- Behind seven innings of one-run ball from Jorge Bautista, the Blue Jays took the series opener from Palm Beach on Tuesday night 3-1.
- Palm Beach scored the game's first run on a Sammy Hernandez RBI single in the third inning.
- In the top of the fourth, Damiano Palmegiani lined a solo homer to left field that tied the game.
- In the fifth, Dunedin rallied with two outs to take the lead. After Nic Deschamps walked, Bryce Arnold picked up an RBI double. Jean Joseph pushed the lead to 3-1 with his own RBI double.
- Following an 1:27 rain delay, JJ Sanchez took over for Jorge Bautista in the eighth, stranding a man on second base by striking out two.
- Bo Bonds picked up his first save of the season, working around two hits in the bottom of the ninth.
- Three native Canadians scored the Blue Jays three runs: Palmegiani, Arnold, and Deschamps.

JUARON WHIFFS-BROWN

Tonight's starting pitcher, Juaron Watts-Brown has proved to be the best swing-and-miss starting pitcher in all of Single-A this season. Watts-Brown leads the level with 117 whiffs and a 39% whiff rate. Watts-Brown has pitched just four innings in three straight starts, but struck out eight or more in all three starts.

FEELING STREAKY

The Blue Jays have picked up wins and losses in bunches lately. Dunedin won six straight games from May 15-21, and then lost three straight. Following that three game losing streak, the Jays picked up five straight wins from May 25-30. Last night's win snapped a three-game losing streak.

JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays are tied for the Florida State League lead with 40 home runs. The team trails Modesto by three homers for the Single-A lead. Dunedin has homered in 17 of its last 21 games. Across that stretch, 11 different players have gone deep.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Dunedin has played 18 one-run games this season, splitting them at 9-9. The Jays have won six of their last eight one-run contests. 36 of the Blue Jays 52 games this season (69%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 19-18 record in those games.

RELYING ON RELIEF

Much of the Blue Jays' success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 3.08 ERA with a 1.23 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 6.02 ERA with a 1.77 WHIP. The bullpen allowed all 11 earned runs in the final two games of the series with the Mets.

STRONG SEVEN

With seven innings of one-run ball last night, Blue Jays starter Jorge Bautista became the first D-Jay this season to pitch seven full innings this season. Bautista did so on just 77 pitches. The outing marks the eighth time this season a Jays starter has pitched six innings or more. Dunedin is 4-4 in these games.

HOUSE OF HORRORS

The Blue Jays return to Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium this week, where they were swept by Jupiter April 23-28. In that series, Dunedin tallied a total of 10 runs and hit just one home run. The sweep marked the first time ever that Dunedin was swept in a six-game series.

REHAB CITY, USA

With Peyton Williams, Damiano Palmegiani and TJ Brock assigned to the D-Jays last week, Dunedin has hosted nine MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. MLB rehabbers Alek Manoah and Erik Swanson both pitched on April 7 against Lakeland.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY HOMERS

After going 10-12 in April, Dunedin played to a 15-12 record in May, thanks in part to a surge in power. The Blue Jays belted 27 home runs in May - the most in all of Single-A, and six more than the next-closest FSL team (Clearwater, 21). The month was highlighted by two lengthy win streaks - a six-gamer from 5/15 to 5/21, and a five-gamer stretch from 5/25 to 5/30. The streaks followed a slow start, as the Jays lost 7 of the first 10 games of the month.

ABOUT JUARON

- Selected by the Blue Jays in the 3rd round of the 2023 draft out of Oklahoma State... Did not make pro debut in 2023.
- Grew up in Hanford, CA; located west of Visalia and south of San Jose. Same hometown as 1996 National League MVP Ken Caminiti.
- Throws a four pitch mix that features a low-90s fastball, slider, curve and changeup. Mid-80s slider has been considered his best pitch by scouts. Slider is occasionally identified as a cutter by Statcast - does not throw a cutter.
- Was a three-sport star at Hanford High School... was the school's starting varsity quarterback and also played basketball.
- Was originally committed to Texas Tech out of high school, but Red Raiders pulled offer after a football injury suffered his senior year.

- Opponents batting .288 against fastball... but .135 vs Slider, .167 against changeup...
- Leads all of Single-A with 117 Whiffs, 39% Whiff rate.
- Has pitched four innings, but struck out 8+ in three straight outings.

- Threw a 9-inning, 11 strikeout no-hitter for Long Beach State on Mother's Day 2022, with his mom in attendance.
- Played in the prestigious Cape Cod league in the summer of 2022 and posted a 3.71 ERA in 34 innings for Falmouth.
