs with 41 and fourth in Minor League Baseball in long balls... The Space Cowboys have homered in 19 of 29 games so far in 2024 and have launched at least two home runs in 13 of their 29 contests.

HAIL CESAR!: Catcher César Salazar has reached base safely in 20 of 21 games he has played in this season... The left-handed hitter is slashing .311/.409/.432/.841 with four doubles, a triple, a home run, 14 RBI, 15 runs scored and nine walks to just 15 strikeouts.

TWIN KILLINGS: Entering Thursday, Sugar Land has turned 35 double plays, the most in MiLB... The Space Cowboys recently turned at least one double play in seven straight games, totaling 15 in that span, ending on 4/30.

The offense batted .279/.393/.475/.868 (242-for-868) with 54 doubles, three triples, 34 home runs and 154 walks.

WE MEASURED IT WITH LASERS: Pedro León owns the longest home run hit this season, as he cranked a 479-foot homer in the 4th inning on Saturday night, the longest home run measured by Statcast in MLB or MiLB this year.

JESUS GOT US: INF Jesus Bastidas has been one of the Space Cowboys most dangerous hitter this year... He is tied for fourth in Minor League Baseball in doubles, tied for fifth in XBH (17) and tied for sixth in RBI ...With runners in scoring position, Bastidas is hitting .500 (16-for-32) with five doubles, six HR and 26 RBI.

WE LITERALLY LOVE HOME PLATE: Sugar Land leads all of Minor League Baseball in runs scored in 2024, plating 211 runs in 29 games, averaging 7.3 runs per game.

HEY, I'M WALKIN'!: In the seventh inning on 4/26, the Space Cowboys drew seven walks in a singular frame, their most this season, helping to propel them in a seven-run inning to take the lead against Reno.

Also, on 4/9 at Albuquerque, the Space Cowboys drew 14 walks, a single-game franchise record... The Space Cowboys have worked 172 walks in 2024, the most in Baseball (Major or Minor League).

WWWWWWINS FOR DAYS: Sugar Land is currently tied with the Sacramento River Cats for the Minor League Baseball lead in wins, picking up 19 victories in their first 29 games.

HITS FROM HAVANA: Pedro León is rolling, as he has hit safely in 22 of 25 games this season... He is batting .311 (32-for-103) with nine doubles, a triple, four home runs, 28 RBI and 22 runs scored... León is tied for fourth in RBI, tied for seventh in doubles and tied for eighth in hits in the PCL.

ON-BASE KINGS: The Space Cowboys currently have four players with active on-base streaks above 10 games, including Shay Whitcomb (17G), David Hensley (17G), Corey Julks (16G) and Luke Berryhill (13G)... Additionally, Pedro León and Will Wagner each have a nine game on-base streak.

OVER THE HUMP: Coming into Thursday, Will Wagner and David Hensley need one more game with a hit to pass Shay Whitcomb and Pedro León's previous nine game hitting streak record for the Space Cowboys this season... Along with Wagner and Hensley's active ninegame hit streak, the other active hit streaks for Sugar Land include Luke Berryhill (8G) and León again (7G).

SPACE COWBOYS IN THE SHOW: So far this season, the Space Cowboys have had seven players called up to the Houston Astros, including five players that had their contracts selected (Joey Loperfido, Blair Henley, Wander Suero, Spencer Arrighetti and Joel Kuhnel)... There have also been four players that have made their Major League debut, with RHP Blair Henley debuting on April 8 @ TEX, RHP Spencer Arrighetti debuting on April 10 @ Kansas City, RHP Forrest Whitley making his Major League debut on April 16 vs. Atlanta, and Joey Loperfido debuting in left field on April 30 vs. Cleveland.

FAREWELL JOEY!: OF/1B Joey Loperfido has been promoted to the Houston Astros after a red-hot start to the Triple-A season... In 25 games for the Space Cowboys, he led all of professional baseball in home runs (13), along with leading the MiLB in runs scored (31) and total bases (72), tied for third in extra-base hits (17) & tied for sixth in RBI (27).

At the time of his promotion, Loperfido was first in the PCL in home runs, slugging and total bases, second in OPS, tied for second in extra-base hits and tied for fourth in RBI.

ONE-HIT WONDER: Sugar Land one-hit the Aviators on April 5, hurling their first shutout of 2024 in just their seventh game of the year... It took Sugar Land until September 5, 2023 to throw their first shutout last season (Game 133)... It was the fourth one-hitter thrown in Space Cowboys history.

WALK THIS WAY: On 4/2 vs. Las Vegas, the Space Cowboys drew 13 walks, which tied the franchise record for most walks in a single game at the time... The other time Sugar Land earned 13 free passes was in Game 2 of a doubleheader on August 19, 2022... The Space Cowboys scored 17 runs in the sixth inning of that game and would end up winning 21-4 in seventh innings... Sugar Land would break the walks record one week later on 4/9 @ Albuquerque, drawing 14 walks.

HISTORY FOR BLANCO: Former Space Cowboys reliever and starter RHP Ronel Blanco (2021-23) authored the 17th no-hitter in Astros' franchise history on April 1 at Minute Maid Park, walking just two batters... The no-hitter came in Blanco's 8th career start in the Majors... Blanco becomes the first Space Cowboys hurler to make his debut and then throw a no-hitter in the Major Leagues... LHP Framber Valdez appeared in two games with Sugar Land in 2021 before throwing his no-hitter on August 1, 2023.

RIDE THE BIKE!: On June 24, 2023, OF Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

UN DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will once again rebrand on multiple occasions in 2024 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: All 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard once again be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV, MLB.TV, the MiLB App and on Bally Live. Garrett Greene returns for his second season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his fourth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fifth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his fourth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with three seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Thomas Whitsett, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Whitsett enters his first season as the Space Cowboys pitching coach, replacing Erick Abreu, who joined the Atlanta Braves in 2024 as their bullpen coach. Whitsett was the Astros' Assistant Pitching Coordinator in 2023 and served as the Pitching Coach for Double-A Corpus Christi in 2022. He also worked as a pitching coach for Single-A Fayetteville in 2019 before spending a year out of the Astros organization as the director of player development for pitching at the University of Arizona in 2021. Westlake returns for his second season as Sugar Land's hitting coach and previously was the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi in 2022 and a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his third season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.
