YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels had their franchise-record eight-game win streak snapped with a 4-3 loss in Harrisburg. The Senators jumped ahead in the first inning with an RBI double by Jakson Reetz and a two-run single from Nick Banks. The Flying Squirrels broke onto the scoreboard in the third with an RBI single by David Villar. In the top of the sixth, Vince Fernandez hit an RBI single and Frankie Tostado tied the score, 3-3, with a sac fly. Harrisburg reclaimed the lead in the sixth with an RBI single by Osvaldo Duarte. After allowing three runs in the first, Gerson Garabito went scoreless over his final four innings in his second start of the year. Frank Rubio pitched a scoreless inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels continue the first road series of 2021, facing off against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, at FNB Field on City Island in the fifth of six games. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' lone trip to Pennsylvania's capital city this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from June 8-13.

GOING STREAKING: The Flying Squirrels won eight straight games prior to Friday's loss, a new franchise record for the longest winning streak. The team previously won seven consecutive games from April 27-May 3, 2010 and June 20-26, 2014. The Flying Squirrels' eight-game win streak was tied for the longest overall in the minors this year (Lynchburg).

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 8-2 record through the first ten games of the season is the best start in the franchise's history. The previous best start through ten games was a 6-3 record, which was set during the 2018 and 2019 seasons. The Flying Squirrels' best record in team history through ten games is 7-3, which was set during the 2018 season. The best start through 11 games was 8-3, also in 2018.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 8-2, the Flying Squirrels are tied for the second-best record in the minors with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Wichita, Lynchburg, Down East and Everett. Two Triple-A West teams, Reno and Sugar Land, are 7-1 to begin the season and are tied for the best record in the minors.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS sit in first place in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, a half-game ahead of Bowie. The Flying Squirrels finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including Jacob Heyward, Sean Hjelle, Ryan Howard, Peter Maris, Heliot Ramos, Frank Rubio and Raffi Vizcaino. Reliever Patrick Ruotolo did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder Vince Fernandez played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

THE SENATORS snapped a six-game losing streak with Friday's win, which was tied for the longest losing streak in the minors at the time. The Senators are batting .136 as a team, which is the worst team average of the 120 teams in the minors. The Harrisburg roster includes 10 players who appeared in a game for the team prior to this season. There are six of *Baseball America's* top-30 Nationals prospects on the Senators' roster, including LHP Tim Cate (8), INF Drew Mendoza (11), INF Jackson Cluff (12), C Jakson Reetz (25), OF Nick Banks (29) and RHP Sterling Sharpe (29). In 2019, the Senators went 76-63, finishing in second place in the Eastern League Western Division, before falling to the Bowie Baysox in the divisional round of the playoffs.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Tristan Beck makes his third start of the season. Last time out, he threw five innings and allowed two runs against Hartford on Sunday to pick up his first Double-A win. Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the fourth round in 2018, Beck was traded to the Giants along with RHP Dan Winkler for reliever Mark Melancon on July 31, 2019 at the trade deadline. That year, his first full professional season, he began the campaign with the High-A Florida Fire Frogs and went 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA through his first four starts before being placed on the injured list with an oblique injury in late-April. After a rehab assignment in the GCL, Beck returned to make four more starts before being traded. He made six total starts with High-A San Jose to close out 2019, and went 3-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) in his last three outings of the season. **For more on Beck, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Tim Cate makes his third start of the season. Last time out, he worked 4.0 innings at Somerset on Sunday and allowed five runs (four earned) in a no-decision. He allowed six runs (five earned) over 4.0 innings in his season debut on May 4 at Somerset in a loss for his Double-A debut. Cate split 2019 with Single-A Hagerstown and A-Adv. Potomac, combining to go 11-9 with a 3.07 ERA, earning him a selection as the Nationals' Minor League Pitcher of the Year. Cate spent 2020 at the Nationals' alternate site. He was drafted by the Washington Nationals in the second round (65th overall) in 2018 out of the University of Connecticut, where he was a teammate of Richmond reliever Patrick Ruotolo during his freshman season in 2016. Cate finished his college career as UConn's all-time leader in strikeouts. He entered the 2021 season rated by MLB.com and *Baseball America* as the Nationals' No. 8 prospect.

STRONG ARMS: Over the last six games since May 8, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff has combined for a 2.70 (14 ER/58.0 IP), which is the best in all of Double-A during that span. The Richmond pitchers also have the second-best BAA (.172) in Double-A in that stretch and the third-best WHIP (1.02).

RAMOS RAKING: Heliot Ramos is currently on a 17-game on-base streak dating back to the end of the 2019 season. He is currently ranked tied for fifth in the Double-A Northeast in extra-base hits (6), tied for eighth in total bases (21), tied for third in runs scored (9) and tied for second in stolen bases (3). On the season, he has picked up at least one hit in eight of his nine games.

POWER SURGE: David Villar has homered three times in the first ten games of the 2021 season, which is tied for fourth in the league. He hit 13 home runs in 2018 in short-season with Salem-Keizer and clubbed 13 home runs again in 2019 with A-Adv. San Jose. Villar is also ranked tied for fourth in the league in RBIs (9).

CLOSING IT OUT: Reliever Patrick Ruotolo leads the Double-A Northeast with three saves this season. He is also tied for first in games pitched (5). On Thursday, Ruotolo pitched the ninth inning to finish a combined no-hitter, the first nine-inning no-hitter in the history of the Flying Squirrels franchise.

WELCOME BACK, AUGGIE: José Alguacil returns to manage the Flying Squirrels after leading the team to a 72-68 record in 2015, the most recent season the team has posted a winning record. Alguacil is in his 15th overall season with the Giants organization and worked at the Alternate Training Site in 2020. He previously served as the first base coach and oversaw bunting instruction while assisting with infield defense and baserunning in San Francisco from 2017-2019 on Bruce Bochy's major league staff.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: Heliot Ramos (3), Tristan Beck (12) and Sean Hjelle (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

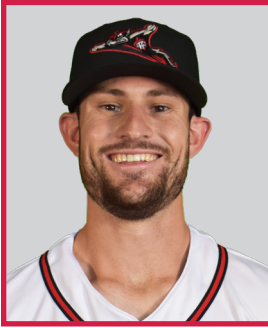
