LAST OUTING: Patrick worked in relief of opener Jakob Junis in Tuesday's win over Louisville. He struck out six over 5.2 innings. The Sounds would go on to shut out the Bats in the contest.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's third time facing Louisville. He got the win in 5.1 innings of five-run baseball on April 26 at Louisville Slugger Field earlier this season, then pitched against them in the series opener on Tuesday.
