**TODAY'S GAME:** The M-Braves continue a six-game series against the Montgomery Biscuits at Riverwalk Stadium. This marks the fourth of six series against the Biscuits this season. These teams meet a total of 30 times, with 15 games at Trustmark Park and 15 games at Riverwalk Stadium. After this series, there will be three more games at Montgomery and six more at Trustmark.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The M-Braves scored four runs in the ninth to complete a two-run comeback in a 5-2 win over the Biscuits. Justin Dean and Andrew Moritz each collected three hits and came up clutch in the ninth. Dean's triple off the top of the wall in right tied the game 2-2, and Mori-tz's two-run single put the M-Braves in front for the first time 4-2. Jake Higginbotham forced a double play groundout for his second save of the season.

THE COMEBACK KIDS RETURN: The M-Braves completed their fourth comeback when trailing after eight innings, already surpassing last season's total of two. Three of four of those come backs came in Riverwalk Stadium. The M-Braves went 2-38 when trailing after eight innings last season

THE SLUGBAUER IS ALONE ATOP M-BRAVES HOME RUN LIST: 1B Drew Lugbauer hit his league-leading 15th home run on Tuesday, June 21 in Montgomery, and 33rd overall with the M-Braves. The solo home run pushed him by Travis Demerritte and Connor Lien for the M-Braves record. Lugbauer hit 18 home runs in 2021. He ranks T-7th in Double-A in homers this season, including a two-homer game on May 27 at Pensacola where he matched a club-record with six RBI.

- Lugbauer hit a walk-off single on Friday, June 3 vs MTG, the M-Braves first walkoff since Wendell Rijo's single on 7/9/21. He is in league's top 10 in...XBH (30, 3rd), walks (37, T-5th), doubles (15, 8th), slugging (.491, 9th), and total bases (114, 4th).
- A CASE OF THE SCUFFLES: The M-Braves have lost their last three series in a row, collecting only four wins over the previous three series. The club went 1-5 vs MTG from 5/30-6/5, 2-4 at RCT from 6/7-12 and 1-5 vs BIR from 6/14-19. The M-Braves have lost nine of 11.
- LAST TIME AT RIVERWALK: The M-Braves offense exploded for 45 runs and 13 home runs from 4/26-5/1 at Riverwalk Stadium. The club took four of six games, with a .271 AVG and .507 SLG during the series. The M-Braves won two games when trailing after eight innings on the Saturday and Sunday games in the series. The two clubs combined for 24 homers in the series.
- SCORE FIRST, GO FIVE INNINGS: The M-Braves are 21-11 when scoring first in a game and 22-11 when the starting pitcher makes it at least five innings into the outing. In contrast, the club is 8-26 when opponents score first and 6-26 when the starter goes less than five innings.
- RELIEVERS TO THE RESCUE: The relief core for the M-Braves is 2nd in the Southern League and 5th in Double-A with a 3.91 ERA this season. The relievers have posted a 2.78 ERA (13 ER/42.0 IP) over the previous eight games. RHP Odalvi Javer has allowed no runs over his last seven games, and 8.1 innings, eight strikeouts, two walks, .074 BAA, and 0.60 WHIP.
- DANGEROUS DEAN: After returning from the injured list on June 4, OF Justin Dean is starting to settle in as an M-Braves regular. In 17 games in June, Dean is batting .306 with five extra-base hits, three RBI, six steals, nine runs, and an .830 OPS. He has hits in eight of his last nine games. Dean is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 30 prospect.
- GIVE ME MO MORITZ: OF Andrew Moritz is out to a seven-game hit streak after going 3-for-5 on Wednesday, June 22. Over the streak, he is 9-for-27 with four RBI. Moritz posted a 10-game hit streak from 5/18-30
- VINES SHINES: In his first Double-A season, RHP Darius Vines leads the league with 82 strikeouts in 65.1 innings. On Sunday, June 19, he posted his longest outing of the season with seven shutout innings and eight strikeouts vs BIR. Vines holds a 5.37 ERA in 13 starts and is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 13 prospect.
- THE M-BRAVES WENT TO JARED: Starter Jared Shuster has a 3.53 ERA through 13 starts, which ranks 8th in the Southern League. The 2020 Atlanta first-rounder ranks among the league leaders in OBA, (.214, 4th), WHIP (1.06, 2nd), innings pitched (66.1, 1st), strikeouts (74, 2nd)
- ALEXANDER THE GREAT: INF CJ Alexander hit his 12th home run on Wednesday, June 22, ranking T-6th in the league. He has two multi-homer games, May 13, at Chattanooga, and May 27 at Pensacola, his third and fourth since 2019. From May 27-June 1, Alexander homered five times in five games.
- · Alexander is T-1st in the Southern League, and ranks T-2nd in Double-A baseball with 12 homers since May 1.
- MAESE SAVES THE DAY: After logging a save in RCT on 6/12, RHP Justin Maese leads the Southern League, and is T-3rd in Double-A, going 9-for-9 in save chances this season. He posts 43 strikeouts to just eight walks in 27.2 innings. He's also T-3rd in appearances with 25.

MISSING MIKE: OF Michael Harris II continues to shine since the Atlanta Braves selected his contract from Double-A Mississippi on 5/28. He is hitting .333 with 3 home runs, 13 RBI, six doubles, two triples and two stolen bases in 24 games. Atlanta is 20-6 since calling up Harris II to the show, including a 14-game winning streak

#### **TODAY'S GAME**

Freddy Tarnok makes his 13th start of the season and his fifth career start against Montgomery. He last faced the Biscuits on June 1, taking the loss after giving up six runs on seven hits in 3.2 innings.

#### LAST TIME OUT

Tarnok bounced back with five innings of one-run ball on June 18 vs Birmingham. He struck out a season-high eight batters to just one walk.

- Struck out a career-high 12 batters on July 29 at Pensacola, the first 12-strikeout game by an M-Braves pitcher since Ian Anderson struck out 14 on June 28, 2019 vs.
- In his M-Braves debut, he tossed a season-high 5.1 innings with nine strikeouts, one walk, two earned runs and three hits in a no decision on July 23 vs Biloxi
- Promoted to Mississippi onn July 20 from High-A Rome. In 7 games, 5 starts for Rome, Tarnok went 3-2 with a 4.76 ERA, 13 walks and 48 strikeouts
- Began the season on the GCL Braves roster, recovering from a lat injury, and transferred to Rome on June 9, making his first start on that day, with 4.0 shutout innings, one walk, eight strikeouts adn 58 pitches
- Struck out a career-high (at the time) 10 batters, walking only two, in his final Rome start on July 16 vs Greensboro
- Went 1-0 and did not allow a homer over 1.2 innings and three appearances during 2021 MLB spring training. He struck out three, walked one and had one save on 3/1 at MIN. His win was against Tampa on 3/14.

- Ended season ranked by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 11 prospect

- Spent the year at High-A Florida and made three rehab appearances with the GCL Braves...Combined to go 3-8 with a 4.75 ERA (56 ER/106.0 IP) in 22 starts
- Went on injured list 6/4 with right rotator cuff strain, reinstated 7/17

- In his first full professional season, pitched 27 games, 11 starts with Single-A Rome, went 5-5 with a 3.96 ERA(34 ER/77.1 IP)
