The game was tied until the top of the seventh when the Cubs scored two runs on one passed ball. With two outs and men on second and third, a passed ball by Captains catcher Joe Donovan allowed Yonathan Perlaza to score from third. Donovan's flip to the plate in an effort to catch Perlaza skipped away, allowing Jake Slaughter to score from second to give the Cubs a 5-3 lead. Lake County out-hit South Bend, 9-4, but went 2-for-10 with men in scoring position. Bryan Lavastida and José Tena each went 3-for-4, while the rest of the Captains went 3-for-23.

TIGHT SERIES: The Captains and Cubs have played three close ballgames. Each game has been decided by two or fewer runs. The Captains won the first two games by scores of 5-4 and 3-2. South Bend took game three, 5-3.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 16-5 at home, compared to 11-19 on the road. The Captains' offense owns the third-best home OPS in the High-A Central League (HAC) at .777 and the pitching staff has the third-lowest home ERA in the league at 3.27. On the flip side, the Captains' offense has the fourth-worst road OPS in the league at .644 and the pitching staff has the third-worst road ERA at 5.19.

HOT LAVA: Bryan Lavastida is riding a six-game hitting streak, during which the Captains' catcher has three three-hit games. Over that stretch, Lavastida has hit .542 (13-for-24) with three homers and a double.

WELCOME BACK: In 14 games since returning from an oblique injury, George Valera has slashed .295/.436/.500 (.936 OPS) with two home runs, a double and a triple. Quentin Holmes returned from a groin injury on June 1 and has hit .380/.411/.500 (.911 OPS) since returning with a homer, a triple, a double.

ROCCHIO ROLLING: Brayan Rocchio has hits in 10 of his last 13 games, including four multi-hit performances. The switch-hitter has hit .300/.386/.520 (.906 OPS) during that span with two homers and five doubles.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is second in the High-A Central League (HAC) in doubles (16), ied for seventh in extra-base hits (19), ninth in batting average (.288).

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains SS Ernie Clement became the 101st former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 13. Nine former Captains have made their major league debuts this year -OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018) and RHP Eli Morgan (2018) and Clement. That ties the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, matching 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on May 11, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

LAST TIME OUT: Gaddis surrendered three solo home runs in the first three innings and allowed seven runs over 3.2 innings to take the loss at Great Lakes last Tuesday. Gaddis gave up a solo shot to Ryan Ward with two outs in the first, a leadoff homer to Carson Taylor in the second and another solo homer to Andy Pages in the third. Gaddis then allowed four more runs in the fourth before being pulled with two outs. The Captains lost to the Loons. 9-1.

PROSPECTING: Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #29 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

NO-HITTER: On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Brennan

THE MAGIC NUMBER: Gaddis has thrown exactly three innings 10 times in his first 14 appearances as a professional. He has never thrown more than three innings so far in his professional career. To open the 2021 season against Lansing, Gaddis worked into the fourth inning for the first time as a pro, however he could not record an out exiting the game after three innings of work. In college Gaddis worked 266.2 total innings over 46 appearances, or 5.2 innings pitched per appearance.

GEORGIA STATE STAR: Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team allSun-Belt selection.

PANTHER PRO'S: David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

TEAM USA: In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
