**TODAY'S GAME:** Welcome to LoanMart Field! The Quakes open a six-game series as they host the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in game one of a six-game series. Tonight is Healthy RC Recycle Tuesday, as fans can log on to the website and learn how to score a FREE Club Seat Ticket for the game. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE STORM:** Today's game is the fourth of 24 head-to-head games, with 15 of those taking place here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 3-0 against the Storm this year, sweeping the three-game set, the opening home stand of the 2025 season. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 here at home.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes won their fifth straight game overall, taking five of six in the series over the Inland Empire 66ers with Sunday's 4-2 come-from-behind win at San Manuel Stadium. Down to their last strike and trailing 2-1, the Quakes rallied and scored three times to take the lead for good on Andre Sanchez (0-6). Victor Rodrigues reached with a two-out, two-strike single, setting the stage for both Eduardo Guerrero and Jaron Elkins to shine. Guerrero doubled home the tying run before Elkins singled home Rodrigues with the go-ahead run. The Quakes added another courtesy of a Sadiel Baro wild pitch, giving them a 4-2 lead. That was enough for Connor Godwin (1-2), who earned his first career-win by retiring all six batters he faced over two perfect innings.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Quakes added C Angel Diaz from the ACL today. On Sunday, they placed C Gio Cueto on the Injured List, while RHP Jholbran Herder was activated from the Injured List. LHP Felix Cabrera was placed on the Injured List, retroactive to Friday, June 13th.

**FIRST HALF SOUTH DIVISION CHAMPS:** After stumbling a bit over a two-week stretch with an eight-game losing streak while both Visalia and Lake Elsinore were in the middle of seven-game win streaks, respectively, the Quakes put all doubt behind them by wrapping up the First Half South Division with last Friday's win over the 66ers. The Quakes will now return to the playoffs for the first time since 2023, when they made it to the Championship Series, where they were swept by Modesto. The Quakes will have qualified for the playoffs in nine of the 14 seasons (2011, 2013, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2023 and 2025) of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. Rancho has won three Championships in franchise history (1994, 2015 and 2018) with the last two coming as a Dodgers' affiliate. This will mark the second time in five seasons they'll make it to the playoffs under Manager John Shoemaker.

**SERIES WINS:** Saturday's win gave the Quakes their first series-win since they took five of six over Inland Empire in mid-May back at LoanMart Field. That stops a streak of three straight series without a series win, as they dropped two series (at Stockton and vs San Jose) and split another (at Modesto). Rancho's series record is now 7-3-1 on the year.

**LOGAN TABELING:** 23-year-old right-hander Logan Tabeling makes his 14th overall appearance this year and fifth start, his second outing and first start against the Storm. In his lone appearance against Lake Elsinore, he retired both batters he faced in his pro debut, a no-decision on April 5th. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on six hits over a career-high five innings in a win at Inland Empire on June 11th. The undrafted free agent out of Illinois signed with the Dodgers in July of 2024.

**KANNON KEMP:** 20-year-old righty Kannon Kemp makes his second appearance and first start for the Storm, his first appearance against the Quakes. Kemp's only appearance for the Storm was on June 11th, when he allowed three runs (two earned) on four hits over five innings of relief in his debut, a no-decision against Visalia. Kemp was drafted by San Diego in the eighth round of the 2023 out of Weatherford High School in Weatherford, Texas, but didn't make his pro-debut until May 3rd of 2025 because of a right shoulder injury.
