LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox held off a late ninth-inning rally by Altoona to defeat the Curve 5-4 at Prince George's Stadium on Sunday afternoon. In the bottom of the 7th, Dylan Beavers crushed a goahead three-run homer to give Bowie a 5-2 lead. Ahead by three entering the ninth, Altoona's Matt Fraizer and Aaron Shackelford both hit solo homers to pull the Curve within one. With the tying run in scoring position and the go-ahead run on first, left-hander Ryan Hennen (S, 1) came in and collected the final two outs to seal the 5-4 victory for the Baysox.

SIZING UP THE FLYING SQUIRRELS

The Flying Squirrels enter this week at a 7-8 record after splitting their last two series, including most recently against Harrisburg on the road. Richmond is hoping to make the postseason for a third year in a row after falling to eventual 2023 Eastern League champion Erie last year. Richmond's roster includes seven of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), LHP Reggie Crawford (No. 8), OF Grant McCray (No. 13), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 20), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 24)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Carson Ragsdale gets the ball in the series opener for Richmond. The 6-8 right-hander is in his first season at Double-A and makes his fourth start of the year. The 25-year-old is coming off a five-inning start at Harrisburg where he allowed just one run on one hit while striking out five in a no-decision. Originally drafted by the Phillies in the 4th round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida, Ragsdale was traded to the Giants on January 9, 2021 for RHP Sam Coonrod.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers is off to solid start in his second stint with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect extended his on-base streak to 12 consecutive games on Sunday afternoon with a pair of hits and a walk, including a go-ahead three-run homer in the seventh. Beavers currently owns the longest active on-base streak in the league. During this on-base streak, Beavers is hitting .378 with 17 hits in 45 at-bats and an on-base percentage of .453.

HEY JUD!

Last weekend was a memorable one for Jud Fabian at the plate. On Thursday, the Orioles No. 12 prospect recorded his first four-hit game at Double-A with a 4-for-4 performance. On Saturday, Fabian cranked his first walk off homer of his career with a grand slam to win the game for Bowie in the ninth. It's the outfielder's second career grand slam and his first at Double-A. The 2022 Orioles second-round pick owns an 11-game on-base streak, which is tied for second in the league.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF Frederick Bencosme has barreled up the ball since arriving the Double-A level to begin the season. The Orioles No. 27 prospect leads the Eastern League in batting average (.365), is second in hits (19) and is tied for second in total bases (32). The middle infielder has hits in 10 of his first 13 Double-A contests, including seven multi-hit contests. Bencosme has also already hit three homers on the season after hitting only two all of last year in High-A Aberdeen. Only 21 years old. Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) Samuel Basallo hit his first Double-A homer on Tuesday, April 16 with a line drive shot in the seventh to put Bowie ahead for good. The 19-year old is coming off a monster season in 2023 where he finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

BRINGING THE HEAT

The Baysox pitching staff has collected the second-most strikeouts so far in the league (157), just four behind league leading Akron. Bowie has also allowed the third-fewest walks at just 49 through the first 15 games. The bullpen has recorded the second-most strikeouts while pitching the fourth-most innings amongst Eastern League bullpens.

No. 10 Orioles prospect via MLB Pipeline

Enters season fully healthy for first time since '22 after rehabbing from TJ surgery in '23 Traded from TB to BAL on 8/1/22 in three-team deal that sent Trey Mancini to HOU Arsenal: Fastball (94-96), Curveball (75-79), Slider (Mid-High 80s), Changeup (86-89)

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of Mil.B's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet activation Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization'S Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fun damentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facteau first served in the Orioles' organization as a technology intern.
