Today's Game: The Sounds and Bats conclude their last series against each other this season today at First Horizon Park. Louisville kept their hopes in splitting the series alive with a 10-inning, 4-2 win yesterday. Right-hander Chad Patrick will go for his second win of the series and sixth of the season, getting the start today for Nashville. Louisville will give the ball to their series opening starter Connor Phillips.

Chad Patrick: The 25-year-old makes his 11th appearance and 10th start of the campaign today. The right-hander is 5-1 with a 2.87 ERA (53.1 IP/17 ER) and has 52 strikeouts. Patrick shut down the Bats on Tuesday, holding them scoreless through 5.2 innings of work. He entered after Jakob Junis got through two innings on rehab assignment, then worked into the eighth inning, striking out six with three hits and a pair of walks allowed. Patrick is the league leader in ERA entering the day and ranks among other IL leaders in win percentage (T-2nd, .833), opponent batting average (5th, .227), wins (T-6th) and WHIP (7th). He's earned the win in each of his last four appearances and boasting a 1.99 ERA (22.2 IP/5 ER), 1.32 WHIP and .235 opponent batting average since May 16. The Indiana native was acquired by Milwaukee from Oakland in the trade that sent infielder Abraham Toro to the Athletics on November 15, 2023. He was originally selected in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft by Arizona out of Purdue University Northwest, a NCAA Division II school in Hammond, Ind.

Connor Phillips: The 23-year-old makes his 12th start of the season for the Bats today. He is 2-3 with a 7.91 ERA (46.2 IP/41 ER) on the season. Phillips took the loss on Tuesday, allowing four runs (2 ER) on four hits and five walks in five innings. It was his first loss since falling to the Sounds on April 26 at Louisville Slugger Field (4.0 IP, 11 H, 8 ER). Phillips checks in as the No.5 prospect in the Reds organization per MLB Pipeline. He leads the International League with 44 walks on the season, five more than his teammate Lyon Richardson and six more than Sounds pitcher Aaron Ashby. He made his Major League debut with Cincinnati last season and went 1-1 with a 6.97 ERA (20.2 IP/16 ER) in five starts. The Reds acquired the right-hander as the player to be named later in the trade that sent Eugenio Suarez and Jesse Winker to the Pacific Northwest. Phillips was originally selected with the 64th pick of the 2020 draft out of McLennan Community College in Texas.

I.C. What You Mean: Outfielder Isaac Collins stayed hot at the plate last night, going 1-for-3 with a sac fly RBI. He's hit safely and recorded an RBI in each of the last six games, going 10-for-22 with three doubles, 10 RBI and four runs scored. He has the second most RBI and sixth most hits in the league since June 2. Collins has crushed Louisville pitching this season, going 16-for-39 (.410) with six doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, 10 walks and 11 runs scored in 11 games against the Bats. The former Creighton University Bluejay ranks among International League leaders in doubles (2nd, 18), runs (T-3rd, 42) and extra-base hits (T-4th, 27) on the season.

McLovin: Right-hander Evan McKendry took over in the fourth inning and had a successful night in long relief, holding the Bats scoreless for four innings. He tied his season high with six strikeouts while scattering three singles in the middle innings. Since moving to the bullpen and appearing strictly as a reliever on May 23, McKendry is 1-0 with a 1.38 ERA (13.0 IP/2 ER), 12 strikeouts, a 0.85 WHIP and .170 opponent batting average.

Bullpen Beat: The Sounds bullpen took the loss but managed to keep their club in the game with 7.2 innings of work last night. Nashville's pen leads Triple-A in ERA (3.12), WHIP (1.30), and is second in opponent batting average (.214) with a 21-8 overall record.

The Power is Out: Nashville has hit just one home run in the series thus far which is the fewest by any team in the IL this week. The Sounds rank 19th in the league with 54 home runs on the season (only Gwinnett has fewer with 46). Just 17 of Nashville's 54 homers have come at First Horizon Park (31.5%), and opponents have hit 28 home runs off Sounds pitching in Nashville.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 716-612 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,308-2,132 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's third time facing Louisville. He got the win in 5.1 innings of five-run baseball on April 26 at Louisville Slugger Field earlier this season, then pitched against them in the series opener on Tuesday.
