YESTERDAY: Vinny Capra and Demi Orimoloye led the offense, but the Fisher Cats dropped a doubleheader to the Sea Dogs on Friday night by scores of 8-3 and 9-2. Capra drove in the three runs in the opener with a double, and Orimoloye finished the night with three hits, including an RBI single in the nightcap. Brock Lundquist drove in New Hampshire's other run in the second game. For Portland, Triston Casas homered three times, driving in a combined seven runs.

2022 SCHEDULE RELEASE: The Fisher Cats have released a 2022 schedule, featuring home matchups on Father's Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day Weekend. New Hampshire opens up the year on the road at Portland before their home opener on April 12th against Hartford. New Hampshire will also host Richmond, Erie, and Altoona for inter-divisional play.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: September 4, 2017—The Fisher Cats finished the 2017 season with a 59-80 record with an 11-4 win over the Sea Dogs at Hadlock Field. Sean Reid-Foley struck out nine over five innings to improve to 10-11 on the season. Matt Dean went 3-for-4 with a pair of homers, driving in three, Gunnar Heidt homered and drove in three runs, and Lourdes Guerriel Jr. had a pair of hits, including a home run.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays stunned the Athletics with six in the eighth, and three in the ninth for an 11-10 win. Lourdes Gurriel Jr. hit a grand slam in the ninth, and Marcus Semien hit the walk-off three run homer after Oakland had pushed ahead 10-8 in the top of the ninth with a pair of runs off Jordan Romano (W, 7-1)...Buffalo shut out SWB 1-0Otto Lopez knocked in the run with an eighth inning sacrifice fly...Vancouver won 9-7 at at Everett...Palm Beach topped Dunedin 12-9 in 13 innings...and the FCL Jays won 9-2 over the Tigers as rehabbing reliever James Dykstra earned the win.

TONIGHT'S STARTERS: RHP Luis Quinones saw a 15-inning scoreless streak come to an abrupt end in an 8-4 loss to Binghamton last Sunday. Allowed runs in three of the four innings he worked, and finished with five hits and five walks allowed. Quinones allowed two hits and just an unearned run in his lone start against Portland on July 31 at Hadlock in the second game of a doubleheader. New Hampshire lost that game 1-0.

Portland is expected to turn to southpaw Jay Groome, who would be making his Double-A debut. The 23-year old was selected in the first round (12th overall) by Boston in the 2016 draft (Barnegat HS, NJ). Made 18 starts for Adv. A Greenville with a 3-8 record and a 5.29 ERA. Did strike out 108 batters in 81.2 IP.
