

LAST GAME

The Baysox fell to Akron last night by a 3-2 final score. Many trends from the two prior games in the series resurfaced on Thursday night. Once again, the Baysox struck early with an RBI double by Heston Kjerstad, just the second batter of the game for Bowie, to take a 1-0 lead. However, Kjerstad was thrown out trying to advance to third later in the inning, and no further damage would be done by the Baysox in the frame. From that point, Akron starter Gavin Williams settled in, along with the stout RubberDucks bullpen, to silence the Baysox to only one hit between the second and eighth inning. On the mound for the Baysox, starter Justin Armbruester kept Akron off the board for the first three frames, before the red-hot Julian Escobedo doubled off the first base bag and later scored on a Johnathan Rodriguez single to lie the game at one in the top of the fourth. Two walks from Armbruester and one from Kade Strowd in the fifth loaded the bases for the RubberDucks, who squeaked a run across on a Bryan Lavastida ground out for a 2-1 lead. Escobedo would then homer for the series thus far, going 8-for-12 at the plate with six extra-base hits. Kjerstad hit a solo shot in the bottom half of the inning to make it a 3-2 game - his third big fly of the campaign, and Bowie would threaten in each of the last two innings, as they have shown throughout the series, but in the bottom of the ninth, Zach Watson was thrown out at home trying to score on a ground ball to third, and Coby Mayo would later sharply fly out to left field with the bases loaded to end the game, as the Baysox

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron Rubberducks return fifteen players from a squad that missed the Eastern League playoffs via a tiebreaker in the first half, and finished just two games off the pace in the second half. In its inaugural series of 2023, Akron dropped two of three games at home against the Erie Seawolves, falling in the rubber match 3-2 in 11 innings on Saturday night. Seven of the Guardians' top 30 prospects begin the 2023 campaign with Akron, including a debut Double-A stints for OF Petey Halpin (No. 17 CLE). Halpin hit .262 with six home runs, four triples, and 16 stolen bases for High-A Lake County last season and is off to a 3-for-12 start with a stolen base in 2023 as a tone-setter atop the Akron lineup. INF Angel Martinez (No. 10 CLE) hit .244 in 24 games for Akron last season and has continued to develop in the offseason, putting successful shifts together in both the Arizona Fall League and Guardians Spring Training. INF Jose Tena (No. 24 CLE) hit .264 in 127 games with 13 home runs for Akron in 2022 but did not feature in either of the two last games against Erie. The RubberDucks have four arms inside of the Guardians' top 30, including righthander Gavin Williams (No. 2 CLE) and southpaw Joey Cantillo (No. 19 CLE), the latter of whom was a 2022 Eastern League All-Star with a 1.93 ERA in 60.2 innings.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Akron's projected starter for this evening is right-hander Ross Carver. Accquired by the Guardians from the Diamondbacks organization in November, Carver started for Akron this past Friday in Erie for his only action so far this season. He went three innings and allowed two runs, only one of which was earned, on a single hit, but walked four in the process. Last season, Carver threw 36 innings at the Double-A level for Amarillo, posting a 9.50 ERA as a starter, allowing a rough 15 home runs and 48 hits, but only walking 15. Opponents hit .331 against the right-hander. He had much more success in High-A Hillsboro in 2022, when he pitched to a 3.10 ERA in 81.1 innings, with the opposition hitting just .186 by comparison. He also had three games with Hillsboro where he registered double-digit strikeouts. Carver was accquired in exchange for now-Major League reliever Carlos Vargas. Tonight's Akron starter features a mid 90s fastball with arm-side run, with a slider and curveball, along with a changeup he is still working on.

MOUND REBOUND

The Baysox have gotten a nice boost from the pitching staff so far in 2023. After having a bottom-half team ERA in the Eastern League last season at 4.42 and the fourth-highest average allowed at .245, the Bowie arms have turned it around to the tune of a 2.63 ERA – good for third in the Eastern League and fourth in all of Double-A. Opponents are also only hitting .155 (9-for-58) with runners in scoring position against Bowie this season.

HESTON IS BESTON

Heston Kjerstad has settled in nicely to Double-A after a phenomenal Spring Training with the Orioles in Sarasota. Now the Orioles' No. 5 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Kjerstad has a team-high three home runs and five RBI in his first six Eastern League games. He has four hits in the series against Akron, three of which are for extra bases. Kjerstad has also shown to be the complete package, stealing two bases as well, all while getting his first three starts at first base in his professional career and for the first time since his 2020 collegiate season at Arkansas. Kjerstad led all Orioles in Grapefruit league action this past spring with four home runs and 34 total bases, in addition to a monstorous 1.219 OPS.

LOCK UP YOUR VALUABLES

The Baysox stole multiple bags on Wednesday night for the third time so far this season. Last night was the first time Bowie failed to register a stolen base in 2023. The Baysox were not a notable stolen base threat in 2022, sporting the fewest stolen base attempts (99) and second-fewest steals (75). However, they currently sit third in the Eastern League with nine swiped bags in 2023. Bowie is also the third most efficient team in the league to attempt at least eight steals, with a success rate of just under 82%.

'ODAY'S STARTING PITCHER







Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 14-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlanic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017.
