**About the Last One:** In a game that the Bowie Baysox had to win on Sunday to keep their season alive, the home team did just that, rallying in dramatic fashion to beat the Altoona Curve 7-5 and clinch a spot in the Double-A Northeast League Championship Series on the final day of the regular season. **Zach Watson** put Bowie in front early with a two-run home run, and **Patrick Dorrian** added a solo homer in the third. Altoona plated five in the fourth to take a 5-3 lead. **Andrew Daschbach** brought Bowie within a run in the sixth on a solo shot, before Bowie stormed ahead in the eighth. The Baysox made use of aggressive baserunning to score three runs and put themselves in position to win. **Diogenes Almengo** faced the miminum in the top of the ninth with two strikeouts to earn his team-leading 16th save.

**Title Time:** For the third time in franchise history, and for the second consecutive season, the Bowie Baysox will play in the Championship Series. Bowie won their first Eastern League title in 2015, defeating Reading in five games. In 2019, the last minor league season that was played, Bowie fell to the Trenton Thunder, then the Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees.

**Gray's Day:** Getting the start for Bowie in game one on Tuesday night will be right-hander **Gray Fenter**. He has spent his entire 2021 season with Bowie, and this will be his 14th start and 22nd appearance. In his starts, Fenter is 3-3 with a 3.66 ERA. He was selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the seventh round of the 2015 draft (223rd overall) out of West Memphis High School in Arkansas. This will be his third start against Akron this season. In his first, he threw five scoreless innings and allowed just one hit, with two walks and three strikeouts. In his second, he threw 3.2 innings and allowed three runs on six hits with two walks and six strikeouts. For more information on Fenter, see page two.

In the Other Corner: The RubberDucks will go with righty Peyton Battenfield to start the series on Tuesday. Battenfield has played at with three different teams in 2021, making seven appearances each with High-A Bowling Green and Double-A Montgomery in the Tampa Bay Rays organization, and seven with Akron. Battenfield was traded at the deadline to the Indians organization in exchange for Jordan Luplow and DJ Johnson. In Montgomery, he had a 3-0 record with a 2.72 ERA. With Akron, he holds a 2-1 record and a 3.28 ERA in those seven appearances, all starts. Opponents in the Double-A Northeast League are hitting 1.83 against him, and he has a 0.87 WHIP.
