TODAY'S GAMES: In this series finale against the Round Rock Express, the Space Cowboys look to continue their offensive rampage and go 5-1 in the meeting with RHP Misael Tamarez on the mound... RHP Shaun Anderson, who was just signed a Minor League contract with the Texas Rangers, will face off against Sugar Land.

ABOUT SATURDAY NIGHT: Sugar Land took the lead first for the first time this series on an RBI groundout by Jacob Amaya... Back-to-back-to-back singles from César Salazar, Amaya, and Luke Berryhill widened the lead in the fourth inning... In the sixth, Jesús Bastidas ripped a two-RBI double down the left field line to extend the lead to 6-0... In the top of the seventh, Round Rock came back on LHP Parker Mushinski to close the gap to 6-4, but, the Space Cowboys would get those four runs back in the bottom half of the frame on RBI singles by Cooper Hummel, Berryhill, and David Hensley... A bases loaded walk for Amaya in the bottom of the eighth sealed the Space Cowboys 11-4 victory... Starter RHP Blair Henley pitched 4.2 innings giving up no runs as he struck out six.

ROSTER MOVES: 4/21 - RHP Spencer Arrighetti recalled by Houston... 4/18 - LHP Bryan King placed on the IL... 4/17 - RHP Forrest Whitley optioned to Sugar Land... 4/16 - RHP Forrest Whitley promoted to Houston... RHP Spencer Arrighetti optioned to Sugar Land... RHP Drew Strotman transferred to Corpus Christi.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 12 players that were drafted by the Astros, six free agent signings, four players acquired in trades, two international free agents, two waiver claim, one MiLB Rule 5 Draft pick and two undrafted free agent.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys roster sports six of the Astros' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline, including: OF/INF Joey Loperfido (#6), RHP AJ Blubaugh (#8), RHP Rhett Kouba (#14), INF Will Wagner (#15), INF Jacob Amaya (#23) and OF Pedro León (#27).

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: With a victory on Saturday night, the Space Cowboys collected their third straight series win... They are 2-1-0 overall in series this season...

FAST STARTERS: Through the first 20 games of the year, the Space Cowboys own a +16 run differential in the first inning, having plated 23 runs while allowing just seven runs in the opening stanza... The Space Cowboys have scored first in 14 of 20 games and have scored in the first inning in 11 of 20 contests... They have also scored multiple runs in the first in six of 19 games.

BOMBS AWAY: Sugar Land leads the Pacific Coast League in home runs with 28 and are tied for third in Minor League Baseball in long balls... The Space Cowboys have homered in 13 of 20 games so far in 2024 and have launched at least two home runs in eight of their 20 contests.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 2021: The Space Cowboys have matched their best start in franchise history, with their 14-6 record the same as the first 20 games of the 2021 season. In that span, they have hit .271 with a league-leading 28 home runs and 126 RBIs.

LOWDOWN ON LOPERFIDO: OF Joey Loperfido has followed up his breakout 2023 season with a hot start to 2024... He homered in three straight games last week from Thursday through Saturday and last Friday night connected for three homers in the game, including two home runs in the seventh inning, his second multi-homer game of the season and fifth of his career... It was the first three homer game in Loperfido's career and the sixth in Space Cowboys history (last - Pedro León, 8/12/23 @ El Paso)... Loperfido also set a new single-game high in RBI with 7.

For his week in Albuquerque, Loperfido was named the Pacific Coast League Player of the Week, his second Player of the Week honor in his career... He went 11-for-26 in 34 plate appearances, slashing .423/.559/1.077/1.636 with two doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI, 14 runs scored, six walks, a stolen base and was hit by a pair of pitches. He recorded multi-hit efforts in four of six games.

Entering Sunday, Loperfido is tied for the Minor League lead in home runs (10), is second in RBI (24) and runs scored (21), third in total bases (53), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (13) and ninth in slugging (.726).

WE LITERALLY LOVE HOME PLATE: Sugar Land leads all of Minor League Baseball in runs scored in 2024, plating 150 runs in 20 games, averaging 7.5 runs per game... Sugar Land scored 72 runs last week in Albuquerque, averaging 12.0 runs per game.

HEY, I'M WALKIN'!: On 4/9 at Albuquerque, the Space Cowboys drew 14 walks, a single-game franchise record, surpassing 13 walks in a game which Sugar Land last achieved on... Tuesday, April 2 vs. Las Vegas... 11 of the walks against Albuquerque came in the 5th, 6th and 7th inning... The Space Cowboys have worked 115 walks in 2024, the most in Baseball (Major or Minor League)

WWWWWINS FOR DAYS: Sugar Land is currently tied with the Sacramento River Cats for the most wins in Minor League Baseball, picking up 14 victories in their first 20 games... In the Major Leagues, only the Cleveland Guardians have more wins than Sugar Land and the Space Cowboys.

HITS FROM HAVANA: Pedro León is rolling, as he has hit safely in 15 of 17 games this season... He is hitting .320 with seven doubles, a home run, 18 RBI and 16 runs scored.

RUNNERS ON BASE? SHAY LESS: Shay Whitcomb has been clutch with runners in scoring position, batting .474... He's driven in 17 base runners and has collected nine hits, including a home run and a double.

SPACE COWBOYS IN THE SHOW: For a third consecutive day, the Space Cowboys had a player get his contract selected by the Astros on April 10. RHP Spencer Arrighetti had his contract selected on the 10th and made his Major League debut in Kansas City versus the Royals... RHP Wander Suero had his contract selected on April 9 by Houston... RHP Blair Henley had his contract selected by the Astros on April 8 and made his Major League debut against the Rangers... While Henley allowed five runs, he did not receive a decision in a 10-5 Astros victory... Meanwhile, former Space Cowboys righty Ronel Blanco was named the American League Pitcher of the Week after throwing a no-hitter on April 1 vs. Toronto and following it up with 6.0 one-hit innings on Sunday at Texas.

ONE-HIT WONDER: Sugar Land one-hit the Aviators on April 5, hurling their first shutout of 2024 in just their seventh game of the year... It took Sugar Land until September 5, 2023 to throw their first shutout last season (Game 133)... It was the fourth one-hitter thrown in Space Cowboys history.

WALK THIS WAY: On 4/2 vs. Las Vegas, the Space Cowboys drew 13 walks, which tied the franchise record for most walks in a single game at the time... The other time Sugar Land earned 13 free passes was in Game 2 of a doubleheader on August 19, 2022... The Space Cowboys scored 17 runs in the sixth inning of that game and would end up winning 21-4 in seventh innings... Sugar Land would break the walks record one week later on 4/9 @ Albuquerque, drawing 14 walks.

HISTORY FOR BLANCO: Former Space Cowboys reliever and starter RHP Ronel Blanco (2021-23) authored the 17th no-hitter in Astros' franchise history on April 1 at Minute Maid Park, walking just two batters... The no-hitter came in Blanco's 8th career start in the Majors... Blanco becomes the first Space Cowboys hurler to make his debut and then throw a no-hitter in the Major Leagues... LHP Framber Valdez appeared in two games with Sugar Land in 2021 before throwing his no-hitter on August 1, 2023.

RIDE THE BIKE!: On June 24, 2023, OF Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

SEEING 20-20-20: Both Pedro León (23 2B, 21 HR) and Joey Loperfido (27 2B, 25 HR) posted seasons in 2023 in which they had at least 20 doubles and 20 home runs while stealing at least 20 bases (León - 21; Loperfido - 27)... They were two of just 23 players in Minor League Baseball to have at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 20 stolen bases, with Corpus Christi OF Kenedy Corona joining them (21 2B, 22 HR, 32 SB)... INF Shay Whitcomb came just one double shy of joining that group, but along with León and Loperfido was one of just 33 players with at least 20 steals and 20 home runs.

UN DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will once again rebrand on multiple occasions in 2024 as 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: All 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard once again be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV, MLB.TV, the MiLB App and on Bally Live. Garrett Greene returns for his second season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his fourth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fifth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his fourth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with three seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Thomas Whitsett, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Whitsett enters his first season as the Space Cowboys pitching coach, replacing Erick Abreu, who joined the Atlanta Braves in 2024 as their bullpen coach. Whitsett was the Astros' Assistant Pitching Coordinator in 2023 and served as the Pitching Coach for Double-A Corpus Christi in 2022. He also worked as a pitching coach for Single-A Fayetteville in 2019 before spending a year out of the Astros organization as the director of player development for pitching at the University of Arizona in 2021. Westlake returns for his second season as Sugar Land's hitting coach and previously was the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi in 2022 and a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his third season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.
