trip with game two of a six-game series vs. the Nashville Sounds (Milwaukee Brewers). It is the eighth of 18 games between the two clubs this season, and the second of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Nashville. With a win tonight, Gwinnett would snap a four-game road losing streak.

VS. NASHVILLE: Following last night's loss, Gwinnett is 3-10 (.300) all-time in Nashville. The Stripers have lost four straight games at First Horizon Park (outscored 12-4) since last winning on 8/26/21 (won 2-1). In six series against the Sounds since first meeting in 2021, the Stripers are 1-4-1.

DICKERSON'S DOUBLE ENDS SHUTOUT: Alex Dickerson staved off what would have been Gwinnett's sixth shutout loss of the year last night with a two-out RBI double in the ninth inning (2-for-4, 2 2B, 1 RBI). It was his third two-hit effort in his last six games, a span in which he's batting .381 (8-for-21, 4 2B, 1 3B, 3 R, 2 RBI, 1.076 OPS).

KINGS OF THE "K": The Stripers' pitching staff leads Triple-A in strikeouts with 685 in 67 games (10.22 SO per game). That's two more than Sacramento of the Pacific Coast League (2nd, 683 SO in 67G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (teamrecord 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (1st, 92), Tucker Davidson (T-9th, 57), and Huascar Ynoa (T-9th, 57) all rank in the International League top 10 in strikeouts.

STIFLING STAFF: Gwinnett leads Triple-A in ERA in the month of June with a 3.59 mark in 18 games. That's 0.07 points lower than Scranton/WB (2nd, 3.66 ERA in 19G). Stripers' starters Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller, and Huascar Ynoa have combined to post a 3.69 ERA (42 ER in 102.1 IP), 9.67 SO/9.0 IP ratio (110 SO), and nine quality starts this month.

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. is riding a nine-game on-base streak since 6/3, batting .417 (10-for-24, 1 2B, 1 HR, 9 R, 3 RBI, 9 BB, 5 SB, 1.154 OPS) in that span. Overall with Gwinnett, he has reached base safely in 39 of 46 games (84.8%), batting .277 (36-for-130, 5 2B, 1 HR, 23 R, 13 RBI). He currently ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-7th, 15) and walks (T-10th, 34).

WATERS WATCH: Drew Waters notched his sixth multi-hit game of the year on Sunday vs. Indianapolis (3-for-5, 1 3B, 1 RBI). In 33 games since being activated from Gwinnett's 7-day Injured List on 5/3, the Atlanta Brayes' No. 2 prospect is batting .250 (32-for-128, 6 2B, 2 3B, 3 HR, 16 R, 11 RBI, 1 SB), including .436 (5 XBH, 1.078 OPS) vs. LHP and .169 (6 XBH, .519 OPS) vs. RHP.

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year, including leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (off LHP Wes Benjamin) and 5/11 at Durham (off RHP Tommy Romero), and a leadoff triple on 6/11 at Jacksonville (off RHP Bryan Hoeing)
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .247 (158-for-639, 33 2B, 3 3B, 16 HR, 103 R, 59 RBI, 32 SB, 706 OPS) in 162 games.

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Over his last six outings, Michael Tonkin has gone 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (1 R, 0 ER in 6.1 IP), 0.63 WHIP, .136 BAA, and one save. In 20 games overall, he is 3-0 with a 2.70 ERA (6 ER in 20.0 IP), .197 BAA, and team-high four saves (4-for-5, T-15th in IL).

TONIGHT: The Stripers continue a 13-day, 12-game road **MULLDOZING:** Kyle Muller retired the final 19 batters he faced on Sunday vs. Indianapolis (6.2 IP, 3 H, 3 ER, 0 BB, 8 SO, 1 HR), producing his fourth straight quality start in a no-decision. He is 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA (5 ER in 26.2 IP), 1.12 WHIP, .221 BAA, and 12.15 SO/9.0 IP ratio (36 SO) during that four-start stretch.

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (92) and is among the top 10 in innings (3rd, 69.0), ERA (4th, 3.00), WHIP (4th, 1.12), and BAA (5th, .221).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-7 with a 3.21 ERA (53 ER in 148.2 IP), .222 BAA, and 185 strikeouts (11.20 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 29 starts.

ROBERTSON STREAKING: Kramer Robertson is riding a six-game hitting streak, batting .364 (8-for-22, 2 2B, 1 HR, 6 R, 5 RBI, 4 SB, 1.091 OPS) since 6/12.

• Giddy Up: Robertson blasted his first Gwinnett homer on 6/17 vs. Indianapolis, a solo shot to center on the first pitch of the game from RHP Jerad Eickhoff. It was the fourth clout by a Stripers player leading off a game this year (Drew Waters has 2, Phil Gosselin has 1).

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .091 (2for-22, 4 R, 1 RBI, 1 SB) in six games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 165 of 195 games (84.6%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .278 (187-for-673, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 14 SB, .925 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

GOSSELIN GETS THE CALL: On 6/15, Atlanta selected the contract of INF Phil Gosselin from Gwinnett. He hit safely in 23 of 29 games from 5/1-6/12, batting .312 (34-for-109, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 16 RBI, .885 OPS) in that stretch. Through 6/13, Gosselin ranked 14th in the IL with a .297 average (54-for-182, 13 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 24 RBI).

GWN Career: In 284 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .295 (309-for-1046, 64 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 106 RBI, 11 SB, .769 OPS). He is one of just seven players in Gwinnett history to record 300 career hits with the club.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

• IL Leaderboard: Entering play, ranks T-9th in the league in strikeouts (57)

• GWN Career: Makes his 17th career start with Gwinnett ... Is 4-6 with a 3.17 ERA (31 ER in 88.0 IP), .221 BAA, and 97 strikeouts (9.92 SO/9.0 IP ratio) since 2019.

On the Road: Makes his seventh career Triple-A road start ... Is 2-2 with a 2.11 ERA (9 ER in 38.1 IP), .185 BAA, and 46 strikeouts (10.80 SO/9.0 IP ratio).

PROSPECTING: Davidson is currently ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 7 prospect by MLB.com. He is the third-highest ranked pitching prospect on Gwinnett's active roster, behind LHP Kyle Muller (No. 3) and RHP Bryce Elder (No. 4).

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Has had two stints with the Stripers, 4/12-5/16 (1-1, 4.44 ERA, .214 BAA in 5 starts) and 5/29-current (0-2, 4.12 ERA, .253 BAA in 3 starts) ... 6/11 at JAX: Set a career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 IP (5 H, 3 ER) in a 3-2 loss.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made the Atlanta Braves' Opening Day roster for the first time in his career ... Pitched once in relief (4/11 vs. WAS, 2.2 IP, 5 ER in 11-2 loss) before being optioned to Gwinnett on 4/12 ... Recalled on 5/17, and earned his first career MLB win that night at Milwaukee (5.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R in 3-0 win) ... Went 1-2 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER in 12.2 IP) over three starts before being optioned again on 5/29.
