GAME RECAP:

The Reading Fightin Phils smoked the Harrisburg Senators for a 13-2 victory for their fourth consecutive win. The R-Phils put up a nine-run ninth inning, their largest run scoring inning, and game, of the season. The team hit four home runs including back-to-back long balls by Aldrem Corredor and Madison Stokes in the fourth and two three-run blasts thanks to Wendell Rijo and McCarthy Tatum in the ninth. Tatum and Vito Friscia both had two-hit innings in the final frame. Everyone in the starting nine reached successfully. Noah Skirrow notched his fifth win of the season going five strong.

SECOND HALF SUCCESS:

The Fightins have come on strong in the second half. They have hit .500 ball with 17 wins and 17 losses after June 26. This puts them in third place. Portland leads the way, three games out in front, and Hartford is in second. Somerset won the first half for the NorthEast Division of the Eastern League.

SEASON HIGHS:

The R-Phils broke a lot of season-highs with yesterday night's win. With a 13 run game they topped their highest count of 12 runs, done three times this summer. With a nine run frame they eclipsed their high of seven runs in the 8th inning at Somerset on 5/19. The team hit four homers last night, topping their previous record of three done last on 7/13 at New Hampshire. The starting nine had eight extra base hits last night, more than the seven they had on 8/3 vs Hartford. This was the first time that everyone in the lineup got on base successfully since May 28. It was the first time since May 17, 2017 at Erie (14-4) that the Fightins beat a team by 10+ runs. Two players had two hits in the ninth inning (Friscia & Tatum), which was the first time since a batter did that since Josh Stephen on 7/25/21 vs New Hampshire.

SNAG 'EM:

The Reading Fightin Phils picked up speed on the base paths lately. In Tuesday's win, the R-Phils notched another two stolen bases. The Fightins have nabbed four bases two times in a game. Once against Hartford on 8/6 in a 5-4 win and another came against Binghamton on May 28, a game in which Reading claimed an 11-2 victory. Rijo leads the team with 17 stolen bases, a career high, while Johan Rojas has 13. The Phillies' No. 3 prospect, Rojas swiped 46 bags so far in 2022 between in Reading and High-A Jersey Shore. The speedster has only been caught twice this season. Kevin Vicuna is in second place for the Fightins with eight bases taken this summer.

CATCHER'S CAUGHT:

Two of the top catchers for Triple-A Lehigh Valley are down for the count this week. Rafael Marchan was placed on the 7-Day Injured List yesterday, while Donny Sands was placed on the COVID-related Injured List. With Karl Ellison still listed on the roster, Philadelphia promoted Jack Conley to Triple-A. Vito Friscia will be the starting catcher in Reading. He will be backed up by Herbert Iser who got the call up from High-A Jersey Shore.

PROSPECT CENTRAL:

The Fightins roster boasts many top prospects in the Phillies farm system. Johan Rojas (#3), Griff McGarry (#7), Erik Miller (#9), Jhailyn Ortiz (#10) and McKinley Moore (#26).

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies topped the Miami Marlins 4-1 yesterday. Zack Wheeler garnered his eleventh win of the season going six strong. He allowed just one run and struck out eight. Seranthony Dominguez got the save. JT Realmuto and Jean Segura both launched homers. Alec Bohm recorded a hit to bring his season average up to .294.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

August 10, 2018: Pitcher McKenzie Mills is promoted to Reading at noon, then is traded to the Marlins for infielder Justin Bour less than three hours later. Mills had flown into Philadelphia from Clearwater only to have to board another plane so he could head to Jacksonville to join Miami's Double-A affiliate. That night, Cornelius Randolph hits a 3-run, pinch-hit homer in the bottom of the 9th to give Reading a 5-2 win over Binghamton.
