### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express look to snap a season-long five-game losing streak in tonight's game five against the Oklahoma City Dodgers. Round Rock LHP Brock Burke is scheduled to face Oklahoma City RHP Yefry Ramírez on the mound. First pitch at Dell Diamond is slated for 7:05 p.m.

### ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The Oklahoma City Dodgers used a five-run eighth inning to collect a 7-2 victory over the Round Rock Express on Sunday night at Dell Diamond. Round Rock started the scoring in the bottom of the first as CF Leody Taveras hit a solo home run. However, OKC 1B Yoshi Tsutsugo responded with a solo homer of his own in the second to tie the game. An ensuing Luke Raley homer in the fourth gave the Dodgers a brief 2-1 lead before Express 2B Andy Ibáñez smoked a solo homer to level the game at 2-2 in the sixth. Oklahoma City's big eighth inning began with consecutive walks by CF DJ Peters and C Keibert Ruiz. After a Raley double scored the go-ahead run, Ruiz scored on a wild pitch to make it 4-2. The inning continued as 2B Sheldon Neuse sent Raley home with a sacrifice fly prior to a solo homer by Tsutsugo. OKC LF Drew Avans added one more run, scoring on an Omar Estévez RBI knock after singling and stealing second base, extending the final score to 7-2.

### RIGHTING THE SHIP

Round Rock LHP Brock Burke looks to get back on track with his seventh start of the season tonight. In his previous outings, the lefty is 0-3 with a 10.45 ERA (24 ER/20.2 IP). Burke allowed five runs on five hits and three walks in 1.1 innings on May 10 during his only start against OKC this season.

### LEODY'S FIRST DELL DINGER

Express OF Leody Taveras blasted his seventh home run of the season in the first inning last night. Strangely enough, the solo shot marked his first career longball at Dell Diamond. As a team, Round Rock has hit 30 home runs in 22 games at home and 28 homers across 18 road contests.

### A FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

Last night's defeat gave Oklahoma City a 4-0 lead in the six-game series, marking the first time in four tries that Round Rock has dropped a series at home. The Express topped the Dodgers 5-1 to begin the season before collecting a 4-2 series victory over the Sugar Land Skeeters from May 13-18 and splitting their six-game set with the El Paso Chihuahuas from June 3-8.

### WORKING THE COUNT

E-Train hitters combined to draw only one walk in Sunday's defeat, just one night after the team didn't collect a single free pass in a 4-2 defeat. Saturday's contest marked the first time all season that Round Rock hitters failed to draw a walk in a game.

### ANOTHER DAY, ANOTHER DEBUT

Round Rock LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang made his Minor League Baseball debut with a start in Sunday night's contest. The veteran lefty pitched for the Kia Tigers in the Korean Baseball Organization for 14 seasons before joining the Texas Rangers this year. Yang was assigned to the Express on June 19 and became the 19th member of the team to make his Triple-A debut last night.

### IBÁÑEZ GETS THE CALL

The Texas Rangers announced on Monday afternoon that Round Rock Express INF Andy Ibáñez has been recalled. Ibáñez has been Round Rock's hottest hitter as of late, posting a season-high nine-game hitting streak prior to the promotion. During the hot stretch, Ibáñez is batting .529 (18-34) with five doubles, a triple, four home runs and 13 RBI. The Cuban native made his Major League Debut earlier this season during a stint with the Rangers from May 4-18.

## ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Eighteen members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. RHP Tyler Phillips is currently seeking his Triple-A debut with the Express. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

## STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 15 different states: Alabama, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

## AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 27 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, OF Elier Hernandez, RHP Dennis Santana and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is from South Korea, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

## EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
