JUMBO SHRIMP FALL IN SERIES FINALE

Jacob Berry homered and drove in three runs on Sunday but the Jumbo Shrimp fell 6-5 to the Tides. After Norfolk built a 2-0 over the first two innings of the game, Berry's two-run blast tied the score in the fifth. Later in the fifth. Harrison Spohn scored on a double steal to give Jacksonville its first lead. Heriberto Hernandez notched an RBI single in the seventh before the Tides answered in the bottom of the seventh. Berry's RBI single in the eighth inning made it 5-3, but Norfolk plated three runs in the bottom of the ninth inning to win the series finale.

BIG. BEAUTIFUL INNINGS

Over the season's first 39 games, Jacksonville mustered at least four runs in an inning six times. However, over their six contests of their set last week at Norfolk, the Jumbo Shrimp put up four runs or more in an inning six times. Relatedly, the week against the Tides saw Jacksonville pile up 43 runs through six games (7.2 per game). Over the previous 12 contests, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated only 36 runs (3.0 per game - second-fewest in Triple-A.

PINTAREST

Jacksonville outfielder Andrew Pintar got off to a slow start to the season, slashing just .240/.296/.280/.576 with two doubles, three RBIs, six runs and two stolen bases in his first 12 games. The Provo, Utah native has been on a tear in the 27 games since. During this stretch, Pintar is hitting .389/.431/.526/.957 with five doubles, one triple, two home runs, 13 RBIs, six walks, 11 runs and 10 stolen bases. On the season, Pintar ranks seventh in the IL in average (.346), tied for seventh in hits (46), tied for 11th in steals (11) and 22nd in OBP (.396).

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 19-5 at home this season, posting the second-most home wins of any MiLB team while outscoring their opponents by a 102-71 margin at VyStar Ballpark. The road for Jacksonville, however, has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 9-12 on the road, getting outscored by an 115-103 margin, Jacksonville has hit similarly at home (.719 OPS) versus on the road (.710 OPS). However, their team ERA is 2.30 at home (1st, also 2nd in MiLB) compared to 5.41 on the road (23rd).

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 26 of their last 44 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have six games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank first in Triple-A and fifth in the minor leagues with 102 stolen bases.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks third in Triple-A with a robust 3.71 ERA, and their 186 runs allowed are the fourth-fewest at the level. Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have also limited walks (154, tied for the second-fewest in Triple-A). Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff has only 403 strikeouts, tied for 10th at the level and also the third-fewest hits allowed. The club's hurlers have done an excellent job limiting the hard contact against, thus keeping their hits allowed down. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.4 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the sixth-lowest such mark in Triple-A.

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 36 games, a whopping 27 have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 18-9 (.667) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 20-10 (.667) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 11-6 (.647) mark in one-run games. Those 11 one-run victories are tied for the most in the International League and tied for second in the minor leagues.

SHRIMP BITES

At 28-17. Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2010 Jacksonville Suns also started the campaign 28-17... Jumbo Shrimp players make up five of the top 15 in the IL in stolen bases... Jacksonville baserunners have taken the extra base on a hit on 49.3 percent of opportunities, far above the MLB average of 42.6 percent... Andrew Pintar's 11-game hitting streak and Jakob Marsee's 12-game on-base streaks are the longest such runs for Jumbo Shrimp hitters thus far in 2025.

ABOUT CONNOR

- -Gillispie was originally selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the ninth round of the $2019 \ \mathrm{draft}$ out of VCU.
- -After pitching in the Orioles' organization and reaching Double-A Bowie in 2023, Gillispie was selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the minor league phase of the 2023 Rule 5 draft.
- -Gillispie made his major league debut for the Guardians on August 4, 2024 in a game against the Orioles in Cleveland. He pitched 3.0 innings, yielding one run on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts in Baltimore's 9-5 victory.
- -Following the 2024 season, Cleveland designated Gillispie for assignment and then non-tendered him, making him a free agent. He signed a one-year major league contract with the Atlanta Braves on November 29, 2024. Gillispie was later designated for assignment by the Braves and claimed off waivers by the Miami Marlins on January 29, 2025.
- -In college at VCU, Gillispie majored in Business Real Estate.

2025 SEASON

-Gillispie made Miami's Opening Day starting rotation but struggled in the big leagues. He was optioned on April 27 to Jacksonville.

With runners on in the major leagues, opponents slashed .358/.379/.623/1.002 in 58 plate appearances against Gillispie.

2024 SEASON

-Gillispie excelled as a reliever; in 15 appearances out of the bullpen, he went 3-3 with a 2.63 ERA (51.1 IP, 32 H, 21 BB, 44 K, .180 BAA). In 15 starts, all coming with Triple-A Columbus, he posted a 2-4 record and 4.89 ERA (70.0 IP, 64 H, 32 BB, 83 K, .242 BAA).

-Gillispie held right-handed hitters to a .196/.287/.396/.683 batting line in 278 plate appearances. Left-handed batters hit .242/.330/.470/.800 against him 224 plate appearances.

2023 SEASON

-In 239 plate appearances, righties slashed .222/.296/.361/.657 against him compared to a .225/.295/.404/.699 line for opposing left-handed hitters in 235 plate appearances.

-Gillispie was 4-3 with a 3.48 ERA in 14 starts (67.1 IP, 55 H, 18 BB, 53 K, .219 BAA). Over 13 relief appearances, he posted a 3.1 record and 4.47 ERA (48.1 IP, 41 H, 19 BB, 46 K, .230 BAA).
