THURSDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats had their four-game win streak come to end on Thursday night, losing to the Reading Fightin' Phils 13-7 at Delta Dental Stadium. New Hampshire gave up eight runs combined in the seventh and eighth innings to give Reading its first win of the series. After launching a team-record 11 home runs in the month of May, **Orelvis Martinez** hit his first homer of June and his 15th of the season with a solo homer in the seventh. It was one of Martinez's three hits on the night and his first three-hit game this year. **Rainer Nunez** collected a pair of hits and two RBIs with a two-run single in the fifth. The Blue Jays No. 26 prospect has five RBIs in his first two Double-A games. In his first game back since Saturday at Portland, **Sebastian Espino** hit a three-run home run in the second inning, his second homer of the season. On the mound, **Chad Dallas** got the start and threw 4.1 innings, allowing two hits, five runs and six walks while striking out two in a no-decision. Right-handed reliever **Gabriel Ponce** took the loss after allowing three runs and four hits in 2.1 innings of work.

HOME RUN HITTERS: In the last five games, New Hampshire has scored 43 total runs and hit 12 home runs. The Fisher Cats are currently third in the Eastern League in home runs with 54 behind Somerset (61) and Erie (56) and are just one home run ahead of Reading (53). In eight games played in the season series, New Hampshire has hit 22 home runs against Reading pitching.

OUTTA HERE ORELVIS: Orelvis Martinez wrapped up an incredible month of May at the plate for the Fisher Cats. The Blue Jays top position player prospect set a team-record hitting 11 home runs in the month. His 11 homers tied Hartford's Hunter Goodman for the month – both were one homer behind Moises Gomez of Triple-A Memphis, who led all minor leaguers with 12. Yesterday, Martinez hit his first home run of the month of June and his second of the series. He is hitting .342 (12-for-32) with two doubles, seven homers and 13 RBI vs. the Fightin Phils this year. He did not homer in 14 games against Reading in 2022.

IMPRESS ME PLEASE: Riley Tirotta and **Rainer Nunez** have made instant impressions in their first home games at Delta Dental Stadium. In their home debuts at Delta Dental Stadium, both hit their first Double-A home runs. Tirotta hit his on Tuesday and Nunez hit his on Wednesday. In six games so far with New Hampshire, Tirotta is hitting .300 (6-for-20) with a double, triple, homer and six RBIs. In two games so far, Nunez has five RBIs and a homer.

WELCOME TO NEW HAMPSHIRE: Earlier this week, right-handed pitcher **TJ Brock** and infielder **Rainer Nunez** were both received from High-A Vancouver. Brock, a 6th round pick by the Blue Jays out of Ohio State in the 2022 Draft, posted a 1.77 ERA in 20.1 innings to start the season with 31 strikeouts over just nine walks. Nunez, a 2017 international free agent signing and the Blue Jays No. 26 prospect, has hit .309 with three homers and 26 RBIs with a .836 OPS. This is both Brock and Nunez's first stints at Double-A.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (June 2, 2010) – In the 15-5 win at Reading, the Fisher Cats hit a franchise-record six home runs, two each by Danny Perales and Adam Loewen, and one each for Eric Thames and David Cooper. Perales and Loewen each homered in the first and Thames hit a grand slam in the second inning for a 7-0 lead. Zach Stewart was the beneficiary of the offense, allowing one run one hit in his six innings.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (30-27) beat Milwaukee yesterday afternoon 3-1 to seal a series win. Kevin Gausman struck out 11 and **Bo Bichette** homered in the victory. The Blue Jays visit the Mets this weekend for a three-game series...Triple-A Buffalo (24-30) lost for a third straight day to St. Paul 11-5. The Bisons jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the fourth but gave up five runs in two innings each...High-A Vancouver (26-21) shut out Eugene 8-0. Alex De Jesus and Garrett Spain both recorded three-hit games and Trenton Wallace pitched six shutout innings ...Class A Dunedin (24-24) lost a third straight to Clearwater 4-1.
